RACE 1: ELDERS INSURANCE MOUNT GAMBIER CLASS ONE HANDICAP - 1812 Metres

BELOVED STAR (C. Puls) - raced wide without cover for the majority of the event.

CELTIC BRUT (NZ) (D. Caboche) - raced keen in the middle stages of the event.

DANRENA (H. Yuen) - raced keen in the middle stages of the event. Held up momentarily near the 450m and again near the 250m.

RACE 2: TRIPLE M 90.5 LIMESTONE COAST MAIDEN PLATE - 1562 Metres

BIG TOWN (H. Grace) - raced wide without cover for the majority of the event.

LUDO (NZ) (N. Farley) - buffeted and lost ground at the start between LEGGY PEGGY and RED PATROL (NZ).

RED PATROL (NZ) (K Walters) - shifted out at the start and bumped LUDO (NZ).



RACE 2: TRIPLE M 90.5 LIMESTONE COAST MAIDEN PLATE - 1562 Metres (cont'd)

BLACKBOOK (M. Julius) - raced keen in the early and middle stages of the event.

FINANCE LEGEND (T. Madden) - when questioned in regards to the performance of the colt rider explained that FINANCE LEGEND was able to obtain a nice position midfield; however, was under pressure from the 600m and proved disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LEGGY PEGGY (H. Yuen) - shifted in at the start and bumped LUDO (NZ). Laid out rounding the home turn and in the straight.

RACE 3: CHRISTMAS TWILIGHT RACES FRIDAY DECEMBER 1 MAIDEN PLATE - 1212 Metres

AL NAZARI (J. Lorensini) - held up and unable to improve between the 400m and 300m behind REEL LIPPY and to the inside of HOT FLUSH.

FRISE (D. Tourneur) – slow to begin. Had difficulty obtaining clear running between the 150m and 50m.

REEL LIPPY (T. Madden) – when questioned in regards to the performance rider stated that the mare raced wide for the majority of the event and when placed under pressure failed to respond. He added that in his opinion the mare may be better suited when ridden quieter in the early stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: CARLTON DRAUGHT BENCHMARK 68 HANDICAP - 2062 Metres

TEEMENZED (NZ) (N. Farley) - faltered near the 900m and was restrained from the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a compound fracture to the off hind pastern and consequently the gelding was humanely euthanized.

RACE 5: SCOTT GROUP OF COMPANIES BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP - 1562 Metres

The start of this event was delayed owing to an issue with the running rail near the 500m.

DR DEE DEE (R. Milnes) - slow to begin.

HASTA LA FIORENTE (D. Tourneur) - bumped near the 950m by SOCIALITE MISS and became unbalanced.

VIVACIOUS AWARD (C. Puls) - hung in rounding the home turn and in the straight, and proved difficult to ride.

SOCIALITE MISS (H. Grace) – near the 950m shifted in, bumped the rail and then shifted back out and bumped HASTA LA FIORENTE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the off foreleg (2/5). Trainer, Ms R. Winnell, was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race start.

RACE 6: LIVING TURF RATING 0 - 56 HANDICAP - 1212 Metres

HEAVY ROTATION (J. Lorensini) - held up and unable to improve between the 500m and 300m.

GETONIT (T. Madden) - shifted out near the 600m and bumped ORCHESTRATE.

HARRY HOT PANTS (D. Tourneur) - near the 250m was bumped by AUTUMN ROSE.

AUTUMN ROSE (D. Caboche) – slow to begin. Shifted in near the 250m and bumped HARRY HOT PANTS.

ORCHESTRATE (A. Kelly) - rider explained that near the 600m was bumped by GETONIT and became unbalanced, and thereafter was reluctant to stretch out and was not fully tested. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: TAB BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1412 Metres

WHISKEY HANGOVER (J. Lorensini) - late scratching by order of the Stewards at 3.52pm, acting on a request from trainer Mr J. Searle due to the track upgrade.

CARAK (M. Julius) - held up and unable to improve between the 550m and the 400m.

SESAR (A. Kelly) - began awkwardly.

ANY LUCK (NZ) (K. Walters) - raced keen in the early and middle stages of the event. When questioned in relation to the performance of the mare, rider explained ANY LUCK (NZ) was worked up pre- race. She added that it was a step up in grade and although she was disappointed with the performance she felt that the mare would benefit from the experience and would be better suited over more ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DUKE OF ANJOU (S. Fawke) - when questioned in relation to the tactics adopted in today's event rider explained that he was instructed to be in a handy position; however, after beginning well from a wide gate he looked to see if there was any speed inside him and as it appeared that nothing wanted to go forward, he elected to allow his horse to obtain the lead, which it did without applying any pressure. He added that the gelding travelled well in front.

STONEFIELD (D. Caboche) - slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.
