**RACE 1: PORT PIRIE BUS SERVICE / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1396 metres**

**BEE JAAY** (J. Potter) - slow into stride. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Obligated to be restrained off heels in the vicinity of the 750 metres.

**COOL DESERT** (A. Lindsay) - over-raced in the middle stages of the event. Obligated to be restrained off heels in the vicinity of the 700 metres. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

**OBSERVANCE** (K. Bishop) - rider reported the mare did not handle the track surface in today's event.

**RACE 2: IAN'S WESTERN HOTEL BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1100 metres**

**KID FLASH** (E. Boyd) - rider reported that the gelding did not handle the track surface in today's event.

**KNOTTED** (S. Logan) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**PANDEIA** (J. Chau) - shifted in onto KNOTTED in the vicinity of the 850 metres. Rider reprimanded.

**SCENIC MINT** (L. Neindorf) - inclined to lay in, in the straight.

**RACE 3: PORT AUGUSTA REFRIGERATION BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1867 metres**

**BANRI DE HERO** (L. Neindorf) - saddle malfunctioned shortly after the start resulting in the rider losing his near side iron, placing him at a disadvantage throughout the event.

**UNCLE KENNETH (NZ)** (A. Lindsay) - shifted out in the vicinity of the 450 metres onto ZAALADD. Rider reprimanded.

**ZAALADD** (L. Goomany) - inconvenienced in the vicinity of the 450 metres when tightened onto GUEST LIST by UNCLE KENNETH (NZ), which shifted out.

**RACE 4: AUGUSTA BOTTLE & CAN RECYCLERS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres**

**ALL THINGS NICE** (K. Bishop) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**AUTUMN'S BEST** (S. Logan) - lost its near fore plate during the event.

**GWENT** (J. Potter) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

**RACE 5: THE FLINDERS HOTEL MOTEL BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1498 metres**

**FULTON STREET** (J. Chau) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**PARK BENCH (NZ)** (E. Boyd) - began awkwardly and was slow to begin. Held up for clear running from the vicinity of the 500 metres until the entrance to the straight.

**LEONARDA** (J. Potter) - laid in, in the straight.

**RACE 6: OFFICE NATIONAL CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1200 metres**

**REAL EASY** (L. Neindorf) - laid in, in the straight.

**DEXTER'S NIBBLE** (C. Lions) - rider reported that she had concerns with the gelding's action and for this reason she had elected not to push DEXTER'S NIBBLE out over the concluding stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**MISS FORBIDDEN** (S. Logan) - laid out in the straight.

**RACE 7: SKY & TASSIE TAVERN BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1396 metres**

**DOCTOR DOOLITTLE** (J. Chau) - shifted out in the vicinity of the 500 metres inconveniencing BRYBECK.

**BRYBECK** (G. Lo) - awkward to begin. Laid in, in the early stages of the event. Laid out rounding the home turn and in the vicinity of the 500 metres was inconvenienced when DOCTOR DOOLITTLE shifted out.

**GET IN THE BOWL** (J. Potter) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

**AY OH WHEY OH** (K. Bishop) - awkward to begin.
