Report on Race Meeting held at Morphetville Parks  
Racecourse by the South Australian Jockey Club on  
Saturday, 18 February 2023

## RACE 1: THE JUNCTION HANDICAP - 1300 Metres

CLUB PUNTER (S. Tomlinson) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event. Near the 1000m shifted in when insufficiently clear onto BONNIE GANGSTER, which had to be steadied. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised, in future, to take greater care when shifting ground. Rider reported that the gelding felt a little short in front in its action over the concluding stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg (1/5). Trainer, Ms R. Day was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race.

DUNMAGHLAS (L. Neindorf) - rider reported that the gelding may not have been suited to the step up in distance in today's event. He added that the gelding had pulled up in a normal manner.

KUSHAN KHANIVALE (J. Eaton) - rider reported that the gelding hung out throughout the event.

BONNIE GANGSTER (J. Potter) - near the 1000m had to be steadied when tightened by CLUB PUNTER, which shifted in when insufficiently clear.


## RACE 2: TAB ADELAIDE CUP DAY - MONDAY MARCH 13TH HANDICAP - 2250 Metres

GRINZINGER ALLEE (NZ) (E. Finnegan) - rider reported that near the 1000m the gelding laid out and became unbalanced for a short distance.

WOLF PRINCE (A. Jordsjo) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

DIXIE WHISTLER (L. Neindorf) - rider was reminded of his obligations under AR131(b) to ensure he rides all his mounts out hands and heels to the end of the race.

SWANKYTOFF (S. Callow) - began awkwardly.



### RACE 3: ADELAIDE GALVANISING INDUSTRIES HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

DODD (J. Potter) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

MOREDREAM (D. Caboche) - slow to begin. Shortly after the start commenced to race keenly and got its head up when being restrained to avoid the heels of RUSCHEYNE near the 800m. Near the 500m was taken out by RUSCHEYNE, which shifted out when racing greenly. Near the 300m was hampered when RUSCHEYNE shifted out and away from BURNING BRIGHT, which was laying out.

NASHO (S. Logan) - raced greenly throughout the event. Near the 500m was taken out of its course by MOREDREAM, which had been taken out by RUSCHEYNE, which shifted out when laying out.

RUSCHEYNE (K. Crowther) - near the 300m was hampered and taken out by BURNING BRIGHT, which shifted out and away from KRISTOBEL. Rider reported that the gelding raced greenly throughout the event.

SIR PANAMA (S. Callow) - slow to begin. Laid in early in the straight near the 400m. Near the 300m shifted to the outside of SURPRISE COMING when improving. Approaching the 100m when improving commenced to lay in under pressure. Passing the 100m when continuing to improve shifted to the outside of HARLEEN to obtain a clear run.

SURPRISE COMING (J. Eaton) - began awkwardly and as a result lost ground.

FIRST RANK (S. Tomlinson) - on jumping away lost its footing behind and as a result began awkwardly.

DIAMONDS CHOICE (B. Price) - rider explained that the filly began only fairly and after a short distance he felt it became awkward in its action and as he felt there was something amiss with the filly he commenced to ease DIAMONDS CHOICE down passing the 900m. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer, Mr C. Bieg was advised that the filly would be required to complete an Official Barrier Trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to accepting for a future race.

KRISTOBEL (B. Vorster) - rider reported that the filly raced greenly throughout the event.

### RACE 4: THOMAS FARMS HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

ROYAL MILE (J. Opperman) - passing the 700m became unbalanced when taken out of its course by SASKATOON, which had shifted out to improve.

### RACE 5: THE FOTOBASE GROUP HANDICAP - 1000 Metres


PARSIFAL (NZ) (E. Wong) - began awkwardly. Near the 50m shifted in when laying in resulting in STAR HILLS, which was racing to the geldings inside, having to be steadied. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised that he would be expected to make a far greater effort to straighten his mounts when in similar circumstances in future.

HE'S A BALTER (T. Voorham) - began awkwardly and lost ground.

STAR HILLS (A. Jordsjo) - near the 50m was steadied to avoid the heels of PARSIFAL (NZ), which when laying, shifted in whilst being ridden along.

