

Racing SA Ltd Stipendiary Stewards' Report

Report on Race Meeting held at Bordertown
Racecourse by the Bordertown Racing Club on
Friday, 29 October 2021

RACE 1: TASCO BENCHMARK 68 HANDICAP - 1550 Metres

BRONSKI (E. Annells) - when questioned regarding the improved performance of gelding compared to its first up last at Penola on Sunday, 10 October 2021, co-trainer, Mr J. Jaensch, stated that the only explanation he could offer was that the gelding was suited by the additional race fitness derived from that run, as well as being stepped up in distance to the 1550 metres. He further stated that at its first up performance BRONSKI was disadvantaged by suffering interference in the middle stages and had gotten back further than expected.

KILOWATT (S. Metcalfe) - over-raced in the early and middle stages.

RACE 2: MCCARTHY TRANSPORT BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 2000 Metres

MULGA LIL (NZ) (J. Opperman) - rider reminded of his obligations under AR132(6)(b) not to use his whip with an action that raised his arm above shoulder height.

KEYSOR (S. Metcalfe) - rider explained that her saddle commenced to shift forward from approaching the 1200 metres, placing her at a disadvantage. She added that whilst it was not her intention to assume the lead she had no other option than to allow her mount to proceed around the field and take up the lead shortly after that point. She further stated that approaching the 500 metres she lost the use of both irons and was therefore placed at a further disadvantage in the run to the finish.

WHITCHETY GRUB (P. Gatt) - rider reminded of his obligations under AR132(6)(b) not to use his whip with an action that raised his arm above shoulder height.



RACE 3: BORDER AG THREE-YEARS-OLD AND OVER MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1550 Metres

THIRTY TWO GUNS (A. Jordsjo) - slow to begin.

DESERT HERO (E. Boyd) - slow to begin. Rider stated that with the apparent lack of pace in the race, after her mount was slow to begin she elected from her wide barrier rather than be trapped wide in the early and middle stages. She added that the gelding laid out from the 600 metres and proved difficult to ride. Rider reminded of her obligations under AR132(6)(b) not to use her whip with an action that raised her arm above shoulder height.

ROYAL GISELLE (K. Crowther) - when questioned regarding the performance of the mare rider explained that ROYAL GISELLE after receiving a bump from MUSICALLY GIFTED, which commenced to tire passing the 500 metres, became unbalanced and did not respond to her riding from this point on and was disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MAVEN MISSILE (K. Zechner) - laid out under pressure in the straight. Rider reminded of his obligations under AR132(6)(b) not to use his whip with an action that raised his arm above shoulder height.

MUSICALLY GIFTED (NZ) (B. Price) - when questioned regarding the disappointing performance of the mare, rider explained that MUSICALLY GIFTED (NZ) was somewhat slow into stride and when there was no apparent pace in the race, he allowed his mount to stride forward and take up a position closer than he had anticipated, as opposed to being trapped wide without cover in the early stages. He added that the mare was under pressure from the 600 metres and did not respond to his riding from there on. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the off hind leg and with lacerations to that leg. First aid administered. Trainer, Mr T. Doudle, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

PAINTED ON (J. Potter) - rider reminded of his obligation under AR 131(b), to ride his mounts out to the finish.

SALSBURY HILL (K. Walters) - had to be steadied away from the heels of MUSICALLY GIFTED (NZ) passing the 500 metres.

RACE 4: DOAN PHARMACIES THREE-YEARS-OLD AND OVER MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres

BOOROOL FLYER (B. Price) - jumped away awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg and to have lacerations to that leg. First aid administered. Trainer, Mr L. Jarvis, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

DETNAW (D. Tourneur) - bumped with WITCHEL near the 700 metres due to both horses shifting ground.

FIOURUKI (K. Sardelic) - rider reported that the gelding hung out throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.


DISCO TILMORN (K. Crowther) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out hampering MARVEL STAR.

PHILLYVONNE (E. Boyd) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out hampering KEETTOM.

TOO LATE (K. Zechner) - shifted out at the start and contacted WITCHEL.

WITCHEL (A. Jordsjo) - contacted at the start by TOO LATE, which shifted out. Bumped with DETNAW near the 700 metres.





