# Racing SA Ltd Stipendiary Stewards' Report



Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse by the Gawler & Barossa Jockey Club on Friday, 27 October 2023

TRIMBOLI SERVICES 'ROAD TO THE JERICHO' BENCHMARK 75 HANDICAP-RACE 1: 3340 Metres

THISTLER (J. Potter) - the rider explained in relation to the gelding's performance, that it was off the bridle for a long way and was disappointing in the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slow post-race recovery.

BEAR ARMS (L. Neindorf) - rider explained in relation to the mare's performance that it was not given a smooth run throughout the event and was taken on in the lead, on numerous occasions which was detrimental to the mare's performance. He further added that BEAR ARMS may not have handled the track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WRISTBAND (S. Logan) - slow to begin.

STAYING STRONG (D. Caboche) - near the 700m shifted out onto WARRANDYTE ROAD, which was obliged to be steadied when tightened onto THISTLER. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) and was advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

WARRANDYTE ROAD (A. Jordsjo) - near the 700m was obliged to be steadied when tightened onto THISTLER as STAYING STRONG shifted out.



# RACE 2: RAY WHITE BAROSSA VALLEY TWO WELLS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE (1) - 1100 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute.

ASTAIRES (B. Wong) - rider reported that the gelding hung out rounding the home turn.

KINDRA PARK (S. Logan) - rider reported the gelding raced greenly throughout the event.

KNIGHT DANCER (A. Lindsay) - shortly after the start shifted in onto ALIBIS, which clipped the heels of that gelding and lost ground. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised to take stronger action sooner, in future.

LORD VALEN (R. Hurdle) - approaching the 800m when racing greenly rolled in and shifted in onto ALIBIS, which had improved quickly to the inside of that gelding. Rider was reminded of his obligations under AR131(a).

ME NAME'S HARRY (A. Livesey) - slow to begin.

RUSCHEYNE (J. Potter) - on jumping away bumped with SOCIAL DANCER. Rider explained in relation to the gelding's performance that his mount jumped away well, travelled well in the early and middle stages; however, did not quicken in the straight as he had anticipated. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ZESTY SPICE (R. Milnes) - shortly after the start was taken in by SOCIAL DANCER. Inclined to shift about under pressure in the straight when racing greenly.

ALIBIS (D. Tourneur) - shortly after the start bumped with EVEN SHARPER and shortly after rolled out and clipped the heels of KNIGHT DANCER, which shifted in and as a result the filly lost ground. Approaching the 800m was obliged to be steadied when it improved quickly to the inside of LORD VALEN, which had rolled in and shifted in when racing greenly.

SOCIAL DANCER (J. Opperman) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped RUSCHEYNE. Shortly after shifted in onto ZESTY SPICE, which was taken in.

SIR PANAMA (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and shortly after shifted back in.

#### RACE 3: BAROSSA DISTILLING CO THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE (2) - 1100 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute to avoid a clash with an interstate event (Rockhampton).

GEEIJO (J. Toeroek) – slow to begin. Rider explained that it was his intention to settle further forward in the event; however, given the manner in which the gelding began, he was unable to do so

IT'S DAN THE MAN (C. Murray) - slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

NASHO (J. Potter) - laid out under pressure over the concluding stages.

OUR DIVINYL (J. Holder) - approaching the 800m was tightened between SANPAGO and SHADOWFAX, which was laying in and shifted in.

SANPAGO (R. Hurdle) - approaching the 800m when racing keenly, raced in restricted room between NASHO and OUR DIVINYL, which was taken in.

SHADOWFAX (T. Voorham) - approaching the 800m when laying in, shifted in, despite the efforts of its rider, onto OUR DIVINYL, which was tightened onto SANPAGO. Rider reported that the gelding laid in throughout the event.

STAGING ALIVE (S. Fawke) - hung out rounding the home turn.



#### RACE 4: KINGSFORD HOTEL MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres

AMBELLO (J. Toeroek) -over raced in the early stages and when being restrained near the 800m shifted in onto ADOPTED SON, which was racing keenly and was obliged to be restrained when awkwardly placed on the heels of that gelding. On return to the mounting yard it was reported AMBELLO had dislodged its tongue tie.

FIRST TOSEN (T. Voorham) - held up for clear running from the 400m until inside the 200m and was tightened between INNER SANCTUM, which was taken in and WANNASCHMACK, which was racing greenly and shifted out. As a result FIRST TOSEN shifted in to obtain clear running. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

INNER SANCTUM (J. Potter) - inside the 200m was obliged to be eased when tightened between FIRST TOSEN as BEACH STREET shifted in.

LA DEFENSE (B. Price) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race.

WANNASCHMACK (S. Payne) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced greenly throughout event. Inclined to hang out under pressure in the straight despite the efforts of its rider and near the 200m shifted out taking FIRST TOSEN wider.

BEACH STREET (J. Holder) - inside the 200m shifted in onto INNER SANCTUM, which was obliged to be eased when tightened onto FIRST TOSEN. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised, in future, to take greater care when shifting ground.

CARARADA (C. Murray) - jumped away awkwardly. Over the final 100m was untested to the line when awkwardly placed on the heels of AMBELLO. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the near hind leg (2/5). Trainer, Mr J. Hyam was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race.

VALIEVA (C. Tootell) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped ADOPTED SON. Raced greenly rounding the home turn and under pressure in the straight.

ADOPTED SON (A. Lindsay) - on jumping away bumped with VALIEVA. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages approaching the 800m when racing keenly was restrained when awkwardly placed on the heels of AMBELLO.

