RACE 1: TRAVIS DOUDLE RACING HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

STAR HILLS (J. Holder) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Rider reported that the gelding had not let down as he had expected when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ALLEBOOM (C. Jones) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

AADELAD (J. Toeroek) - Stewards permitted J. Toeroek to ride the gelding 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54.5kg.

SEVENTH SEAL (NZ) (B. Price) - rider reported the gelding never travelled in today's event and was under pressure at the entrance to the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: SPRINGFIELD FARM - STANDING NOSTRADAMUS HANDICAP - 1550 Metres

The start of this event was delayed by approximately two minutes to avoid a clash with an interstate race.

HYPERCANE (C. Rawiller) - rider reported the gelding travelled fairly in the early stages however, when placed under pressure near the 600 metres, failed to respond to his riding, was disappointing and for this reason he had elected not to ride the gelding out from inside the 200 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CHASE ON THE CASE (K. Crowther) - had to be momentarily steadied at the entrance to the straight when tightened between DEELBRAKA, which rolled out slightly at the same times as BOLT BY, shifted in slightly.

RACE 2: SPRINGFIELD FARM - STANDING NOSTRADAMUS HANDICAP - 1550 Metres (Cont'd)

BOLT BY (J. Holder) - at the entrance to the straight shifted in slightly onto CHASE ON THE CASE.

DEELBRAKA (J. Toeroek) - rolled out at the entrance of the straight onto CHASE ON THE CASE. Rider reported that he had become concerned with the geldings action on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

VENUSIAN (R. Hurdle) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as the gelding had raced on Wednesday 13 July 2022 and was deemed suitable to race.

RACE 3: MORPHETTVILLE EQUINE HANDICAP - 1250 Metres

OH MO (B. Vorster) - had difficulty obtaining clear round from the entrance to the straight until near the 200 metres. Laid out under pressure over the final 100 metres.

MR MARATHON MAN (GB) (B. Price) – raced keenly in the middle stages of the event. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

PIMM'S PARTY (T. Voorham) - slow to begin.

KAYSERI (NZ) (J. Benbow) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

CLASSY KENNY (J. Maund) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

OBI (K. Crowther) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

KONG (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin. Held up from near the 400 metres until near the 150 metres.

ROTHMOORE (S. Logan) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as the gelding had not raced since 17 July 2021 and was deemed suitable to race.

RACE 4: SAROA - THERE FOR OWNERS HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

TUBBY TWO TRACKS (B. Price) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DANISH FORTUNE (B. Vorster) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

WRITE THE SCORE (J. Holder) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RUN AND TELL (T. Voorham) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

RACE 5: CHARLES MELTON WINES OAKLANDS PLATE - 1400 Metres

LONSDALEITE (B. Vorster) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider reported that the colt had travelled well in the early and middle stages however, near the 500 metres had received a solid bump from its inside resulting in LONSDALEITE becoming unbalanced. He added after receiving this contact the colt became uncomfortable in its action, did not respond to his riding and was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HE'S HEAVEN (J. Benbow) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

MONSEAGLE (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near hind leg. Co-Trainer, Mr G. Richards, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance was required prior to a future trial or race start.

BIRDIES GALORE (C. Parish) - near the 50 metres was momentarily inconvenienced when taken wider by HE'S HEAVEN.

RACE 5: CHARLES MELTON WINES OAKLANDS PLATE - 1400 Metres (Cont'd)

FIELD THE MOMENT (C. Jones) - jumped away awkwardly.

HARMONIOUS SENORA (K. Crowther) - slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 6: HORSEMED SA HANDICAP - 1950 Metres

MAHASHAKTI (B. Price) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ICHIBANSAN (J. Holder) - slow to begin.

HARBOURING (S. Logan) - rider reported that the gelding hung out throughout the race. A postrace veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near hind leg. Trainer, Mr G. Lynch, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance was required prior to a future trial or race start.

ALL HARD WOOD (M. Lawrence) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto SPACE EQUITY. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

DOCTOR TIMOR (K. Crowther) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

SPACE EQUITY (D. Caboche) - hampered on jumping away when ALL HARD WOOD shifted out.

RACE 7: PUNT CLUB SUPPORTING SA RACING HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

CALLA DREAM (R. Hurdle) - shifted out shortly after the start onto JAAZEB.

JAAZEB (L. Neindorf) - lost its near fore plate during the event. Jumped away awkwardly and shortly after lost its position when taken out onto TYCOON'S GIRL. Near the 900 metres was inconvenienced when contacted by TYCOON'S GIRL.

ANGEL LIKE (B. Price) - lost its near hind plate during the event.

NICE FOR WHAT (J. Holder) - shifted in shortly after the start onto THE GOLFER. Rider reported that the filly shortened in its action inside the 100 metres and he had become concerned on pulling up and for this reason had dismounted from NICE FOR WHAT. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be lame near foreleg with a soft tissue injury proximal to fetlock tendon region. First aid administered. Co-Trainer, Mr D. Eustace, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance was required prior to a future trial or race start.

BENEVOLENT (IRE) (T. Pannell) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BRAZANO (B. Vorster) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

THE GOLFER (J. Maund) - shortly after the start, lost its position when taken in onto ANGEL LIKE by NICE FOR WHAT.

HANABI (K. Crowther) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

TYCOON'S GIRL (J. Eaton) -shortly after the start, lost its position when CALLA DREAM shifted out into its running line. Raced fiercely in the early and middle stages and near the 900 metres had to be steadied. In being steadied shifted in and brushed JAAZEB.

LAMOREE (J. Benbow) - hampered shortly after the start when tightened between BENEVOLENT (IRE), which shifted out slightly at the same time as ANGEL LIKE rolled in slightly. Raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event

RACE 8: GRAND SYNDICATES - NEW YEARLINGS AVAILABLE NOW! HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

PRIVATE CHEETAH (T. Pannell) - laid out under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DEEVINE (L. Neindorf) - shifted out shortly after the start and contacted SHORT STORIES.

FALLOW (J. Benbow) - shifted out shortly after the start onto CLAMARC.

ULTIMATE VICTORY (B. Vorster) - slow to begin.

SHORT STORIES (E. Boyd) - inconvenienced shortly after the start when contacted by DEEVINE.

OLD TIME ROCK (T. Voorham) - jumped away awkwardly.

UNASSAILABLE (K. Crowther) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CLAMARC (J. Toeroek) - hampered shortly after the start when FALLOW shifted out.

RACE 9: FRANO PLEIC MEMORIAL HANDICAP - 1300 Metres

TOYZ ON FIRE (M. Lawrence) - jumped away awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

NIGHT HUSSLER (NZ) (K. Crowther) - slow to begin.

BON PEGASUS (S. Logan) - shifted out on jumping away and contacted SUNNY GREEN.

SEA PRINCESS (T. Pannell) - near the 1100 metres shifted in and contacted STARSONGARI. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SUNNY GREEN (R. Hurdle) - contacted on jumping away.

BARBALINE (B. Vorster) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

STARSONGARI (J. Toeroek) - near the 1100 metres was inconvenienced when contacted by SEA PRINCESS.

MAY'S WEST (J. Maund) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

SMART CHANGE (J. Benbow) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.
