Racecourse by the South Australia Jockey Club on
Saturday, 20 February 2021

RACE 1: PIKE & JOYCE HANDICAP - 1600 Metres

DEXTER YOU DEVIL (S. Metcalfe) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by S. Metcalfe and noted that she used it on two occasions over the final 100 metres.

RITRATTO (J. Eaton) - awkward and slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

VON COSTA GLASS (S. Logan) - inside the 1000 metres became awkward on the heels of FRANCE'S BOY for a number of strides as the pace slackened.

FRANCE'S BOY (S. Fawke) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.



RACE 1: PIKE & JOYCE HANDICAP - 1600 Metres (cont'd)

LOSTARC (D. Tourneur) – raced wide without cover from near the 1000 metres until in the vicinity of the 600 metres. When questioned regarding his riding in today's event rider explained that his instructions were to settle back; however, if the pace slackened at any stage to improve his position, take up a forward position and if possible lead. He added that when the pace slackened near the 1000 metres when racing behind DEXTER YOU DEVIL he improved to that horse's outside in an attempt to comply with his instructions and took up a forward position; however, when placed outside IRONCLAD (GB) near the 600 metres he formed the view that he would not be able to lead owing to the manner in which that gelding and RITRATTO, to its inside, were travelling and consequently, rather than being trapped wide without cover, he elected to take cover behind IRONCLAD (GB). Trainer, Mr R. Balfour, confirmed the instructions provided to D. Tourneur. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by D. Tourneur and noted that he used it on one occasion over the final 100 metres.

RACE 2: HOLDFAST INSURANCE HANDICAP - 1050 Metres

SWING AND BOOM (S. Logan) – laid out in the straight.

CHUCKY (T. Pannell) – rider explained that the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event; however, when placed under pressure at the entrance to the straight failed to respond to his riding. He added that the gelding made excess respiratory noises on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near hind leg. Trainer, Mr J. Pickering, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

RITORNO (R. Hurdle) – began very awkwardly, shifted in and hampered THREE TEARS, which was taken in onto ASTON RAPOVA.

THREE TEARS (S. So) – hampered shortly after the start by RITORNO, which shifted in, and as a consequence was taken in onto ASTON RAPOVA, which was inconvenienced. Near the 100 metres was inclined to lay out and shifted out under riding taking WOULD A THOUGHT SO wider. Rider reported that as a consequence of being hampered at the start she was unable to take up a more forward position as intended. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be lame in the off foreleg and to have a laceration to its off hind leg. Trainer, Mr P. Hardacre, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

ASTON RAPOVA (J. Toeroek) – inconvenienced at the start when taken in by THREE TEARS.

WOULD A THOUGHT SO (B. Vorster) – was taken wider near the 100 metres by THREE TEARS, which was inclined to lay out and shifted out under riding.

RACE 3: TAB ADELAIDE CUP DAY - MONDAY MARCH 8 HANDICAP SPRINT - 1100 Metres

ECHOES IN ETERNITY (J. Eaton) – rider reported that the filly chocked down in running and as a consequence failed to finish the event off in the manner expected. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WIDE AWAKE (T. Pannell) – awkward to begin. Approaching the 100 metres was disappointed for clear running when attempting to improve between MORPHETT ROAD and COOL MAGNUM, which laid in and shifted in. As a consequence the filly was unable to be tested for several strides. Thereafter approaching the finish again attempted a run between MORPHETT ROAD and COOL MAGNUM, brushed the hindquarters of COOL MAGNUM, was unable to obtain clear running and was untested to the line.

DAILY SPIRIT (S. Logan) – laid in, in the straight.

PIMM'S PARTY (J. Holder) – awkward to begin.

COOL MAGNUM (S. Fawke) – awkward and slow to begin. Raced very keenly in the early stages of the event. Shortly prior to the winning post had its hindquarters contacted and turned by WIDE AWAKE, which attempted to improve to its inside.



RACE 3: TAB ADELAIDE CUP DAY - MONDAY MARCH 8 HANDICAP SPRINT - 1100 Metres

PASSING PHASE (A. Jordsjo) – slow to begin.

RACE 4: BILL SWINTON 80TH HANDICAP RACE - 1050 Metres

MUSIC ADDITION (K. Zechner) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg. Trainer, Mr P. Gelagotis, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

IRISH MINT (J. Toeroek) – lost its off fore plate during the event.

TAKEN OFF (K. Crowther) – knuckled at the start. Lost its off hind plate during the event.

GINGER JONES (T. Pannell) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. Near the 700 metres was brushed by FLOSTAR, which shifted out slightly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PORT VALE (O. Ridge) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by O. Ridge and noted that he used it on two occasions over the final 100 metres of the event.

FLOSTAR (J. Eaton) – lost its near hind plate prior to the event and was required to be reshod. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start. Slow to begin. Near the 900 metres, when improving its position, was momentarily inconvenienced by LITTLE RICH BOY, which shifted in. Near the 700 metres shifted out slightly and brushed with GINGER JONES. Rider reported that the mare hung out badly during the event, did not let down and felt awkward in its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LITTLE RICH BOY (S. Metcalfe) – near the 900 metres shifted in and inconvenienced FLOSTAR. Rider was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

RACE 5: ZILZIE HANDICAP - 1800 Metres

LORD VLADIVOSTOK (NZ) (J. Eaton) – approaching the 700 metres was momentarily inconvenienced by CUBAN TOONITE, which shifted in and took its running, and was obliged to shift to the outside of that horse's heels. Approaching the 100 metres shifted out for a number of strides and shortly after being corrected shifted in abruptly near the 100 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be exhibiting signs of mild heat stress. First aid was administered. Trainer, Mr M. Hickmott, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its racing manners.

