RACE 1: TEAMPOLY TWO-YEAR-OLD CLASS ONE PLATE - 1000 Metres

BONA FIDE STAR (J. Doyle) - slow to being and shortly after was inconvenienced when contacted by OUR DIVINYL. Approaching the 50m shifted out abruptly onto TESTA DURA. Rider reported that the gelding raced greenly throughout the event.

OUR DIVINYL (T. Voorham) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto BONA FIDE STAR.

TESTA DURA (J. Holder) - inconvenienced approaching the 50m when BONA FIDE STAR shifted out.

CHEROKEE MISS (J. Benbow) - inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

MISS RUBICK (P. Gatt) - stewards permitted P. Gatt to ride the filly 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54.0 kg.



RACE 2: COONARA MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute.

ALEKHINE'S GUN (J. Maund) - raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event and was inclined to shift about.

LEADER'S PRIDE (A. Lindsay) - near the 1000m shifted in onto SEAFARING, which was inconvenienced. Rider reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

I AM HERA SINGH (C. Murray) - laid out under pressure in the straight. Near the 1000m was inconvenienced when taken in slightly by LEADER'S PRIDE.

SEAFARING (NZ) (J. Toeroek) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

CLASSIC HOLLY (B. Vorster) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

FRUSCIANTE (E. Wong) - lost its off fore plate en route to the barrier and required farrier attention. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

LINDA BRAVE (NZ) (D. Tournour) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

CARARADA (J. Benbow) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow into stride. Near the 1000m clipped the heels of I AM HERA SINGH and knuckled dislodging its rider. J. Benbow was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and then transported to hospital for further observations. Preliminary evidence was taken from C. Murray, J. Maund and E. Annells. An inquiry into this incident was adjourned to a date and time to be fixed to allow J. Benbow to be present. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a minor laceration to the near fore cannon.

MISSILE STAR (M. Collett) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

RACE 3: DAISH IRRIGATION & FODDER MAIDEN PLATE - 1400 Metres

The start of this event was rescheduled to 1.32 pm following a delay due to the fall in race 2.

KING FOX (C. Murray) - shifted out on jumping away onto MASTER AT ARMS (NZ). Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

MASTER AT ARMS (NZ) (B. Price) - inconvenienced when contacted on jumping away. Near the 1200m was inconvenienced and taken out onto YOUR MANDARIN by BILLIE BRONX. Raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event.

YOUR MANDARIN (J. Holder) - inconvenienced near the 1200m when taken out slightly by MASTER AT ARMS (NZ). Raced keenly in the middle stages of the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

FINAL JEDI (A. Livesey) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

MISS NARRANGA (J. Maund) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

MIZZ BEEBEEFF (P. Gatt) - had to be steadied near the 1200m when YOUR MANDARIN was taken out slightly into its running line.

BILLIE BRONX (E. Boyd) - approaching the 1200m rider eased and in doing so the filly shifted out onto MASTER AT ARMS (NZ).

CURRENCY KAMAR (J. Potter) - fractious in its barrier after being loaded. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and deemed suitable to race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be exhibiting signs of heat stress. In addition the veterinary surgeon reported that the filly was in season.



RACE 4: NORMA GROUP & ORANGE PUMPS MAIDEN PLATE - 900 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately six minutes owing to the delay in the previous event.

HOT SPARKY (E. Boyd) - laid out rounding the home turn. Laid out under pressure over the concluding 100m.

RUBINI (J. Doyle) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow into stride.

TENTERK (A. Lindsay) - shifted out abruptly for no apparent reason near the 200 metres, and in doing so inconvenienced ZAC'S BACK and STELLER EAGLE. Rider reported that in her opinion the gelding had reacted after being struck by kickback. Trainer, Mr S. Padman, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its racing manners.

ZAC'S BACK (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly. Near the 200m had to be momentarily steadied when TENTERK shifted out abruptly.

COMANCHE QUEEN (E. Annells) - slow to begin.

FLY THE LINE (C. Murray) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RUSSIAN STYLE (M. Collett) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

I LOVE MUM (K. Sardelic) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

STELLER EAGLE (J. Eaton) - inconvenienced near the 200m when taken wider by TENTERK.

RACE 5: PHILMAC BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1800 Metres

SIX FOOT SONG (K. Crowther) - slow to begin.

HANDSHAKE (J. Potter) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slower than expected recovery.

KEYSOR (J. Holder) - held up from near the 500m until inside the 400m.

AMERICAN TROUBLE (J. Maund) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

NEVA DOUBT US (T. Voorham) - slow to begin. Held up from near the 500m until near the 300m and was obliged to alter course to the inside to obtain clear ground.

QUEBECOIS (J. Eaton) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

JACK'S A CRACKER (B. Price) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid out under pressure over the concluding 100m of the event.

RACE 6: DAVEY CLASS ONE PLATE - 2000 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately four minutes.

