
Racing SA Ltd Stipendiary Stewards' Report

Report on Race Meeting held at Port Lincoln Racecourse by the Port Lincoln Racing Club on Sunday, 9 January 2022



TRACK: Good 4 (Track with some give in it) Upgraded to a Good 3 retrospective to Race 3 (Track with good grass coverage and cushion)

RACE 1: SCALLYWAGS TOYS & NURSERY BENCHMARK 76 HANDICAP - 1350 Metres

MY MATE SONNY (E. Boyd) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped WITCH KID. Shifted in when placed under pressure near the 150 metres when insufficiently clear of KINGSON, which had to be eased. Rider was reprimanded under AR131(a).

WITCH KID (T. Voorham) - slow to begin and bumped shortly after by MY MATE SONNY.

KINGSON (E. Annells) – had to be eased near the 150 metres when crowded momentarily by MY MATE SONNY. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: MITTY'S MAIDEN PLATE - 1210 Metres

CROWNED KING (K. Zechner) - laid in, in the straight.

LORAINE'S FLOWJO (B. Price) - rider reported the gelding hung out throughout the event.

RIGHT TURN (E. Annells) - slow into stride and tailed the field by a considerable distance throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer Mr B. Cozamanis was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding with regards to its uncompetitive racing manners.

WIDMAIER (NZ) (E. Wong) – shifted in rounding the home turn and momentarily crowded LADY VENUS on its inside.

GOOD TIME MADAM (S. Callow) - shifted in at the start and bumped LADY VENUS (NZ).

HOT TRIM (G. Lo) - raced wide without cover for the majority of the event.

APOLLO GIRL (K. Crowther) – resaddled on arrival at the barriers at the request of the rider. Hung out and raced wide rounding the home turn. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LADY VENUS (NZ) (A. Jordsjo) – resaddled behind the barriers at the request of the rider. Bumped by GOOD TIME MADAM on jumping away. Hung out rounding the home turn, became awkwardly placed close to the heels of WIDMAIER (NZ), which shifted in slightly, and was steadied.

RACE 3: CARLTON DRY MAIDEN PLATE - 1210 Metres

GET AROUND HIM (E. Boyd) – rider reported she had concerns with her gelding's action in the straight and did not ride the gelding out in her normal manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ROGUE I AM (T. Voorham) - slow to begin.

TELEPORTATION (K. Sardelic) - jumped away very awkwardly and lost ground.

ROWDY DIVA (E. Wong) - refused to load into the barriers. Stewards declared ROWDY DIVA a late scratching at 2.32 pm. Trainer Mr S. Drewitt was advised that the filly would have to be loaded in the barriers in an Official Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

SWEET MINSKY (NZ) (G. Lo) - jumped away awkwardly with its head up and lost ground. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event and got its head up when being restrained. Raced greenly in the straight and was inclined to hang out.

RACE 4: MORPHETTVILLE EQUINE CLINIC MAIDEN PLATE - 1750 Metres

ALPHA RAIDER (R. Hurdle) - near the 1500 metres was crowded and steadied between SOLIS ORTUS and A MIDNIGHT SHADOW, which both shifted ground. Laid in under pressure in the straight.



RACE 4: MORPHETTVILLE EQUINE CLINIC MAIDEN PLATE - 1750 Metres (Cont'd)

ANGRY ANT (K. Zechner) – shifted in near the 1500 metres crowding SOLIS ORTUS in onto ALHPA RAIDER, which was crowded and steadied to the outside of A MIDNIGHT SHADOW, which shifted out slightly away from ROCK STORM. Rider was advised to be exercise more care when shifting ground in future. Raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

RAMBLER GAMBLER (B. Price) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

ROMPER STOMPER (S. Callow) - jumped away awkwardly with its head up and lost ground.

SOLIS ORTUS (K. Sardelic) - crowded near the 1500 metres between ANGRY ANT and ALPHA RAIDER.

SOUMAH (E. Wong) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

A MIDNIGHT SHADOW (C. Lions) – fractious in the barriers and reared on several occasions. Trainer Mr G. Kluske was advised a warning would be placed on the mare regarding its barrier manners. Bumped on jumping by ROCK STORM on its inside. Near the 1500 metres shifted out away from ROCK STORM and in doing so crowded ALPHA RAIDER.

