RACE 1: HOLDFAST INSURANCE BROKERS / SABOIS FILLIES AND MARES MAIDEN PLATE
- 1100 Metres

ARCTIC FLORA (E. Finnegan) - slow to begin. Inside the 100 metres was disappointed when attempting a run between the heels of DRESSMAKER and JUST JILTED and was obliged to alter course to obtain clear ground.

FOXY AMBITION (M. Collett) - rider accidentally dropped her whip in the vicinity of the 400 metres.

DRESSMAKER (J. Toeroek) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid out under pressure over the concluding 200 metres, and inside the 100 metres shifted out onto ARCTIC FLORA. Rider explained it was not his intention to lead however, after the filly had jumped away well; it took up the lead of its own accord.

JUST JILTED (B. Vorster) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight. In the vicinity of the 100 metres shifted in onto ARCTIC FLORA.

RACE 2: COOPERS SESSION ALE / SABOIS COLTS, GELDINGS & ENTIRES MAIDEN PLATE
- 1100 Metres

CALL ME DEXTER (S. Logan) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

GREY FROG (D. Tourneur) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 2: COOPERS SESSION ALE / SABOIS COLTS, GELDINGS & ENTIRES MAIDEN PLATE
- 1100 Metres (Cont'd)

ALPHEUS (J. Holder) - contacted on jumping away.

FACTOROFHOTRACHAEL (B. Panicucci) - slow to begin.

JUST TREVA (R. Hurdle) - reared on jumping away and was slow into stride.

SPECIAL BOOM (C. Jones) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

RACE 3: TERRACE FUNCTION CENTRE / SABOIS TWO-YEARS-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1100
Metres

JUST ALLAN (K. Bishop) - shifted in abruptly on jumping away. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KAHAYLAAN (B. Vorster) - jumped away awkwardly.

REDENZO LAD (R. Hurdle) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SHELLSHOCKED (S. Cahill) - inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

BRAZEN HEAD (J. Potter) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

ULTIMATE ADDICTION (C. Lions) - laid out throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: ADELAIDE PLAINS BLOODSTOCK / SABOIS+ MAIDEN/ CLASS ONE PLATE - 2100
Metres

AMMO LOCO (S. Fawke) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

REBEL ROMANCE (J. Toeroek) - Co-Trainer Mr C. McEvoy advised Stewards prior to the event of a change in tactics that being he would instruct the rider to be more positive in the early stages in an attempt to take up a more forward position. Settled forward of mid-field.

WHYS (K. Zechner) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

GONDOLIER (E. Boyd) - jumped away awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: RACING, PACING, CHASING SHOW MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1500 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three minutes owing to a barrier attendant being kicked in the mounting yard and requiring medical attention.

MAGUS MAN (S. Logan) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

TYCOON BARNEY (C. Jones) - proved difficult to load. Trainer Ms S. Hayes was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: RACING, PACING, CHASING SHOW MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1500 Metres (Cont'd)

GOLDEN RIPPLES (T. Pannell) - rider explained he was instructed to take up a position dependant on how the filly jumped away. He stated that these instructions were consistent with his previous instructions provided on GOLDEN RIPPLES. He added in today's event the filly had jumped away much better than it had at its previous start and after encouraging it early, he made an assessment that due to the formation of the field, he would be caught wide, and it was for this reason he had continued to pressure GOLDEN RIPPLES and to obtain the lead. Trainer Mr C. Bieg confirmed that the instructions provided today were consistent with those provided at the filly's most recent starts.

EAST CAPE (S. Fawke) - slow into stride.

KEN'S THUNDER (S. Cahill) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced fiercely in the middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 700 metres clipped the heels of ZOULY, which shifted in slightly.

AUSSIE SOJOURN (D. Tourneur) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

ZOULY (B. Vorster) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Shifted in slightly in the vicinity of the 700 metres onto KEN'S THUNDER. Rider was reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised in future to make a greater effort to keep his mounts straight.

OH GEORGIA (M. Collett) - slow to begin. Inclined to shift about under pressure in the straight.

SHE'S DREAMING (A. Jordsjo) - slow to begin.

RACE 6: COOPERS XPA BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1500 Metres

ANCIENT HISTORY (IRE) (T. Pannell) - contacted by CRYPTO CURRENCY in the vicinity of the 200 metres.

CRYPTO CURRENCY (A. Jordsjo) - laid out under pressure in the straight. In the vicinity of the 200 metres shifted out and contacted ANCIENT HISTORY (IRE).

GIVEPEACE A CHANCE (E. Finnegan) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event and was wide without cover throughout.

CHAPPETTE (K. Crowther) - slow to begin. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

DOUBLE POCKETS (B. Vorster) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

EMMY AWARDS (C. Lions) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 7: G&J CIVIL BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

GALCRUM (J. Maund) - lost its off fore plate during the event.

SIR JOHNSON (E. Finnegan) - in the vicinity of the 600 metres had to be steadied when tightened between PIVOTAL FORCE, which shifted in slightly at the same time as COUNTER SPIN shifted out slightly. Disappointed in the vicinity of the 300 metres when attempting a tight run between the heels of CHEVITE and HE IS GOLDEN and became held up until in the vicinity of the 200 metres.

HE IS GOLDEN (D. Tourneur) - raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event.

SCARE CAMPAIGN (T. Voorham) - slow to begin.

RACE 7: G&J CIVIL BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres (Cont'd)

FERGIE (J. Holder) - inconvenienced in the vicinity of the 100 meters when MAIDEN GRACE shifted out.

MY LESSON (K. Zechner) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

SARAH'S JULE (J. Potter) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RUSTYDUSTYSUNSHINE (C. Jones) - laid in under pressure in the straight. In the vicinity of the 300 metres shifted in and contacted MAIDEN GRACE.

COUNTER SPIN (E. Boyd) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

MAIDEN GRACE (M. Collett) - in the vicinity of the 300 metres was contacted by RUSTYDUSTYSUNSHINE. Rolled out under pressure in the vicinity of the 100 metres onto FERGIE. Rider was reminded of her obligations under AR132(6)(c) and (d) in using her whip when her mounts are out of contention and showing no response.

CHEVITE (S. Fawke) - jumped away awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8: CORNERSTONE STUD STANDING SIR PRANCEALOT 0-58 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

GUCCI GUY (J. Holder) - laid out under pressure in the straight. Rider reported the gelding had never travelled and when placed under pressure, had not responded to his riding and had been disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

THE BLUES BROTHER (C. Jones) - momentarily held up at the entrance to the straight and was obliged to alter course to obtain clear ground.

GRAVITY (K. Crowther) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

TINNY BAR BLUE (E. Finnegan) - slow into stride.

CRY OUT LOUD (M. Collett) - jumped away awkwardly.
