Report on Race Meeting held at Penola Racecourse by the Penola Racing Club on Wednesday, 24 February 2021

RACE 1: TDC LIVESTOCK AND PROPERTY BENCHMARK 68 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

BROBAK (B. Price) - hung out throughout the event.

FERGIE (S. So) - slow to begin.

RACE 2: ADRIAN THOMAS INDUSTRIAL BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 2100 Metres

BRONSKI (C. Jones) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CHALLICUM (K. Crowther) - when guestioned rider explained that in her opinion the horse has come to the end of its campaign and will appreciate a spell. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ENBARR (S. So) - shifted in near the 1700 metres when insufficiently clear of CENTENARY SHOT, resulting in that gelding tightening LOVE FROM LUCY, which had to be steadied. Rider severely reprimanded for careless riding under AR131(a).

CENTENARY SHOT (K. Zechner) - tightened near the 1700 metres.

LOVE FROM LUCY (S. Fawke) - tightened and had to be steadied near the 1700 metres. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by S. Fawke and noted that he used it on three occasions over the final 100 metres of the event.

RACE 3: FINNS FINE FOODS MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

BARNACLES (J. Opperman) - slow to begin. Laid in, in the straight.

CASE CLOSED (S. Metcalfe) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.







RACE 3: FINNS FINE FOODS MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1100 Metres (cont'd)

HOOKED ON JIMMY (A. Jordsjo) - raced greenly throughout.

AIR TIME (J. Eaton) – raced keenly approaching the first turn and near the 800 metres had to be steadied off the back of GOLDEN RIPPLES, shifted out and bumped GOLDRHUM. Attempted to push outwards rounding the home turn from behind TEESHA and in doing so bumped GOLDRHUM on several occasions. Rider was issued with a reprimand.

GOLDRHUM (J. Maund) – slow to begin. Bumped near the 800 metres and again on several occasions rounding the home turn.

RACE 4: PENOLA CUP DAY - SUNDAY 4 APRIL THREE-YEARS-OLD AND OVER MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 Metres

ALLGO (J. Eaton) - got its head down just prior to the start and as a result was slow to begin.

EVER ONWARD (P. Gatt) – jumped awkwardly and shortly after clipped the heels of SALUTE THE CANNONS, stumbled and lost ground. Raced wide from the 800 metres.

SALUTE THE CANNONS (J. Opperman) – jumped awkwardly, stumbled and shifted in. When questioned in relation to the horse's performance rider explained that after beginning very awkwardly he felt that the horse may have injured itself at the start and was concerned with its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

YOUNG LUCAS (K. Bohorun) - very awkward to begin and lost considerable ground.

LEWANDOWSKI (D. Tourneur) - hung in from the 600 metres.

LADY JEUNE (A. Jordsjo) - raced wide from the 900 metres.

ROBYN'S FOLLY (S. Fawke) - when questioned in regards to the performance of ROBYN'S FOLLY rider explained that his mount travelled well up to the 600 metres; however, when placed under pressure failed to respond to his riding and was unable to offer any excuse. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: TAB CLASS 2 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

GRIMESY (K. Zechner) – slow to begin. Near the 50 metres was contacted by WILD WILLY, which shifted out.

OUR BOY BAILEY (S. Wiseman) - laid in, in the straight.

WILD WILLY (J. Holder) - shifted out near the 100 metres when insufficiently clear of WAR CHEVAL, resulting in that horse having to be eased. Rider was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground in future. Continued to shift out and near the 50 metres made contact with GRIMESY.

WAR CHEVAL (S. Fawke) – near the 100 metres had to be steadied away from the heels of WILD WILLY, which shifted out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

COMIENDO (J. Opperman) - laid in, in the straight.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow K. Zechner (GRIMESY) placed third, to view the vision in the early stages of the event.

RACE 6: COOPERS BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1300 Metres



CHU CHARLIE (D. Tourneur) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not raced since November 2018 and was passed fit to start. Jumped awkwardly, shifted in and bumped ROYAL MILE.

RACE 6: COOPERS BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1300 Metres (cont'd)

WILD COLONIAL BOY (P. Gatt) – hung in approaching the 150 metres, and shortly after had to be steadied away from the heels of LONGMIRE, which shifted out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MANHATTAN ARCH (J. Eaton) – shifted out slightly near the 150 metres. Bumped by ROYAL MILE shortly after passing the winning post.

LONGMIRE (B. Price) – raced wide throughout the event. Laid in, in the straight and near the 150 metres was steadied away from the heels of MANHATTAN ARCH, which shifted out slightly. Crowded and bumped between MANHATTAN ARCH and CANIDAE, shortly after passing the winning post.

CANIDAE (S. Fawke) – bumped shortly after passing the winning post.

ROYAL MILE (J. Opperman) – shifted out at the start and bumped CHU CHU CHARLIE. Raced greenly when placed under pressure in the straight. Shifted out over the concluding stages around DISSOLUTE and became unbalanced.

Correct weight was delayed to allow J. Opperman (ROYAL MILE), placed second, to view the official vision.

RACE 7: DIGIORGIO FAMILY WINES BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

DEFORCE (J. Maund) – shifted out abruptly at the start.

KLIPPEN (J. Holder) – shifted in at the start. Held up momentarily behind MAGICHELL rounding the home turn and entering the straight.

MAGICHELL (J. Opperman) - jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin.

RANGER CEE JAY (K. Crowther) – shifted out under pressure in the straight.

ATUM (J. Eaton) – crowded between horses at the start. Eased slightly near the 200 metres away from TECOFSKY, which shifted out.

AVID GENERAL (A. Jordsjo) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

GEANDGE (D. Tourneur) - shifted out at the start and crowded ATUM onto TECOFSKY.

BULLET KID (S. So) - dislodged its rider behind the barriers. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start. S. So was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and passed fit to fulfil her engagement. Jumped awkwardly, was slow to begin and was then hampered by KLIPPEN which shifted in. Hung in, in the straight, proved difficult to ride and over the concluding stages became awkward, close to the heels of RANGER CEE JAY.

TECOFSKY (S. Wiseman) – crowded between horses at the start and lost ground. Rider advised it was her intention to be more forward in the race however was she unable to achieve that position as a result of the start. Shifted outwards abruptly when placed under pressure near the 200 metres.

RACE 8: THE MIDFIELD GROUP BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1700 Metres

DAVEEDO (B. Price) – when racing keenly between the 1500 metres and 1350 metres was buffeted between FOUR OUTLAWS and SADUKA, and as a consequence lost ground. Continued to race keenly until the middle stages of the event and raced wide for the majority of the event.

FOUR OUTLAWS (J. Holder) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event and shifted ground.



HASTA LA DREAMS (D. Tourneur) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

RACE 8: THE MIDFIELD GROUP BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1700 Metres (cont'd)

SADUKA (K. Crowther) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event, and near the 1350 metres had to be steadied when racing tight between O'MIZZNA and DYADAMO, which shifted in slightly. Raced wide for the majority of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

STRYKER STAR (S. So) – dislodged its rider en route to the barriers. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start. S. So was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and passed fit to fulfil her engagement.

BASSONS (J. Eaton) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

SKILLING (A. Jordsjo) – finished a distant last. Trainer, Mr D. Saxon, advised that it was his intention to retire the horse.