ROCK STORM (T. Voorham) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped A MIDNIGHT SHADOW.

RACE 5: VETS ON EYRE BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP (1) - 1750 Metres

BONIFACE (NZ) (S. Callow) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Shifted out near the 1300 metres placing HAYZELLE in an awkward position to its outside, resulting in that mare losing ground.

HAYZELLE (D. Caboche) – hampered and lost ground near the 1300 metres when awkwardly placed close to the heels of BONIFACE (NZ), which shifted out.

OUR JOURNEYMAN (E. Wong) - rider was dislodged when pulling up after the race. E. Wong was examined by the First Care Medical Personnel and found fit to fulfil his remaining engagements. A post-race veterinary examination revealed speedy cuts to the off side cannon. First aid administered.

ROAR (E. Boyd) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and was found to be unfit to race. Acting on veterinary advice Stewards declared ROAR a late scratching at 3.32 pm. Trainer Mr R. Dawson was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

NEAR MAGIC (K. Zechner) - resaddle on arrival at the barriers at the request of the rider.

RACE 6: AVIS PORT LINCOLN BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP (2) - 1750 Metres

LADY CONQUISTADOR (E. Wong) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare had reinjured a small laceration to its off foreleg.

SHINSEKI (B. Price) – near the 700 metres was crowded and checked between RELAXED and TYCOON DREAMING, which shifted out when insufficiently clear.

TYCOON DREAMING (K. Zechner) - near the 700 metres shifted out around the heels of BURNING HARD, and in doing so crowded SHINSEKI onto RELAXED, resulting in SHINSEKI having to be check. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) for careless riding.

RACE 7: JONES ELECTRICAL BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

SANBUCK (R. Hurdle) – shifted out near the 800 metres and bumped RAHEEBA. Momentarily held up near the 300 metres behind SOMETHING FOXY.

RACE 7: JONES ELECTRICAL BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres (Cont'd)

STAR PARFAIT (T. Voorham) - raced erratically and got its head up on several occasions in the early and middle stages of the event.

MAIDEN GRACE (G. Lo) - hung out in the straight and proved difficult to ride.

RAHEEBA (C. Lions) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Near the 800 metres was bumped by SANBUCK, which shifted out slightly, resulting in RAHEEBA becoming awkward on the heels of SOEMTHING FOXY and having to be steadied.

RACE 8: MITAVITE - LEADERS IN EQUINE NUTRITION BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1250 Metres

ARTFUL AMBITION (K. Sardelic) - puts it head down just prior to the start being affected and as a result was slow to begin.

RED DYNAMO (NZ) (S. Callow) - changed lead legs near the 300 metres and became unbalanced.

MESSERSCHMITT (K. Zechner) - slow to begin.

ISA SECRET (A. Jordsjo) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

BRUTAL POWER (D. Caboche) - fractious in the barriers and was awkward to begin.

RACE 9: HYGAIN - FEEDING CHAMPIONS BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1210 Metres

CHARGING FIRE (K. Zechner) - shifted in at the start crowding I'M OH SO PRETTY in onto COMPARDY and as a result I'M OH SO PRETTY lost ground.

COMPARDY (G. Lo) – on jumping away was bumped by I'M OH SO PRETTY on its outside. Hung out throughout the event and raced wide from the 800 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer Mr R. Dawson was advised the gelding would be required to perform to the Stewards satisfaction in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

I'M OH SO PRETTY (R. Hurdle) – lost ground at the start when crowded and buffeted between COMPARDY and CHARGING FIRE, which shifted in.

MISS CATASTROPHI (T. Voorham) – raced in restricted room in the straight and between the 250 metres and 50 metres was held up for clear running behind CITY JET.

TROUBLED TIMES (E. Boyd) - hung out in the straight when placed under pressure.

TRIVAGO GIRL (B. Price) - crowded and lost ground at the start between WINTER HARBOUR and CELERITATE REGEM, which both shifted slightly. Rider was found guilty to a charge under AR132(6)(b) in that he used his whip in an action that raised his arm above shoulder height and was reprimanded.

HE'S ABEL (S. Callow) - slow to begin.
