Racing SA Ltd Stipendiary Stewards' Report

Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Parks Racecourse by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 25 September 2021

<u>RAIL:</u> Out 7 metres 1000 metres to the winning post, out 4 metres remainder. Sectional 609 metres.

RACE 1: SPRING RACING CARNIVAL AT MORPHETTVILLE - OCT. 9 - NOV 6 HANDICAP - 1550 Metres

WHEELS OF COURAGE (R. Hurdle) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

MAX FIRE (B. Price) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

SHABALALA (B. Vorster) - slow into stride.

MAN OF HEART (J. Eaton) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Hung in under pressure in the straight and proved difficult for its rider to ride out in her normal manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ABIT RATTLEY (J. Maund) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 2: FURPHY HANDICAP - 1550 Metres

CHAPEL CITY (T. Voorham) - shortly after the start was restrained from its wide barrier and shifted in to take up a position at the rear of the field on the rail.

RACE 2: FURPHY HANDICAP - 1550 Metres (Cont'd)

FRANCE'S BOY (A. Jordsjo) – inside the 100 metres rolled out. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip A. Jordsjo and noted that she used it on two occasions over the concluding 100 metres of the event.

SIGN OF USSURI (B. Vorster) - hung in from approaching the 700 metres until the finish and proved difficult for the rider to ride out in the straight.

MAGNETIC EDGE (J. Maund) – inside the 100 metres raced in restricted room between PERFECT ROUTE and FRANCE'S BOY, which rolled out and as a result, the gelding was not fully tested to the line.

RACE 3: G.H. MUMM THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 Metres

CHARM SLINGA (NZ) (C. Murray) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow into stride. Raced ungenerously throughout the event.

COURAGEOUS HEARTS (T. Voorham) – shortly after the entrance to the straight, commenced to hang in and near the 200 metres shifted in onto SON OF AKEED, which was obliged to be steadied and lost its position when tightened onto CHASING STARS despite the efforts of the rider. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised in future to make a greater effort.

GRINZINGER PRINCE (B. Vorster) - slow into stride.

SON OF AKEED (D. Caboche) - rider stated prior to the event that his instructions from Trainer Mr P. Caboche were to attempt to lead in this event. Settled mid-field. Near the 200 metres was obliged to be steadied and lost its position when tightened onto CHASING STARS as COURAGEOUS HEARTS, which was hanging in, shifted in.

CHASING STARS (S. Metcalfe) – en route to the barriers took charge of its rider and ended up in the vicinity of the 1200 metres on the main track and was returned behind the barriers. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to race. Co-Trainer Mr D. Moyle was advised a warning had been placed on the filly in relation to its pre-race behaviour. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LEGLESS LADY (J. Eaton) – jumped away awkwardly and lost ground. Rider reported that the filly did not feel comfortable in its action during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: THE JUNCTION HANDICAP - 2250 Metres

SLIPINTOTHIS (NZ) (J. Eaton) - rider reported the gelding may not have handled today's track conditions.

EXALTED AMBITION (B. Price) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers on request from its rider and was passed fit to race. Hung out under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

NORDIC SYMPHONY (J. Holder) – inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SANTELMO FUEGO (D. Tourneur) – held up for clear running from inside the 600 metres until shortly after the entrance to the straight, when racing between NORDIC SYMPHONY and EXALTED AMBITION and shifted to the inside of that gelding, near the 300 metres to obtain clear ground.



FLOW METER (E. Finnegan) - in accordance with AR78 underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course and was passed fit to race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: DOMINANT HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

HARD RANSOM (P. Gatt) – hung in under pressure in the straight. Rider reported the gelding did not feel comfortable in its action over the concluding stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GARRIRE (S. Metcalfe) - hung out under pressure in the straight.

ATTACK THE PIN (S. Logan) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: PIKE & JOYCE HANDICAP - 1250 Metres

GIGGLON (S. Logan) - on jumping away shifted out and bumped TUBBY TWO TRACKS. Raced ungenerously in the early stages of the event and got its head up on a number of occasions when being restrained.

HANKSTAR (S. Metcalfe) Trainer, Mr P. Nolan advised Stewards prior to the event of a change in tactics in that he would instruct his rider to attempt to be more forward. Settled in the box seat. Raced ungenerously in the early stages of the event and got its head up on a number of occasions when being restrained.

TUBBY TWO TRACKS (D. Caboche) - on jumping away bumped with GIGGLON, which shifted out.

RACE 7: BAROSSA FINE FOODS HANDICAP - 1300 Metres

STAR OF UMA (B. Price) - shortly after the start, rolled in.

STAY GOLD (B. Vorster) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MONA DREAM (G. Lo) - jumped away awkwardly and shortly after was inconvenienced as STAR OF UMA rolled in. From shortly after entering the straight, commenced to lay out and near the 200 metres, shifted out abruptly and continued to lay out for the remainder of the event.

GRINZINGER STRASSE (NZ) (E. Finnegan) Trainer, Ms K. Byrnes notified Stewards prior to the event of a change in tactics, in that she will instruct her rider to attempt to settle further back and not lead. Settled mid to back. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

WURLIES LASTCHANCE (D. Caboche) - on jumping away was taken out by EUROGEM.

COMFORT GIRL (C. Murray) - held up for clear running from shortly after the entrance to the straight until approaching the 200 metres.

EUROGEM (K. Zechner) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto WURLIES LASTCHANCE.

ISSARA (S. So) - inside the 600 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of WURLIES LASTCHANCE and shifted out.

RACE 8: GRAND SYNDICATES - SUPPORTING SA RACING HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

TAKEN OFF (G. Lo) - laid out from the 150 metres and for the reminder of the event. At the finish rolled out.

LARKHAM (D. Tourneur) - on jumping away dipped and rolled in taking IDEAS MAN in. From the 200 metres was inclined to lay in and near the 50 metres, rolled in and was momentarily inconvenienced. At the finish was steadied as TAKEN OFF rolled out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



IDEAS MAN (K. Crowther) - on jumping away was taken in by LARKHAM. Over-raced during the event.

RACE 8: GRAND SYNDICATES - SUPPORTING SA RACING HANDICAP - 1000 Metres (Cont'd)

LOHN RANGER (S. Metcalfe) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

KILOWATT (D. Caboche) - Stewards permitted D. Caboche to ride the filly 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54kg.

RACE 9: WESLO SECURITY HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

COPPER FOX (M. Aitken) - approaching the 200 was inconvenienced as TURN TABLE, which was weakening, ROLLED OUT.

REALEZA (B. Vorster) - near the 150 metres was inconvenienced as MORIALTA rolled in.

ANGASTON (G. Lo) - approaching the 100 metres rolled out and inconvenienced MAVETTE.

CROWN MINT (J. Holder) - near the 200 metres had difficulty obtaining clear ground for a short distance.

MORIALTA (J. Opperman) - near the 150 metres rolled in.

MAVETTE (J. Maund) – approaching the 100 metres was inconvenienced as ANGASTON rolled out.

TURN TABLE (K. Crowther) – approaching the 200 metres commenced to weaken, rolled out and momentarily inconvenienced COPPER FOX. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.
