## RACE 1: DUTTON'S EASY TO DO BUSINESS WITH!! STEEPLECHASE - 3360 Metres

All runners underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and were passed fit to start.

SEARAVEN (C. McCarthy) - made the fifth jump awkwardly and was eased from the event. Rider reported that after making the fifth jump awkwardly the gelding felt extremely uncomfortable in its action and for that reason he had eased it from the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer, Mr B. Brook, was advised that Stewards would refer the performance to the Jumps Review Panel for assessment.



### RACE 1: DUTTON'S EASY TO DO BUSINESS WITH!! STEEPLECHASE - 3360 Metres (cont'd)

HISTORIC (NZ) (S. Pateman) - after making the fifth jump had to be steadied to avoid SEARAVEN, which shifted in abruptly when being eased from the event. Eased out of the event at the entrance to the straight. Rider reported that the gelding felt like it had faltered at the entrance to the straight, and for this reason he had elected to ease from the event prior to making the eighth jump. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer, Mr S. Pateman, was advised that Stewards would refer the performance to the Jumps Review Panel for assessment.

PENTELLIGENTSIA (NZ) (T. Ryan) - slow to begin.

ONCE WERE LOST (IRE) (L. Horner) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

All runners underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no further visible abnormalities.

### RACE 2: WEDDINGS @ BRIDGES EVENT CENTRE HURDLE - 3360 Metres

All runners underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and were passed fit to start.

BUCKEYE NATION (B. Small) - made the sixth jump awkwardly.

MASTER POET (NZ) (L. Horner) - made the eighth jump awkwardly and shifted in onto ARISTOCAT.

MAZAZ (IRE) (N. Newton) - made the first jump awkwardly, shifted in and lost ground.

JACK IN THE DITCH (R. Short) - made the third jump awkwardly.

ARISTOCAT (D. McLeod) - rider accidentally dropped his whip near the 50 metres. Stewards questioned the rider in relation to his riding of this gelding over the concluding 50 metres of the event. After considering his explanation Stewards charged D. McLeod under AR131(b) in that he failed to ride his horse out to the end of the race. D. McLeod pleaded guilty and was fined \$200.

All runners underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no visible abnormalities.

### RACE 3: IRONGATE MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

UTAH JOE (P. Gatt) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

RUSTY HALO (S. Metcalfe) - laid out under pressure in the straight. Rider accidentally dropped her whip inside the 200 metres.

LEANNA BELLE (J. Toeroek) - reared on jumping away and was slow to begin.

THE TRANCE FACTOR (C. Jones) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow into stride.

COURAGEOUS HEARTS (F. Atkinson) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until near the 200 metres. Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages of the event.

RUBY ANGEL (J. Maund) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

SAMURAI SUN (NZ) (T. Pannell) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.





### RACE 3: IRONGATE MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 Metres (cont'd)

WITNESS AWARD (B. Vorster) – trainer, Mr T. Doudle, was reprimanded under AR65 for failing to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card (TIC) for WITNESS AWARD. The colt was permitted to start as it was able to be identified from records held by the Stewards. Mr. Doudle was advised that he would be required to produce the TIC prior to a future race start. Stood flat footed and was slow to begin. Rider could offer no explanation for the colt's performance; however, was of the opinion that it would benefit from the race experience. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a small abrasion to the offside of its forehead.

STELAE (A. Jordsjo) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not raced in over twelve months and was passed fit to start.

SHE'S ESTELLE (K. Zechner) – proved difficult to load. Trainer, Mr R. Balfour, was advised that a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to its barrier manners.

### RACE 4: MAGIC MILLIONS MAIDEN PLATE - 1600 Metres

EM BRYAN (K. Crowther) – held up from the entrance to the straight until in the vicinity of the 150 metres, and then had difficulty obtaining clear ground over the final stages of the event. Accidentally struck by the whip of M. Aitken in the vicinity of the 80 metres.

FINAL PRINCE (R. Hurdle) – shifted out and away from SOUMAH on jumping away.

CHRYSOS (B. Vorster) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

SEMYORKA (D. Tourneur) – hung in throughout the event. Raced wide without cover.

CLUB QUEEN (J. Potter) – from the entrance to the straight until near the 200 metres was held up. Near the 200 metres was forced to be steadied to avoid the heels of JUST JAZZ. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FUNCKIA (T. Pannell) – shifted in shortly after the start and brushed with JUST JAZZ for a short distance.

