

THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse by the Gawler & Barossa Jockey Club on Wednesday, 7 August 2019

TRACK: Soft 5 (Track with a reasonable amount of give in it)

RAIL: Out 2 metres entire. Sectional 602 metres.

WEATHER: Overcast / showery

RACE 1: TAB BENCHMARK 120 HURDLE - 3380 metres

All runners underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and were passed fit to start.

CASIRAGHI (D. McDonagh) - landed awkwardly after jumping the final hurdle. Rider reported that he became concerned with the gelding's action on pulling up and for that reason he dismounted. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a strain to the right fore superficial digital flexor tendon. First aid administered. Trainer, Mr G. Young, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

UNDERCOVER POET (W. Gordon) - made the seventh jump awkwardly.

All runners underwent a post-race veterinary examination which, with the exception of CASIRAGHI, revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: GAWLER CUP - 'TWILIGHT' FRIDAY OCT 25TH / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 2118 metres

FOXY AMBITION (K. Bishop) - laid in over the concluding stages of the event.

LYRICKIN'S DREAM (R. Clark) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

SILVER JEWEL (P. Gatt) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.



RACE 3: ADELAIDE PLAINS BLOODSTOCK / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1718 metres

ALIRIS (J. Chau) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Held up for clear running from the 600 metres until approaching the 400 metres. Laid out from the 400 metres until the 150 metres contacting RECOGNISE on two occasions.

LE DUPE (D. Tourneur) - rider explained that he was instructed to attempt to gain cover in today's event and after being slightly awkward away from a wide gate he elected to find cover behind RECOGNISE.

SMART MAHER (S. Fawke) - laid out from the 600 metres. In the vicinity of the 200 metres shifted out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RECOGNISE (B. Vorster) - contacted on two occasions in the straight by ALIRIS.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow B. Voster (RECOGNISE) placed second, to lodge an objection against ALIRIS (J. Chau) being declared the winner on the grounds of alleged interference from the entrance to the straight until the winning post. After considering the evidence, viewing the vision and acting on their own observations Stewards *dismissed* the objection.

RACE 4: PROPER CLEAN BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1718 metres

HAHNDORF (G. Lo) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LAST ONE NAMED (E. Boyd) - laid out in the straight.

JOCKS GLEN (R. Clark) - rider explained that her instructions were to push forward in today's event. Trainer, Mr D. O'Leary, confirmed these instructions were the same instructions provided to JOCKS GLEN's rider at most recent start. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: LYNDOCH MOTORS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

SPIRIT OF CHARM (J. Toeroek) – laid out and away from AMMO LOCO from the entrance to the straight until the 100 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SUMMER BLAZE (NZ) (K. Crowther) - lost its off fore plate during the event.

NEW TESTAMENT (T. Voorham) - raced greenly in the straight.

SIRIUS JOURNEY (E. Boyd) - laid out from the entrance to the straight.

WHITSUNDAY (A. Lindsay) - jumped away awkwardly. Laid out throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: COOPERS XPA CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1100 metres

RIZSKI (K. Lau) - shortly after the start raced in restricted room for a short distance between MEGNETIC ROSE, which shifted in slightly, and EQUIDAME. Laid out in the straight.

THE PUBLIKIN (J. Holder) - laid out from the 600 metres.



RACE 7: GOLDIN FARMS BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 2118 metres

SHAKOPEE (GB) (S. Logan) – shortly after the start got its head up whilst being restrained. Rider explained that her instructions were to settle back from the wide gate in today's event. She added that SHAKOPEE (GB) raced keenly in the early stages and did not finish the event off as she had expected. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer, Mr G. Young, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

CAROUN (IRE) (T. Voorham) - shortly after the start was taken in and across the heels of LORD ROSENTHAL by I'M BULLETPROOF and lost its position.

SPIEGEL GROVE (J. Holder) - laid in over the final 150 metres of the event.

I'M BULLETPROOF (P. Gatt) - on jumping away was takin in onto CAROUN by AMBISHOP. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Lost its near hind plate during the event.

SAMSTAG (R. Clark) - shifted in on jumping away onto AMBISHOP. Raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

AMBISHOP (J. Maund) - on jumping away was taken in onto I'M BULLETPROOF by SAMSTAG.

Correct weight was delayed to allow J. Holder (SPIEGEL GROVE) placed second, and trainer, Mr D. Magro, to view the official image for first.

RACE 8: HOLDFAST INSURANCE BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

SUNMATE (T. Pannell) - laid out in the straight.

THANASI (J. Toeroek) - shortly after the start shifted in and away from SPIRITED MATCH, which rolled in, tightening SCARE CAMPAIGN. Raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event. Trainer, Mr D. Koch, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its racing manners. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ARCTIC BLAZE (J. Holder) – obliged to be steadied at the 500 metres to avoid the heels of FAY'S JOY. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GRAVITY (D. Tourneur) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out taking MIA GIORGIA wider. Laid out in the straight.

MIA GEORGIA (G. Lo) - taken wider by GRAVITY at the start. Held up for clear running from the entrance to the straight until the 200 metres when it was obliged to shift to the inside of GRAVITY to obtain clear ground.

SCARE CAMPAIGN (P. Gatt) - shortly after the start lost its position when tightened between THANASI, which shifted in, and PANZER PRINCESS.

FAY'S JOY (S. Logan) - shifted out and away from MISS ELEGANCE at the 500 metres.

MISS ELEGANCE (T. Voorham) - taken wider at the 500 metres by SPIRITED MATCH.

SPIRITED MATCH (K. Lau) – rolled in shortly after the start. Laid out at the 500 metres taking MISS ELEGANCE wider. Laid out in the straight.
