RACE 1: TAB SA SIRES' PRODUCE STAKES - 1400 metres (Morphettville Parks Track)

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute.

BARCALI (M. Walker) - shifted out near the 100 metres and again over the concluding stages and brushed HINCHPIN.

MR DEADLINE (L. Currie) - lost its off hind plate during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HINCHPIN (R. Clark) - began awkwardly, shifted out and contacted SHE SHAO FLY. Held up for clear running from the 500 metres until the 300 metres. Inside the 500 metres rider was struck by a shoe, which was dislodged from one of the runners in the event. Near the 100 metres shifted out and away from BARCALI, which shifted out, and over the concluding stages was brushed by BARCALI, which shifted out. Rider examined by the First Care Medical Personnel and ruled fit to fulfil her remaining engagements. Rider explained that after being struck in the face by a shoe inside the 500 metres, she was placed at a disadvantage as she was unable to ride the gelding in her normal competitive manner.

FLOREAT PICA (D. Oliver) - raced wide without cover in the middle stages of the event. Near the 200 metres laid in, shifted in and contacted YOU HADME AT HELLO. Thereafter near the 100 metres was inconvenienced by FASCINO (NZ), which shifted out abruptly.



RACE 1: TAB SA SIRES' PRODUCE STAKES - 1400 metres (Cont'd)

ROLLS (C. Douglas) - inside the 1200 metres shifted in and crossed the running of SHE SHAO FLY, which had to be steadied when awkward on heels. Thereafter rider slowed the pace sightly. Rider reminded of his obligations when shifting ground and slowing the pace in races.

SHE SHAO FLY (D. Dunn) - contacted at the start and thereafter over-raced in the early stages of the event. Inside the 1200 metres had to be steadied when awkward on the heels of ROLLS and shifted out abruptly.

YOU HADME AT HELLO (B. Vorster) - over-raced in the early stages of the event. Lost its off fore plate during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FASCINO (NZ) (W. Pike) - shifted in shortly after the start and became awkwardly placed on the heels of FLOREAT PICA. Laid out and shifted out in the straight and inside the 100 metres contacted FLOREAT PICA, which was taken wider. Rider reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

CARTIER TIARA (P. Gatt) - lost its near fore plate during the event.

RACE 2: CARBINE CLUB AUTUMN SERIES FINAL - 1400 metres (Morphettville Parks Track)

ARKHAM KNIGHT (P. Gatt) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

POLAR VORTEX (W. Pike) - had difficulty obtaining clear running form the entrance to the straight until near the 200 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

VINLAND (L. Currie) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Held up for clear running near the 500 metres until approaching the 100 metres.

TAN TAT TRUSTING (NZ) (B. Vorster) contacted at the start. Raced wide without cover throughout of the event.

ROSELLI STING (D. Tourneur) - laid in, in the straight.

BORRIS IN OSSORY (R. Clark) - began awkwardly, shifted in and contacted TAN TAT TRUSTING (NZ). Raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

ENKI (J. Holder) - held up for clear running from near the 400 metres until approaching the 100 metres.

AUSSIE JACK (D. Thornton) - had difficulty obtaining clear running for some distance shortly after the entrance to the straight and was only able to fully improve his position in the vicinity of the 200 metres.

RACE 3: HUGHES LIMOUSINES HANDICAP - 1050 metres

TEQUILA TIME (C. Jones) - the saddled slipped back on jumping away, as a consequence C. Jones did not ride the gelding competitively in the event. Rider reported that as a consequence of the saddle slipping back on jumping away, she became concerned and elected not to ride her mount competitively as she had formed the view that it would not be safe for her to do so. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HEAVEN'S DEAL (J. Toeroek) - near the 300 metres attempted to improve into restricted room between PAPALET, which was inclined to lay out and BLIND CHANCE, which laid in and shifted in. As a consequence contacted BLIND CHANCE and was hampered. Thereafter approaching the 200 metres was able to obtain clear running. Rider reminded of his obligations when shifting ground and to take greater care in future.



RACE 3: HUGHES LIMOUSINES HANDICAP - 1050 metres (Cont'd)

VIDUKA (W. Pike) - had to be steadied over the concluding stages when tightened by BURNING THE CLOCK, which shifted out and away from MAGNA BELLA.

ASSERTIVE PLAY (D. Tourneur) - laid in, in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MAGNA BELLA (J. Holder) - began awkwardly, shifted out and contacted BLIND CHANCE. Held up for clear running from the entrance to the straight until inside the 300 metres. Over the concluding stages laid out and shifted out, as a consequence BURNING THE CLOCK shifted out and away from that horses heels onto VIDUKA, which had to be steadied.

BLIND CHANCE (J. Lorenseni) - began awkwardly, shifted in and contacted MAGNA BELLA. Was contacted near the 300 metres.

RACE 4: PROPUNTERALERT.COM HANDICAP - 1200 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

MAZUREK (R. Clark) - slipped behind on jumping away and as a consequence was very awkward and slow to begin. In the incident, the mare threw its head back and struck the rider in the face. Rider explained as a consequence of being slow to begin, she was unable to take up a more forward position as intended. Rider was examined by the First Care Medical Personnel and declared fit to fulfil her remaining engagements. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EASY BEAST (NZ) (D. Dunn) - Farrier required to perform remedial work on its off fore-plate on arrival at the barriers. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to race.

RACE 5: TRIPLE M PROVINCIAL SUPER SERIES FINAL BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1800 metres

NASEEB (D. Tourneur) - wide without cover in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

OCEAN WALZER (GER) (B. Vorster) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CHESTNUT CHARLIE (M. Walker) - held up for clear running for a short distance approaching the 200 metres.

DEXTER YOU DEVIL (J. Allen) - held for clear running from inside the 400 metres until near the 200 metres.