RUPPAPUMPUM (NZ) (M. Vassallo) – jumped away awkwardly and was slow in to stride.

SUGAR WITH THAT (A. Jordsjo) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

AMBER HAZE (J. Eaton) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out contacting JUST JAZZ.

JUST JAZZ (S. Metcalfe) – contacted on jumping away. Shortly after the start shifted in slightly and brushed with FUNCKIA for a short distance. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 200 metres rider allowed her mount to shift in onto CLUB QUEEN, which was forced to be steadied. Rider was severely reprimanded and advised in future to make a greater effort to keep her mounts straight when they commence to shift ground.

GUNFIREINTHECITY (E. Wong) – inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight and had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until near the 200 metres.

### RACE 5: CARLTON DRAUGHT BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP- 2500 Metres

REX GOLIATH (E. Wong) – jumped away awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LION'S SHARE (P. Gatt) – jumped away awkwardly. Rider dismounted on pulling up. Rider explained that the horse was disappointing in the straight when placed under pressure and on pulling up he formed the view that it had tied up in its hindquarters, and for that reason he had dismounted. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LUTZ (J. Toeroek) – inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight. Rider reported that the gelding hung in throughout the event.



RACE 5: CARLTON DRAUGHT BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP- 2500 Metres (cont'd)

CAPTAIN HARRY (F. Atkinson) - from the vicinity of the 800 metres until near the 600 metres lost ground when it became awkwardly placed on the heels of REX GOLIATH, which commenced to give ground.

BEACH GOD (E. Annells) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event, and approaching the finish post on the first occasion eased and altered course to obtain additional galloping room. Raced wide without cover for the remainder of the event. From the vicinity of the 200 metres until near the 100 metres raced in restricted room to the inside of EXALTED AMBITION.

M'LADY LOIS (B. Price) - Jumped away awkwardly and was slow into stride. Stewards questioned trainer, Mr L. Cadzow, in relation to the late arrival on course of M'LADY LOIS. After considering his explanation Mr Cadzow was reprimanded and advised that a future breach may result in a penalty being imposed.

RACE 6: CARLTON DRAUGHT MURRAY BRIDGE GOLD CUP - 15TH OCTOBER!! BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

MAGIC PHANTOM (B. Price) - inclined to hang out rounding the turn from the vicinity of the 600 metres until the entrance to the straight. Became held up when awkwardly placed on the heels of RIZSKI from the vicinity of the 200 metres until near the 100 metres.

FIRST REWARD (K. Crowther) - Stewards questioned trainer, Ms S. Hayes, in relation to the late arrival on course of FIRST REWARD. After considering her explanation Ms Hayes was reprimanded and advised that a future breach may result in a penalty being imposed.

LA RAPIDE (J. Eaton) - stood flat footed and was slow to begin. Trainer, Mr A. Clarcken, was advised that a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to its barrier manners.

CIBACHROME (K. Zechner) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 7: BRIDGES EVENT CENTRE CLASS ONE HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

EVER ONWARD (P. Gatt) - lost its position on jumping away when tightened onto CALL ME ARCHER by PICAROON. In the vicinity of the 600 metres was hampered when contacted by DOMESDAY MAGIC and taken out onto CALL ME ARCHER.

SUPER LOOKA (T. Pannell) - in the vicinity of the 1000 metres had to be steadied away from the heels of MAGUS MAN, which was taken out.

PICAROON (E. Wong) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto EVER ONWARD. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

WHISKEY 'N' WOMEN (D. Tourneur) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

CALL ME ARCHER (R. Hurdle) - lost its position on jumping away when taken in onto EVER ONWARD by MAGUS MAN. In the vicinity of the 1000 metres rolled out and away from INDIAN MO, onto MAGUS MAN. In the vicinity of the 600 metres was forced to race in restricted room for a number of strides when contacted by EVER ONWARD, which was taken out.

WYNTER LADY (J. Potter) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out into the running line of YOUNG LARS. Held up from the vicinity of the 500 metres until near the 300 metres.

SHY BOY (K. Crowther) - in the vicinity of the 600 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of CALL ME ARCHER, which was taken out.

