RACE 1: CARBINE CLUB OF SOUTH AUSTRALIA INC HANDICAP - 2028 Metres

MORTY (J. Toeroek) - near the 800m was forced to race in restricted room for a number of strides between the heels of GAME KEEPER and DIXIE WHISTLER, which shifted out.

CANFORD (A. Livesey) - shortly after the start was hampered when contacted by MONTEPULCIANO. Raced keenly in the middle stages and near the 900m improved onto the heels of SMILING ASSASSIN and had to be steadied.

SMILING ASSASSIN (S. Payne) - slow to begin.

PRINCE JOFRA (S. Fawke) - laid out under pressure in the straight and near the 50m shifted out onto CAPTAIN BRITAIN (IRE).

SILENT SURRENTE (M. Lloyd) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.



RACE 1: CARBINE CLUB OF SOUTH AUSTRALIA INC HANDICAP - 2028 Metres (cont'd)

DIXIE WHISTLER (L. Neindorf) – near the 800m shifted out onto MORTY. Rider was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground. Inside the 800m raced in restricted room for a number of strides between the heels of CAPTAIN BRITAIN (IRE) and GAME KEEPER, which both shifted ground slightly. At the entrance to the straight had to momentarily steady and alter course to the inside of SMILING ASSASSIN, which shifted out.

MONTEPULCIANO (K. Crowther) – shortly after the start shifted out and bumped CANFORD.

CAPTAIN BRITAIN (IRE) (M. Dee) – inconvenienced over the concluding 50m when taken wider by PRINCE JOFRA.

RACE 2: SKYCITY HANDICAP - 1050 Metres

ASTON RAPOVA (M. Lloyd) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages and near the 700m rider was forced to take hold when METRO LEGEND shifted in.

METRO LEGEND (D. Oliver) – near the 700m shifted in onto ASTON RAPOVA, forcing the rider to take hold. Rider reprimanded and advised to ensure he is sufficiently clear prior to shifting ground in future. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

GRINZINGER PRINCE (E. Finnegan) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 300m shifted out onto SAMESYN, which was hampered when forced to momentarily steady. Rider was reprimanded for careless riding.

HOWL (L. Neindorf) – rider explained that he was caught wide in the early and middle stages of the event, and in his opinion the gelding will benefit from the first up run.

DARING MOVE (J. Toeroek) – contacted on jumping away.

RUSHAWAY LAD (C. Williams) – shifted in on jumping away and bumped DARING MOVE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CHOSEN BLONDE (D. Caboche) – jumped away awkwardly.

THE TRANCE FACTOR (A. Livesey) – Stewards acceded to a request from trainer, Mr R. Balfour, to permit the mare to race without pacifiers as declared due to the heavy track. Jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

SAMESYN (K. Crowther) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.


RACE 3: DAVID COLES AM STAKES - 1200 Metres

HEURISTIC (B. Melham) – laid out under pressure in the straight.

BOLTED IN (J. Eaton) – inconvenienced on jumping away. Raced wide without cover throughout the event. Rider explained that the gelding had not travelled during the event and near the 500m was forced wider when STUPENDOUS shifted out. She added that on straightening she had elected to shift in as in her opinion that was the firmest part of the track, and after doing so the gelding responded to her riding and finished the race off strongly. She further added that in her opinion the gelding was not suited by the heavy track.

EVEN SHARPER (C. Jones) – slow to begin.

PUTANOTHERCOININ (J. Toeroek) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



CHILLED (M. Dee) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto BOLTED IN. Rider explained that in his opinion the filly is better suited over shorter distances and may have come to the end of its preparation. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



RACE 3: DAVID COLES AM STAKES - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

HARLEEN (C. Newitt) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Raced in restricted room over the concluding 200m between the heels of PUTANOTHERCOININ and STUPENDOUS, which both shifted ground slightly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TE PANI (T. Pannell) - inconvenienced on jumping away when tightened between DOWN LOW, which shifted in on jumping away at the same time as IPHIMEDIA shifted out.

STUPENDOUS (T. Voorham) - jumped away awkwardly.

RACE 4: KEN AND HELEN SMITH SA FILLIES CLASSIC - 2500 Metres

LET'SBEFRANKBABY (J. Mott) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto MOYA LASS. At the entrance to the straight was inconvenienced when its hindquarters were contacted by ANPHINA. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

ANPHINA (J. Toeroek) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and contacted SAVSONIC (NZ). Hampered at the entrance to the straight when taken out onto LET'SBEFRANKBABY by MOYA LASS.

MOYA LASS (D. Oliver) - hampered on jumping away when tightened between WHAKAMANA and LET'SBEFRANKBABY. Raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

STORMY GREY (USA) (C. Murray) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

WHISPERING LADY (C. Williams) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

LA GIOIA (M. Dee) - lost its off hind plate on jumping away. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

NOVEMBER FALLS (NZ) (C. Newitt) - jumped away awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MONKS - Stewards acceded to a request from trainer, Mr L. Kennewell, that MONKS be declared a late scratching due to the track downgrade at 10.00am.

WANDA'S OUTLAW (T. Pannell) - jumped away awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be lame in the near foreleg (2/5). Trainer, Ms Littlefield, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

SAVSONIC (NZ) (L. Neindorf) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and contacted ANPHINA.