HONEY PRINCESS (FR) (J. Lorensini) - held up for clear running near the entrance to the straight until near the 200 metres.

ZAGATO STAR (D. Dunn) - inclined to lay out in the straight.

IAMTHEKEY (J. Maund) - near the 600 metres became awkward on the heels of runners for several strides. Had difficulty obtaining clear running for a short distance after the entrance to the straight. Inclined to lay out in the straight.

WICKED RHYTHM (J. Holder) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 800 metres became very awkwardly placed on the heels of DEXTER YOU DEVIL for several strides.



RACE 6: ADELAIDE GALVANISING ADELAIDE GUINEAS - 1600 metres

EAST INDIAMAN (R. Clark) - held up for clear running from approaching the 400 metres until approaching the 200 metres.

WINNING PARTNER (B. Vorster) - approaching the 1300 metres became crowded for room, got its head up when being restrained and raced ungenerously for a short distance. Obliged to be checked at the winning post when tightened for room between MUSWELLBROOK, which rolled in and away from SO WE ARE, which laid in and shifted in, and EAST INDIAMAN, which rolled out.

TONGSAI BOSS (D. Dunn) - laid in, in the straight.

AIGUILETTE (P. Gatt) - approaching the 1300 metres was hampered by SO WE ARE for several strides as that horse shifted in and away from TONGSAI BOSS. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ICE GHOST (J. Toeroek) - contacted at the start by GELIGNITE JACK (NZ), which shifted in. Rider reported his horse laid in, in the straight.

GELIGNITE JACK (NZ) (C. Douglas) - began awkwardly, shifted in and contacted ICE GHOST. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

SPLASH SOME CASH (M. Walker) - became awkwardly placed on the heels of MABEL JOSEPHINE for a short distance near the 800 metres.

LEFT HAND MAN (J. Holder) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

SO WE ARE (J. Allen) - laid in throughout the event. Approaching the winning post shifted in resulting in MUSWELLBROOK shifting in and away from this horse, onto WINNING PARTNER. Rider reminded of his obligations when his mounts commence to shift ground.

HAVANA HEAT (T. Pannell) - weakened noticeably from inside the 200 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LADY YOUNG (L. Currie) - near the 1300 metres raced keenly and became very awkward on the heels of TONGSAI BOSS for several strides.

AMANIKAN (D. Thornton) - approaching the 1300 metres got its head up and raced ungenerously when awkward on heels of runners for several strides.

BIRDWING (NZ) (W. Pike) - approaching the 1300 metres became awkward for several strides when hampered by WINNING PARTNER, which raced ungenerously.

RACE 7: TAB SOUTH AUSTRALIAN DERBY - 2500 metres

MR QUICKIE (J. Allen) - tightened at the start by ZESTO, which shifted out on jumping away and STAR STATUS, which maintained its line and lost its position. Laid in, in the straight. Rider explained that after being tightened at the start and losing his position, he was obliged to settle further back than intended. He added after passing the winning post on the first occasion, he was hampered when in restricted room and was obliged to take up a position closer to the rail, which was not his preferred option. He further added that inside the 700 metres he anticipated he may be taken into the race by runners in front which did not eventuate and was obliged to improve wide around the field.

CLASSIC WEIWEI (B. Vorster) - raced ungenerously on several occasions at various stages in the early part of the race when awkward on the heels owing to the pace in the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



RACE 7: TAB SOUTH AUSTRALIAN DERBY - 2500 metres (Cont'd)

STAR MISSILE (B. Allen) - awkward to begin. Raced ungenerously on several occasions at various stages in the early part of the race when awkward on the heels owing to the pace in the event. Laid in over the concluding stages.

RIDGEWOOD DRIVE (D. Thornton) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SAVVY OAK (NZ) (M. Walker) - began awkwardly and shifted out.

MANGIONE (D. Dunn) - tightened at the start between SAVVY OAK (NZ), which began awkwardly and shifted out and MANZALA, which began awkwardly and shifted in.

STAR STATUS (R. Clark) - contacted at the start and inconvenienced by MR QUICKIE. Raced very keenly in the early stages of the event.

MANZALA (J. Lorensini) - began awkwardly and shifted in.

QAFILA (C. Parish) - rider explained that it was his intention to settle mid-field or a touch further forward however, after beginning well and given the formation of the field in the early stages, he found himself in the box seat.

ZESTO (J. Maskiell) - shifted out shortly after the start.

Correct weight was delayed to allow Trainer Mr N. Smart to view the photo finish in relation to the placing of MANZALA.

RACE 8: ROBERT & FAY GERARD SA SPRINT SERIES FINAL BENCHMARK 86 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

DOMINATION (D. Dunn) - contacted at the start by SWEET VARDEN. Laid out in the straight.

MONTRE (K. Bishop) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ILLUMICON (B. Vorster) - slipped on jumping away and was awkward for several strides shortly thereafter. Rider explained that it was his intention to settle more forward in today's event however, after beginning awkwardly, he was obliged to settle further back. He added when questioned in relation to his riding of the gelding in the straight that it was his instructions to race wide. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CHEVAUX (D. Thornton) - laid out in the straight.

LADY SOMA (J. Maund) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

SWEET VARDEN (C. Parish) - contacted at the start by DOMINATION.

ZARACE (A. Jordsjo) - raced fitted with a tongue-tie. On arrival at the barriers A. Jordsjo requested the barrier staff to fit a tongue-tie to this gelding on the mistaken belief that the gelding had been fitted with a tongue-tie and lost it on the way to the barriers. A. Jordsjo was questioned in relation to the matter and while Stewards accepted that she acted in good faith, she was advised to be more circumspect in future before requesting gear replacements.