ST JUST (NZ) (F. Atkinson) - inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

INDIAN MO (E. Annells) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

YOUNG LARS (A. Jordsjo) - slow to begin and then shortly after clipped the heels of WYNTER LADY, which shifted out. Raced fiercely for a short distance approaching the 1000 metres.



RACE 7: BRIDGES EVENT CENTRE CLASS ONE HANDICAP - 1400 Metres (cont'd)

DOMESDAY MAGIC (D. Tootell (Snr)) - jumped away awkwardly. Approaching the 600 metres rolled out onto EVER ONWARD, which was taken out.

MAGUS MAN (J. Maund) - shifted in on jumping away onto CALL ME ARCHER. In the vicinity of the 1000 metres shifted out and away from CALL ME ARCHER onto SUPER LOOKA.

RACE 8: HAPPY 70TH BIRTHDAY BERNIE MULLINS BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1800 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

LE DUPE (J. Potter) - had to be removed from the barrier after being loaded to have its cross-over noseband readjusted.

LOLLIELUCAS (M. Aitken) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course and was passed fit to start.

ARTHURAS (C. Jones) - at the entrance to the straight shifted out in an attempt to improve and in doing so inconvenienced BACK POCKET, which tightened onto LORD ROSENTHAL.

SEMINOLES (NZ) (A. Jordsjo) - inconvenienced near the 1400 metres when it had its hindquarters turned after being contacted by BALDY.

BALDY (F. Atkinson) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto ARMAMENT. Near the 1400 metres was taken in onto SEMINOLES (NZ) by BACK POCKET. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until near the 100 metres.

RIPPA EAGLE (NZ) (B. Vorster) - in the vicinity of the 1400 metres shifted in onto LORD ROSENTHAL, taking that runner in. Rider was reprimanded. Eased out of the event from the vicinity of the 200 metres. Rider reported that the gelding put in a number of awkward strides from the vicinity of the 700 metres and he became concerned with its action on entering the straight, and for that reason he had elected to ease the gelding from the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a higher than expected heart rate.

A KNIGHT IN PARIS (R. Hurdle) - slow to begin.

AUSSIE SOJOURN (D. Tourneur) - slow to begin.

BUT BEAUTIFUL (E. Boyd) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

NEAR MAGIC (J. Maund) - slow to begin.

BACK POCKET (T. Pannell) - near the 1400 metres was taken in onto BALDY by LORD ROSENTHAL.

LORD ROSENTHAL (E. Wong) - near the 1400 metres was taken in onto BACK POCKET by RIPPA EAGLE (NZ). Contacted by BACK POCKET rounding the home turn.

RACE 9: RIVERSCAPE FOOD & WINE CHRISTMAS CUP 5TH DECEMBER BENCHMARK 54  
HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

PALE ALE (B. Price) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RISING THUNDER (J. Eaton) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RONNIE (J. Potter) - shifted out shortly after the start onto PARISIANS. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CIRCUS DANCER (C. Jones) - inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

SPEARS (E. Wong) - raced in restricted room from the vicinity of the 300 metres until near the 200 metres between the heels of ZOUSTORM and PALE ALE.

RACE 9: RIVERSCAPE FOOD & WINE CHRISTMAS CUP 5TH DECEMBER BENCHMARK 54  
HANDICAP - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

SHARPLY ATTIRED (S. Metcalfe) - inconvenienced near the 200 metres when taken out into the running line of AZZURO BIANCO by JAC JAC JACQUI, which shifted out to improve. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ROYAL BOWER (K. Crowther) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course and was passed fit to start. Lost its position on jumping away when contacted by PARISIANS, which was taken out by RONNIE. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until near the 300 metres.

JACJAC JACQUI (J. Toeroek) - in the vicinity of the 200 metres shifted out in an attempt to improve and in doing so inconvenienced SHARPLY ATTIRED, which was taken out into the running line of AZZURO BIANCO. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) for careless riding.

AZZURO BIANCO (E. Annells) - became awkwardly placed on the heels of JACJAC JACQUI near the 600 metres for a number of strides. In the vicinity of the 200 metres was forced to be steadied to avoid the heels of SHARPLY ATTIRED, which was taken out.

PARISIANS (K. Zechner) - lost its position on jumping away when taken out onto ROYAL BOWER by RONNIE.
