Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse

RACE 1: ANZAC DAY FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

LADY TUCAN (S. Tomlinson) - jumped away awkwardly. Approaching the 900m was hampered when tightened onto QUEEN IN THE NORTH by MOMENTS IN LIFE.

SALLETT (S. Payne) - slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BALLON D'OR (T. Pannell) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin. In the vicinity of the 900m was inconvenienced when racing behind QUEEN IN THE NORTH, which lost its position.

MOMENTS IN LIFE (C. Murray) - near the 900m shifted in when insufficiently clear of LADY TUCAN, which was hampered when taken in onto QUEEN IN THE NORTH, which was forced to be checked and lost its position when tightened onto TOBIWASHI, which was hampered and became unbalanced when it was tightened. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR131(a) and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence midnight Wednesday, 3 May 2023 to conclude midnight Wednesday, 10 May 2023, a period of three meetings. Laid out under pressure rounding the home turn and in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

QUEEN IN THE NORTH (J. Toeroek) - in the vicinity of the 900m had to be check and lost its position when tightened onto TOBIWASHI. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

TOBIWASHI (A. Livesey) - near the 900m was hampered and became unbalanced when contacted by QUEEN IN THE NORTH, which had been taken in.



RACE 1: ANZAC DAY FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

ANGELIC APPEAL (L. Neindorf) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin. Near the 900m was inconvenienced when racing behind QUEEN IN THE NORTH, which had lost ground. Laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: WE WILL REMEMBER THEM COLTS, GELDINGS & ENTIRES MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

MY RICH BOY (S. Payne) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SANDHILL KNIGHT (R. Hurdle) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

ENUFF RED (B. Price) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

FAMOUS KNIGHT (E. Wong) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

SOLAR BLAST (K. Crowther) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

YEAH WHATEVER (E. Finnegan) - inconvenienced near the 100m when taken wider by OUR DIVINYL.

OUR DIVINYL (L. Neindorf) - approaching the 100m improved onto the heels of FAMOUS KNIGHT, which had shifted out, and altered course to obtain clear ground, and in doing so inconvenienced YEAH WHATEVER, which was taken wider. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a laceration to the near hind leg. Co-trainers, Mr L. Macdonald and Mr A. Gluyas, were advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

RACE 3: ANZACAPPEAL.COM.AU MAIDEN PLATE - 1700 Metres

LINES OF GLORY (C. Jones) - rider reported that the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event; however, when asked for an effort failed to let down as she had anticipated. She added that in her opinion LINES OF GLORY would be better suited with blinkers on. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PUNCHIN (S. Payne) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

GREY FOLLY (A. Livesey) - slow to begin.

HOSTESS SUSIE (C. Murray) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow into stride.

JUST JOKING (J. Holder) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

PUISSY GALORE (S. Tomlinson) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider reported that it was not his intention to lead in today's event; however, after jumping away well and with the addition of blinkers the filly took up that position of its own accord.

RACE 4: THE RETURNED & SERVICES LEAGUE CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

HOT ROD BOY (B. Price) - rider reported that he had become concerned with the gelding's action in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

JACKS ON ICE (J. Toeroek) - lost its off fore plate en route to the barriers and was required to be re-plated. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to start.

SUPER SHARP (J. Holder) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.



RACE 4: THE RETURNED & SERVICES LEAGUE CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

TEA RAV (NZ) (L. Neindorf) - lost its off fore plate during the event.

RACE 5: RESPECT FOR OUR VETERANS RATING 0 - 58 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

IMPORTANT PRODUCT (S. Payne) - shortly after the start had to be steadied when it was taken in across the heels of CANIDAE by MELINKE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MELINKE (T. Pannell) - shifted in on jumping away onto IMPORTANT PRODUCT.

HAYZEE FANTAYZEE (S. Tomlinson) - near the 900m had to be steadied when racing in restricted room for a number of strides between RUSTYDUSTYSUNSHINE, which had been taken in slightly by MAGIC DELTA, and FOURTH POWER, which shifted out slightly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be lame in the near foreleg (1/5). Co-trainers, Mr R Jolly and Miss C Jolly, were advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

MAGIC DELTA (J. Toeroek) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CANIDAE (C. Jones) - held up for a short distance at the entrance to the straight and then had difficulty obtaining clear ground until near the 100m.

RACE 6: THE GALLIPOLI MEMORIAL TROPHY BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 2100 Metres

BLOOD SWEAT TEARS (S. Payne) - near the 1000m was inconvenienced when contacted and taken wider by PUISSANCE DUSOLEIL. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ACE ATTACK (C. Murray) - rider was reprimanded under AR132(7)(a)(i) in that he used his whip in consecutive strides prior to the 100m.

AL RANCHERO (E. Wong) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

FLIGHT DECK (NZ) (L. Neindorf) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

PUISSANCE DUSOLEIL (J. Toeroek) - raced keenly in the middle stages and near the 1000m shifted out and contacted BLOOD SWEAT TEARS, which was taken wider. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PERLUBIE BEACH (J. Eaton) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

BONNIESIX (J. Potter) - approaching the crossing near the 1800m became awkward in its action and was eased from the event. Attended to by the Veterinary Surgeon who reported that the mare had fractured its near fore pastern and was humanely euthanased.

RACE 7: 50TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE VIETNAM WAR RATING 0 - 58 HANDICAP - 1500 Metres

I NEED A DRINK (A. Livesey) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

MASTER OF ZERPRISE (S. Payne) - near the 200m rider was forced to take hold to avoid the heels of VALENTIGRA, which shifted out.

TANAAWOL (NZ) (J. Eaton) - rider reported that the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event; however, when placed under pressure did not respond to her riding and was disappointing to the finish. She added that when placed under pressure and on pulling up the gelding had made excess respiratory noise. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



RACE 7: 50TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE VIETNAM WAR RATING 0 - 58 HANDICAP - 1500 Metres (cont'd)

VALENTIGRA (L. Neindorf) - approaching the 200m shifted out into the running line of MASTER OF ZERPRISE when insufficiently clear resulting in that rider having to take hold to avoid the heels of VALENTIGRA. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR131(a) and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence midnight Wednesday, 3 May 2023 to conclude midnight Friday, 12 May 2023, a period of four meetings.

JOURNEY IN TIME (E. Wong) - held up from near the 500m until approaching the 200m.

MOSS THE BOSS (F. Atkinson) - slow to begin.