RACE 4: DOAN PHARMACIES THREE-YEARS-OLD AND OVER MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres

MARVEL STAR (M. Collett) – had to be checked on jumping away when DISCO TILMORN shifted out, resulting in its rider become unbalanced. MARVEL STAR then commenced to hang in severely and passing the 900 metres struck the running rail for some distance, then shifted in and had to be steadied away from the heels of KEETTOM. Continued to hang in severely throughout resulting in the rider being unable to control the filly. Near the 100 metres contacted the running rail resulting in its rider being dislodged. Co-trainer, Mr G. Kent, was advised that MARVEL STAR was now required to perform to the Stewards' satisfaction in two consecutive Official Barrier Trials prior to a future race start. A post-race veterinary examination after the event and again later in the day, revealed no visible abnormalities. Mr G. Kent was further advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start. M. Collett was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and passed fit to fulfil her remaining engagement.

KEETTOM (E. Annells) – hampered on jumping away when PHILLYVONNE jumped awkwardly and shifted out. Rider reported that after being held up at the entrance to the straight KEETTOM raced greenly and was reluctant to proceed between runners, and for this reason she elected to alter course back to the inside, to continue into clear running approaching the 200 metres.

RACE 5: BORDERTOWN PUMPS & REFRIGERATION BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

RHYTHMATIC (A. Livesey) – reared on jumping away and lost approximately two lengths.

BARACONI (P. Gatt) – briefly held up for some distance passing the 200 metres.

GYPSY CROWN (K. Crowther) – rider reported that the mare hung out throughout the event and proved difficult to ride, particularly rounding the home turn and over the final stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DASKULYA (S. Logan) – hung out rounding the home turn and in the straight resulting in its rider being unable to fully test it to the finish.

RACE 6: ADELAIDE GALVANISING INDUSTRIES BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1300 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately ten minutes owing to B. Price being kicked by MISS MOSH in the mounting yard. B. Price was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and ruled unfit to fulfil his engagement.

SHOCK ALERT (NZ) (E. Annells) – had to be steadied when tightened for room approaching the 50 metres between ENZED BEER (NZ), which laid out under pressure, and RUNBRO, which shifted in slightly.

ENZED BEER (NZ) (S. Metcalfe) – laid out under pressure in the straight.

ANNIKA (P. Gatt)- held up for clear running from the 400 metres until passing the 200 metres. Laid out for a short distance thereafter.

HURRICANE SONNY (A. Livesey) – had difficulty obtaining clear running for some distance passing the 250 metres until passing the 100 metres.

MISS MOSH (K. Sardelic) – kicked B. Price in the mounting yard. B. Price was ruled unfit to fulfil his engagement and replaced by K. Sardelic. Fractious behind the barriers. Co-trainers, Mrs S. & Mr J. Jaensch, were advised that a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to its barrier manners.

PICAROON (G. O'Loughlin) – raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages. Steadied at the 400 metres and then held up for clear running from the 400 metres to the 200 metres.

HEAVY ROTATION (K. Zechner) – jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

TOUGH LASSIE (G.Lo) – trainer Mr C.Bieg reported the mare had pulled up well and added that she may not have appreciated being pressured near the lead.

RACE 7: BORDERTOWN HAULAGE BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

The start of this event was rescheduled to 5.05 pm owing to the delay in Race 6.

DIAMOND ARROW (J. Potter) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course as it had not raced since April 2020 and was passed fit to start. Bumped on jumping away by RICHD, which shifted in.

CANIDAE (S. Logan) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in hampering RICHD. Approaching the 150 metres was taken in by RICHD.

HIGH DELTA (P. Gatt) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MIGHTY MOSHE (F. Atkinson) - Shifted in passing the 700 metres when insufficiently clear of RICHD, which was steadied. Rider was reprimanded for careless riding under AR 131(a).

RICHD (E. Boyd) - bumped on jumping away by DIAMOND ARROW, which shifted out. Raced ungenerously and was inclined to hang in throughout the event. Steadied off the heels of Mighty Moshe passing the 700 metres. Shortly after straightening, after being held up for short distance, shifted in and took CANIDAE in approaching the 150 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Ms R. Day, representing trainer, Ms J. Giles, was advised that the gelding was now required to complete an Official Barrier Trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to a future race start.

GENERAL:

On Saturday, 30 October 2021 co-trainer, Mr G. Kent, advised Stewards that he had become concerned with the filly's behaviour in its day yard and contacted his veterinary surgeon. MARVEL STAR was examined by the stable's veterinary surgeon who advised that the filly was showing abnormal neurological signs and euthanasia was recommended and then carried out.