SILVER ON RED (B. Vorster) - rider reported that the gelding did not quicken when placed under pressure over the concluding stages as he would have anticipated. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

### RACE 6: GRAND SYNDICATES HANDICAP - 1250 Metres



ANGASTON (S. Callow) - raced keenly in the early stages. Near the 1000m got its head up when being steadied to avoid the heels of other runners.

ICHIBANSAN (E. Wong) - became fractious in its barrier after being loaded. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race.



RACE 6: GRAND SYNDICATES HANDICAP - 1250 Metres (cont'd)

CLASSY BANNER (J. Eaton) - slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Near the 1000m when racing keenly was eased when awkwardly placed on the heels of TAHNEE TRADITION.

TURFITT (L. Neindorf) - near the 1000m after being brushed by ANGASTON, shifted out and away from that gelding and became awkwardly placed on the heels of FOUR WINDS.

FOUR WINDS (K. Crowther) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 7: CROSER HANDICAP - 1550 Metres

TRUMPSTA (S. Callow) - slow to begin.

KUTAYHA (NZ) (S. Tomlinson) - passing the 200m shifted out tightening the running of TIGER QUEEN when not fully clear. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised to ensure he is clear of other runners before shifting ground in future.

GETOUTTHEWAY (E. Wong) - slow to begin. Rider reported that the gelding hung in for the majority of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PORT ROYAL (J. Opperman) - began awkwardly.

CALIBURN (L. Neindorf) - near the 1000m shifted in tightening LEONARDA, which was taken in onto HONEY GO LIGHTLY, which in turn was taken in slightly, resulting in SADLER'S SONG racing in restricted room to the inside of that mare and having to be steadied. Rider was reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised that he must ensure that he leaves comfortable galloping room for other runners to his inside in similar circumstances, in future.

KALAMON (J. Toeroek) - began awkwardly.

LEONARDA (A. Livesey) - began awkwardly.

VELARO (A. Jordsjo) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Laid out rounding the home turn near the 400m. Rider reported that the gelding hung out throughout the event.

TIGER QUEEN (B. Price) - passing the 200m was taken out by KUTAYHA (NZ) and as a result was steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of EXCUSEZ MOI. Rider explained that he felt that there may have been something amiss with the mare's action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the off foreleg (3/5). Trainer, Mr R. Balfour was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race.

SADLER'S SONG (S. Logan) - near the 1000m was steadied when racing in restricted room to the inside of HONEY GO LIGHTLY, which was taken in slightly by LEONARDA, which in turn was taken in slightly by CALIBURN.

RACE 8: WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

ALL CLUBS (S. Tomlinson) - rider reported that the mare hung out rounding the home turn. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LITTLE RICH BOY (B. Vorster) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

THE TRANCE FACTOR (A. Livesey) - began awkwardly.

RUSTY HALO (J. Holder) - near the 900m was eased when racing tight between SANBUCK, which shifted out slightly and MY RUBY, which was taken in slightly by LITTLE RICH BOY.

LAMOREE (J. Toeroek) - rider reported that the mare hung out for the majority of the event and was difficult to ride.

SO SILENT (J. Eaton) - near the 400m when racing tightly to the outside of LADY WAIRUA (NZ) became unbalanced after brushing with that filly.





RACE 8: WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS HANDICAP - 1000 Metres (cont'd)

LADY WAIRUA (NZ) (T. Voorham) - near the 400m became unbalanced when racing tightly between SEND IT and SO SILENT.

UNIFICATION (J. Potter) - bounded on jumping away.

RACE 9: PFD FOODS HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

TONGSAI BOSS (L. Neindorf) - began awkwardly and contacted STORM HUNTER. Rider reported after striking interference at the start, TONGSAI BOSS settled further back than intended. He explained that he became concerned with the gelding's action prior to straightening and for this reason did not ride TONGSAI BOSS out in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer, Mr J. Hyam was requested to report any veterinary matters that may arise in the coming days that may have affected TONGSAI BOSS's performance in today's event.

LI'L HANK (J. Maund) - began awkwardly, shifted in making contact with STORM HUNTER and as a result became unbalanced.

STORM HUNTER (J. Eaton) - shortly after the start was severely checked and lost ground when tightened for room between LI'L HANK, which began awkwardly and shifted in and TONGSAI BOSS, which shifted out and away from DANCING STREAM.

RUBBLE (B. Price) - knuckled on jumping away.

TIME WARRIOR (C. Jones) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Raced wide without cover throughout the event