EM BRYAN (A. Lindsay) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

LORD LUKER (IRE) (B. Price) - lost its near fore plate en route to the barrier and required farrier attention. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider reported that the gelding had travelled fairly in the early and middle stages; however, when asked for an effort at the entrance to the straight had not responded as he had anticipated and commenced to make excess respiratory noise approaching the 100m and on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slower than expected recovery.



RACE 6: DAVEY CLASS ONE PLATE - 2000 Metres (cont'd)

TUFF CAT (P. Gatt) - near the 700m attempted to ease to the outside to avoid the heels of REBEL ROMANCE, which had commenced to give ground, and in doing so made contact with the hind quarters of OH NO GEORGE, turning that gelding in, resulting in TUFF CAT becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of REBEL ROMANCE and forcing the rider to take hold.

REBEL ROMANCE (E. Annells) - commenced to give ground near the 700m. Rider reported that she had become concerned with the mare's action on straightening and for this reason had elected to ease it out of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the off hind leg (3/5). Trainer, Mr T. Day, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance was required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race.

ROBE RAIDER (B. Vorster) - slow to begin. In the vicinity of the 650m was inconvenienced when taken wider by SOARLIKEANEAGLE.

SOARLIKEANEAGLE (S. Fawke) - shifted out inside the 700m onto ROBE RAIDER.

RACE 7: WHITE INTERNATIONAL RATING 0 - 58 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

CORK HARBOUR (B. Price) - near the 600m was inconvenienced when contacted by MADAM FURPHY, which shifted out and then shifted back in towards that mare resulting in these runners making contact on a number of occasions. Raced in restricted room over the concluding 100m when awkwardly placed between the heels of SANBUCK and SEE YOU LATER NOW. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a lower than expected heart rate.

MANAGE THE CYCLE (E. Wong) - at the entrance to the straight shifted out to improve and in doing so brushed the hindquarters of FIFTY FOUR SQUARES.

STREET SWAGGER (J. Holder) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MADAM FURPHY (A. Livesey) - approaching the 600m shifted out and contacted CORK HARBOUR, which shifted back in resulting in these runners making contact on a number of occasions.

FIFTY FOUR SQUARES (B. Vorster) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced wide without cover throughout the event. At the entrance to the straight was inconvenienced when its hindquarters were contacted by MANAGE THE CYCLE.

SEE YOU LATER NOW (T. Voorham) - slow to begin. In the vicinity of the 300m rider accidentally dropped her whip.

RACE 8: AAP BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately four minutes.

AKTOLGALI (J. Maund) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

ENTITLED PRINCESS (K. Crowther) - near the 300m had to be steadied when tightened onto BENZ BARON by ICE GHOST.

AMMO AMOR (T. Voorham) - inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

FOX GEM (B. Vorster) - lost its near fore plate en route to the barrier. The farrier was unable to refit the near fore plate and trainer, Mr J. Macmillan, requested that the gelding be scratched rather than being permitted to race bare in front. Stewards acceded to the request and FOX GEM was declared a late scratching at 4.16 pm.



LORD OF DARKNESS (NZ) (A. Lindsay) - slow to begin.

WARRANTYTE ROAD (S. Fawke) - slow to begin.



RACE 8: AAP BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1400 Metres (cont'd)

ICE GHOST (D. Caboche) - shifted out under riding in the straight and near the 300m shifted out onto ENTITLED PRINCESS, which was forced to steady when tightened onto BENZ BARON. Rider was severely reprimanded and advised in future to make a greater effort to keep his mounts straight.

WARMINSTER (B. Price) - near the 200m shifted in when insufficiently clear of PRETENTIOUS LASS, which was forced to check. Rider was found guilty of a charge of careless riding under AR131(a) and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence midnight Saturday, 12 November 2022 and to conclude midnight Sunday, 20 November 2022, a period of four race meetings.

BENZ BARON (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

PRETENTIOUS LASS (P. Gatt) - near the 200m was forced to check and lost its position when avoiding the heels of WARMINSTER, which shifted in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 9: VINIDEX BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

AESTHETE (GB) (B. Price) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be exhibiting signs of the thumps and to be lame in the off hind leg (2/5). Trainer, Mr W. Clarken, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance was required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race.

MISTA HOLYFIELD (E. Annells) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

BADONKIDONK (K. Crowther) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto LORD WONDER (NZ).

LORD WONDER (NZ) (J. Holder) - contacted on jumping away.

RUBBLE (D. Tourneur) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Inside the 300m shifted out slightly onto WHISKEY 'N' WOMEN. Rider was reminded of his obligations when his mounts commence to shift ground.

ALPHAEUS (J. Potter) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WHEELS OF COURAGE (B. Vorster) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

NICOTERA (D. Tootell (Snr)) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

WHISKEY 'N' WOMEN (E. Boyd) - slow to begin. Inside the 300m was inconvenienced and forced to steady for a short distance when RUBBLE shifted out.