GRINZINGER STAR (NZ) (T. Pannell) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

NASEEB (B. Vorster) – tightened and inconvenienced shortly after the start. Over-raced in the early stages of the event. Eased out of the event by its rider shortly after the entrance to the straight. Rider explained that he had commenced to put the gelding under pressure from in the vicinity of the 700 metres; however, near the 600 metres was off the bridle and was momentarily inconvenienced between runners, and shortly thereafter the gelding weakened and failed to respond to his riding. He added that in his opinion the gelding showed signs of a respiratory condition. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have atrial fibrillation. Trainer, Ms S. Murphy, was advised that the results of an ECG are to be forwarded to the RacingSA Veterinary Surgeon and a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to the gelding performing satisfactorily in an Official Barrier Trial.

CUBAN TOONITE (P. Gatt) – approaching the 700 metres shifted in and inconvenience LORD VLADIVOSTOK (NZ).

STAN THE CADDY (K. Crowther) – shifted out shortly after the start onto NASEEB, which was tightened onto DREAMED.





RACE 5: ZILZIE HANDICAP - 1800 Metres (cont'd)

DREAMED (D. Tourneur) - was inconvenienced shortly after the start when taken wider by NASEEB.

MOTELL (K. Zechner) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

HOBO BOB (A. Jordsjo) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: ACCOLADE WINES HANDICAP - 1540 Metres

CALL ME SHAMUS (T. Pannell) - shifted out under riding over the concluding stages of the event taking the running of KYSHAKA, which had to be steadied to avoid that horse's heels. As a consequence KYSHAKA shifted out into the running of CALL ME ARCHER, which had to be restrained when awkward on the heels of KYSHAKA. As a further consequence CALL ME ARCHER shifted out onto TRUMPSTA, which was inconvenienced near the winning post. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) for shifting ground when not sufficiently clear.

CANFORD (D. Tourneur) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

ECHO BOOMER (S. Metcalfe) - became awkward in its stride approaching the 100 metres.

KYSHAKA (S. Logan) - over the concluding stages of the event was obliged to be steadied to avoid the heels of CALL ME SHAMUS, which shifted out.

BOLT BY (S. So) - lost its near hind plate during the event.

TRUMPSTA (P. Gatt) - awkward to begin. Inconvenienced near the winning post.

CALL ME ARCHER (R. Hurdle) - obliged to be restrained over the concluding stages of the event.

KALAMON (J. Maund) - awkward to begin, shifted out and contacted KYSHAKA. Raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

RACE 7: TERRY HOWE PRINTING HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

TULLYS GOLD (J. Eaton) - approaching the 600 metres was inconvenienced by the riderless horse (CALL ME DEXTER), which shifted out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.


BASTYAN (D. Tourneur) - shortly after the start S. Logan, the rider of CALL ME DEXTER, came into contact with this gelding for a number of strides after becoming unseated from her mount. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CALL ME DEXTER (S. Logan) - began awkwardly, as a result S. Logan contacted the outside of her barrier stall, became unbalanced, unseated and was dislodged. After being unseated from her mount S. Logan came into contact with BASTYAN for several strides. As a consequence of beginning awkwardly CALL ME DEXTER shifted out and hampered FOUR OF A KIND. S. Logan was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and ruled unfit to fulfil her remaining engagements.

ROSE TIARA (K. Crowther) - inside the 700 metres was taken wider by the riderless horse (CALL ME DEXTER) and was inconvenienced.

FOUR OF A KIND (S. So) - was severely hampered at the start by CALL ME DEXTER, which shifted out abruptly, and was unable to maintain its position and was obliged to shift out.

RACE 8: LORD REIMS STAKES - 2600 Metres



MONGOLIAN MARSHAL (NZ) (J. Toeroek) - was obliged to race in restricted room for several strides after passing the winning post on the first occasion when racing between MUSHAIREB (GB) and THE RED SEA, which shifted in to improve.



RACE 8: LORD REIMS STAKES - 2600 Metres (cont'd)

CHAROSSA (S. Metcalfe) - raced wide without cover in the early stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer, Mr G. Richards, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

FLOW METER (S. Fawke) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SOSTENIDO (NZ) (A. Jordsjo) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to start. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TARN'S PRINCE (K. Crowther) - rider reported that her instructions were to begin neutral and she considered she was likely to settle on pace. She stated that after beginning neutral the gelding appeared dour and was off the bridle and as a consequence she was obliged to settle further back than intended.

THE RED SEA (S. So) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by S. So and noted that she used it on five occasions over the final 100 metres of the event. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(6)(c) in that she used her whip when her mount was out of contention and was fined \$200.

RACE 9: FURPHY HANDICAP - 1600 Metres

ICE GHOST (S. Metcalfe) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

UNLACED (NZ) (J. Eaton) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

ICECRUSHER (R. Hurdle) - reared at the start and was very awkward to begin.

LA RICHESSE (T. Pannell) - laid out in the straight.

KORODON (NZ) (J. Toeroek) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.
