

Racing SA Ltd Stipendiary Stewards' Report

Report on Race Meeting held at Port Lincoln
Racecourse by the Port Lincoln Racing Club on
Friday, 21 January 2022



Stewards: M. Zarb (A/Chairman) & S. Callanan (HT) (Stewards), Dearman (F), G Harvey & T Kenny (Deputy Stewards), Dr R. Haensel (Veterinary Surgeon).

TRACK: Good 4 (Track with some give in it)
Downgraded to a Soft 5 at 4.50 pm, retrospective to race 4
(Track with a reasonable amount of give in it)

RAIL: 2 metres out the entire circuit

WEATHER: Overcast/showers

RACE 1: PORT LINCOLN REAL ESTATE THREE-YEAR-OLD BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

DAY FOR IT (NZ) (A. Chung) - on jumping away was buffeted between ROKUN and ZAKYBREE, which jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

ZAKYBREE (C. Murray) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped DAY FOR IT.

RACE 2: SCHWEPES LEMONADE MAIDEN PLATE (1) - 1250 Metres

RIGHT TURN (A. Jordsjo) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination upon arrival at the barriers and was found to be lame in the off foreleg and declared unfit to start. Acting on this advice Stewards withdrew RIGHT TURN at 3.36 pm. Trainer, Mr B. Cozamanis, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the gelding for a future trial or race.

SURVEY LANE (S. Callow) - hung in, in the straight resulting in the rider being obliged to stop and straighten her mount near the 150 metres.

CASSABELLA (C. Murray) - rider reported that the horse hung out badly from the 900 metres to the 500 metres and proved difficult to ride. Co-Trainer, Mr J. Dunn, was advised that a warning has been placed on the mare in relation to its racing manners.

HOT TRIM (A. Chung) - slow to begin.

ODDSOCK (K. Crowther) - slow to begin.

TELEPORTATION (K. Sardelic) - jumped away very awkwardly and lost considerable ground (six lengths). Raced wide without cover for majority of the event. Co-trainer, Mrs J. Branford, was advised that a warning had been placed on the mare. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



RACE 3: PB & KG GASKELL CONTRACTORS MAIDEN PLATE (2) - 1250 Metres

BEERS ON BILL (D. Caboche) - rider reported that the horse hung in for majority of the event and proved difficult to ride.

CROWNED KING (A. Chung) - shifted in at the start and bumped GOOD TIME MADAM. Near the 300 metres became awkward on the heels of PERFECT VOYAGE, when attempting to shift out around that gelding's heels.

RECLUSIVE LAD (G. Lo) - bumped at the start by SAINT OLGA.

TWO BEERS (C. Lions) - rider reported she was concerned with the gelding's action in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer, Mr M. White, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the gelding for a future trial or race.

GOOD TIME MADAM (S. Callow) - shifted out at the start and bumped CROWNED KING. Laid in, in the straight.

GREY FOLLY (F. Atkinson) - reluctant to parade around to the start. Slow to begin. Near the 400 metres when racing tight to the inside of BEERS ON BILL, bumped the running rail and became unbalanced. Passing the 300 metres shifted out and became very awkward on the heels of BEERS ON BILL. Trainer, Mr T. Jolly, was advised that a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to its pre-race behaviour.

SAINT OLGA (A. Jordsjo) - shifted in at the start and bumped RECLUSIVE LAD. Near the 400 metres bumped the running rail and became unbalanced.

TIAMAT (B. Price) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination upon arrival at the barriers and was passed fit to start. Shortly after the start was tightened between TWO BEERS and PERFECT VOYAGE, which was laying in, resulting in the mare losing ground.

RACE 4: LINCOLN SAND SUPPLIES BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1960 Metres

PAULO PACE (K. Sardelic) - shifted out momentarily near the 150 metres when weakening.

WITCH KID (B. Price) - bumped near the 150 meters by SHINSEKI on its outside.

FEARLESS AL (G. Lo) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped DIAMONDS ARE, which lost ground. Near the 900 metres became awkward on the heels of LADY CONQUISTADOR, which was racing keenly and shifted in. Due to the heavy rain throughout the event, rider weighed in more than 0.5 kg over his declared weight.

DIAMONDS ARE (K. Crowther) - bumped at the start by FEARLESS AL and as a result lost ground. Near the 1500 metres became awkward and was obliged to be steadied away from heels of SHINSEKI.

LADY CONQUISTADOR (C. Murray) - Stewards permitted C. Murray to ride the mare 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54.5 kg. Raced keenly near the 1400 metres and when steadied, got its head up and lost ground. Raced keenly near the 900 metres and shifted in when eased. Due to the heavy rain throughout the event, rider weighed in more than 0.5 kg over his declared weight.

SHINSEKI (A. Chung) - shifted in near the 150 metres and bumped WITCH KID.

NEAR MAGIC (C. Lions) - due to the heavy rain throughout the event, rider weighed in more than 0.5 kg over her declared weight.





RACE 5: FIRE EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE GROUP FOUR-YEAR-OLD & UP BENCHMARK
58 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

EFFORTKAT (G. Lo) - approaching the 200 metres was held up momentarily for a clear run.

BEERMINT (A. Jordsjo) - knuckled on jumping away, shifted out and bumped STAR PARFAIT.

CITY JET (A. Chung) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed mild signs of heat related stress which required treatment.

STAR PARFAIT (A. Chung) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination upon arrival at the barriers and was passed fit to start. Bumped at the start by BEERMINT on its inside.

I'M OH SO PRETTY (D. Caboche) - rider reported the mare failed to handle today's track conditions.

RACE 6: EYRE PENINSULA RADIO - MAGIC FM BENCHMARK 76 HANDICAP - 1210 Metres

MALAISE (A. Jordsjo) - rider reported the horse was not entirely comfortable on today's soft track.

ARTFUL AMBITION (K. Sardelic) - slow to begin.

MESSERSCHMITT (A. Chung) - slow to begin.

REGINA DEL DRAMMA (F. Atkinson) - jumped away awkwardly and lost ground. Rider reported the mare felt uncomfortable in its action in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the horse to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer, Mr T. Jolly, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the mare for a future trial or race.

RACE 7: AVIS PORT LINCOLN BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1350 Metres

MIDNIGHT BRAWLER (NZ) (S. Callow) - near the 1250 metres clipped the heels of CRAZY CULPRIT, which shifted out slightly, resulting in the horse blundering and became unbalanced. Raced wide from the 600 metres.

SORRIDERE (A. Chung) - held up for clear running room near the 300 metres behind CRAZY CULPRIT and to the inside of RIVERSIDE ROCK.

CRAZY CULPRIT (C. Lions) - shifted out slightly near the 1250 metres and as a result MIDNIGHT BRAWLER (NZ), which was following, clipped its heels and blundered. Hung out rounding the home turn.

SPENCER GULF (D. Caboche) - slow to begin. Raced wide without cover for majority of the event.

ANASTASIA SKILL (F. Atkinson) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as the mare had not raced for more than 12 months and passed fit to race.