RACE 5: R A LEE STAKES - 1600 Metres

SILENT SOVEREIGN (T. Pannell) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

MY KHALIFA (L. Neindorf) - rider explained that the gelding raced flat and may have come to the end of its preparation. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

YURI ROYALE (K. Crowther) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto LORD VLADIVOSTOK (NZ).

PUDDING (NZ) (J. Toeroek) - had to be momentarily steadied near the 200m when PARTY PRINCESS shifted out.

LOMAX (C. Murray) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow into stride.

FOXY FRIDA (W. Egan) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until approaching the 200m.





RACE 5: R A LEE STAKES - 1600 Metres (cont'd)

PARTY PRINCESS (T. Voorham) - inclined to shift about under pressure in the straight and near the 200m shifted out and away from SILENT SOVEREIGN into the running line of PUDDING (NZ).

RACE 6: THOMAS FARMS CENTAUREA STAKES - 2028 Metres

AGREEABLE (C. Williams) - slow to begin.

HUNBOSHI (NZ) (J. Mott) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground from near the 400m until near the 200m.

CAP DE JOIE (GB) (W. Egan) - rider reported that the mare may have come to the end of its preparation. Trainer, Mr N. Ryan, confirmed CAP DE JOIE (GB) would now be spelled. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the off hind leg (2/5). Trainer, Mr N. Ryan, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

STARSPANGLED BABY (J. Eaton) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

WARM SMILE (GB) (J. Holder) - held up from the 500m until inside the 300m.

RACE 7: PETALUMA PROUD MISS STAKES - 1200 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes to avoid a clash with an interstate event.

HYPOTHETICAL (D. Oliver) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and contacted SO SAY ANGEL.

FOXICON (W. Egan) - held up from the 400m until near the 200m.

I AM BENE (C. Murray) - Stewards acceded to a request from trainer, Mr A. Clarken, that the mare not race in bar plates as declared due to the track downgrade. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to start. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground from near the 500m until inside the 300m.

GAZE GRISE (K. Crowther) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.


CALLA DREAM (R. Hurdle) - co-trainer, Mr R. Daniel, advised Stewards prior to the event of a change of tactics in that he would instruct the rider to attempt to gain cover in today's event. Settled behind the leader. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SO SAY ANGEL (P. Moloney) - made contact with the barrier structure whilst being loaded. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to start. Contacted on jumping away. Rider reported that the mare commenced to weaken from the 500m and near the 400m he had become concerned with its action and for this reason had not ridden out in his usual manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the near hind (4/5). Trainer, Mr R. Balfour, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to future jump-out, trial or race start.

LEGLISS LADY (J. Holder) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CIRCLE OF MAGIC (NZ) (T. Pannell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8: THE TAB GOODWOOD - 1200 Metres



SAVATOXL (C. Jones) - inside the 200m had to alter course to the outside of FREE OF DEBT, which shifted in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CURRAN (C. Newitt) - approaching the finish improved onto the heels of KALLOS resulting in the rider being unable to ride out in his usual manner to the finish.



RACE 8: THE TAB GOODWOOD - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

FREE OF DEBT (J. Potter) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

LOFTY STRIKE (J. Mott) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin. Shortly after was inconvenienced when tightened between GENERAL BEAU and FRONT PAGE, which both shifted ground slightly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

ZOUTORI (C. Williams) - rider reported that in his opinion the gelding did not handle the track condition. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GENERAL BEAU (L. Neindorf) - held up for a short distance at the entrance to the straight. When questioned in relation to his riding of the horse to the finish he stated that he had not persisted in riding in his normal manner as he had commenced to improve quickly onto the heels of SERADESS.

NOT AN OPTION (P. Moloney) - jumped away awkwardly.

ROYAL MERCHANT (M. Dee) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

ANOTHER AWARD (J. Holder) - Stewards permitted J. Holder to ride the gelding 0.5kg over its allocated weight of 52.5kg. Rider explained that the mare laid out under pressure in the early part of the straight, resulting in him being hesitant to take a run between FRONT PAGE and SERADESS inside the 300m. He added that from near the 200m he was able to improve into that run and finish the race off strongly. When further questioned in relation to his use of the whip he stated that in his opinion the mare responds better to hands and heels riding and for this reason he did not draw the whip.

RACE 9: GRAND SYNDICATES HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

JACKS ON ICE (J. Toeroek) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

SOMEWATT FABULOUS (K. Crowther) - jumped away awkwardly. Held up at the entrance to the straight and then had difficulty obtaining clear ground until the 200m. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the near foreleg (2/5). Co-trainers, Mr R. Jolly and Miss C. Jolly, were advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

DASH IT (T. Voorham) - slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KNIGHTSTOWN (T. Pannell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

STARSONGARI (S. Tomlinson) - slow to begin. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

TOAST THE DEEL (M. Lloyd) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until approaching the 200m.

ALOTAFUN (J. Mott) - Stewards acceded to a request from trainer, Mr S. Cahill, that the mare be declared a late scratching due to the track downgrade. ALOTAFUN was declared a late scratching at 12.30pm.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow D. Oliver (MIDNIGHT MASS (NZ)), placed second to view the vision in the straight.