#### RACE 5: MATRIX SOLAR SOLUTIONS MAIDEN PLATE - 1500 Metres

CALL ME AL (L. Neindorf) - held up for clear running from approaching the 400m until the entrance to the straight. Rider explained in relation to the gelding's performance that it was held up at a crucial stage of the event and he was unable to gain momentum to best suit CALL ME AL to finish the event off. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CHEF MILITAIRE (S. Tomlinson) - raced wide without cover from the 1200m. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

HIT THE SLOPES (B. Price) – slow to begin. Held up for clear running from the 400m until approaching the 100m. Near the 300m attempted to improve into a run between TROPOPAUSE and SLIM JIM, which rolled out marginally and shortly after attempted a run to the inside of SLIM JIM; however, that gelding rolled in slightly and as a consequence HIT THE SLOPES was obliged to be restrained and shift out in an attempt to gain clear running.

STOKEDOWN (T. Pannell) – rider explained in relation to the gelding's performance that he settled further forward than he had anticipated in the event and when asked for an effort failed to respond to his riding and was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have cardiac arrhythmia (1st occurrence). Trainer Mr D. Jolly was advised that he was required to comply with the Racing Australia Code of Practice in order for the gelding to be reinstated to race.

URRIPIE (S. Payne) - jumped away awkwardly.

ELECTRA BLUE (J. Potter) - from its wider barrier was restrained and shifted in, in attempt to gain cover.

#### RACE 5: MATRIX SOLAR SOLUTIONS MAIDEN PLATE - 1500 Metres (cont'd)

MAIDEN FLIGHT (A. Jordsjo) - slow into stride. Laid out over the final 100m of the event.

SLIM JIM (D. Tourneur) - inside the 1000m became awkward in its action and shifted out abruptly. Lost its off hind plate during the event.

BURNING BRIGHT (J. Holder) - Stewards permitted J. Holder to ride 0.5kg over its declared weight of 54.0kg.

DIAMOND SUNRISE (J. Doyle) - over raced in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

### RACE 6: IRONGATE AUSTRALIA RATING 0 - 56 HANDICAP - 1700 Metres

RUE BUNGAN (J. Potter) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Rider could offer no explanation in relation to the gelding's poor performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slow post-race recovery.

ENLIST (A. Jordsjo) - kicked by another runner behind the barriers. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination which revealed a laceration to its off hind hock and was deemed unsuitable to race. First race administered. Acting on this advice ENLIST was declared a late scratching at 4.37pm. Trainer, Mr M. Seyers was advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race.

LORD GEORGE (D. Caboche) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in onto SIPSMITH. Rider reported that in his opinion the gelding may have been sore behind. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PICK ME (S. Metcalfe) – rider could offer no explanation in relation to the gelding's performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SIPSMITH (T. Pannell) - shortly after the start lost its position when tightened onto PICK ME as LORD GEORGE shifted in.

AUSSIE SOJOURN (H. Yuen) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

## RACE 7: ADELAIDE PLAINS BLOODSTOCK EVANSTON SPRINT BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

SECRET WAR (H. Yuen) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

EXALTED TRAIL (J. Potter) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not raced since February 2020 and was deemed suitable to race. Slow into stride.

VALAROC (H. Edgley) - hung out under pressure in the straight.

WILLYBEAFACTOR (S. Metcalfe) - on jumping away shifted in onto KING MOYA and shortly after continued to shift in.

DELCREDERE (H. Grace) - hung in under pressure in the straight.

KING MOYA (J. Holder) - on jumping away was inconvenienced when tightened between HELLO LADIES and WILLYBEAFACTOR, which shifted in. Shortly after lost its position as WILLYBEAFACTOR continued to shift in. Rider explained in relation to the gelding's performance that after receiving pressure on jumping away the gelding never travelled during the event and was very plain over the final 200m. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.





MONTIGN (K. Crowther) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Rider explained that the gelding raced flat in the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CHICAGO STORM (J. Holder) - Stewards permitted J. Holder to ride 0.5kg over its declared weight of 54.0kg.

ADELAIDE ACE (NZ) (B. Price) - rider reported that the gelding was disappointing in the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SPLASH SOME CASH (A. Livesey) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

THIRSTY GUEST (J. Opperman) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

TEXAN WINDSTORM (H. Grace) - held up for clear running for a short distance near the 200m when racing between EAST INDIAMAN and NOT USUAL GLORIOUS.

ZOFFALA (H. Yuen) - jumped away awkwardly.

### RACE 9: COOPERS BREWERY FILLIES & MARES RATING 0 - 64 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

BELLALIQUE (J. Toeroek) - jumped away awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

JILLADORA (S. Fawke) - slow to begin.

SUGGESTIVE MISS (A. Livesey) - held up for clear running rounding the home turn for a short distance. Lost its off fore plate during the event.

ALOTAFUN (D. Tourneur) - held up for clear running from near the 400m until near the 100m. Near the 200m when attempting a tight run, was obliged to be steadied when tightened between FLUFFY BUNNY FEET and CHEROKEE MISS, which shifted in slightly.

CHILKO LAKE (J. Opperman) - shortly after jumping away was unable to improve its position as CHEROKEE MISS had shifted out.

CHEROKEE MISS (K. Crowther) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto CHILKO LAKE.

RACE 6: ZOBEL FINANCE NARACOORTE BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

TAN TAT BEAU (H. Yuen) – on Tuesday, 24 October 2023, Co-Trainer, Mr. A. Bain reported the gelding was inspected by his stable veterinarian and was sound on a trot up inspection; however, an endoscopic examination revealed mucus in the trachea. Mr Bain further advised TAN TAT BEAU will undergo the relevant treatment and the stables intention is to continue on with the gelding's preparation.
