RACE 1: SPRINGFIELD FARM MAIDEN PLATE - 2050 Metres

CAMBERWOOD (J. Holder) - passing the winning post on the first occasion was tightened for room by PUISSY GALORE, which in turn was tightened for room by KEMI, which was taken in by HUSSLING, which shifted in when not clear.

KEMI (H. Yuen) - passing the winning post on the first occasion was taken in off its course and hampered by HUSSLING, which shifted in when not clear.

MILITARY ACTION (S. Tomlinson) - passing the winning post on the first occasion was checked severely when tightened for room by CAMBERWOOD, which was taken in by PUISSY GALORE, which in turn was taken in by KEMI, which was taken in by HUSSLING, which shifted in when not clear.

CITYOFCHURCHES (T. Voorham) - rider reported that it was her intention to ride the mare back in the field; however CITYOFCHURCHES commenced to race keenly in the early stages and as a result she permitted her mount to stride forward and race in a forward position.

DARK'N'STORMY (S. Fawke) – performed poorly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer, Mr K. Knowles was advised the mare must perform to the Stewards' satisfaction in a trial or jump-out prior to a future race.

GREY FOLLY (R. Milnes) - rider reported that the mare laid in under pressure in the straight.



RACE 1: SPRINGFIELD FARM MAIDEN PLATE - 2050 Metres (cont'd)

HUSSLING (A. Livesey) – passing the winning post on the first occasion shifted in when not clear of KEMI, which was taken in onto PUISSY GALORE, which in turn was taken in onto CAMBERWOOD, which was taken in onto MILITARY ACTION, which had to be checked. Rider was found guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR131(a) in that passing the winning post on the first occasion she permitted her mount to shift in when not clear of KEMI and took that gelding in onto PUISSY GALORE, which was tightened for room, taken in and had to be steadied which resulted in PUISSY GALORE tightening the running of CAMBERWOOD, which was taken in onto MILITARY ACTION, which had to be severely checked and lost its rightful running. Rider was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence midnight Thursday, 9 November 2023 and to conclude midnight Friday, 24 November 2023, a period of seven meetings. In determining penalty, Stewards took into account A. Livesey's record, plea and degree of interference involved in the incident.

PUISSY GALORE (K. Crowther) - passing the winning post on the first occasion was tightened for room and had to be steadied when KEMI was taken in by HUSSLING, which shifted in when not clear.

RACE 2: MOUNT COMPASS SAND MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

SAM'S REWARD (R. Milnes) - slow to begin.

THE BULL MCCABE (T. Pannell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding exhibited signs of the thumps. First aid administered.

WICKED WISH (S. Logan) - began awkwardly. Over raced in the early stages.

ASTROMANCER (C. Reynolds) - performed below market expectations. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MISSILE STAR (M. Collett) - near the 900m was steadied to avoid the heels of CHIARO, which shifted in when not fully clear. Rider was reminded of his obligations under AR131(a) and advised to exercise more care in similar circumstances.

REVOLUTION BELLE (H. Edgley) - held up from near the 300m until passing the 200m.

ROLL START (A. Jordsjo) - near the 1000m was steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of MISSILE STAR.

SIR PHOENIX (NZ) (J. Holder) - slow to begin.

CHIARO (J. Potter) - near the 900mshifted in when not fully clear of MISSLE STAR. Rider was reminded of his obligations under AR131(a) and advised to exercise more care in similar circumstances

RACE 3: CHALK HILL VITICULTURE BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1600 Metres

MASTER OF ZERPRISE (E. Finnegan) - slow to begin.

SEAFARING (NZ) (M. Collett) - slow to begin.

VEE ROD (NZ) (L. Neindorf) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 4: PETER MOODY'S 80TH BIRTHDAY CLASS ONE HCP - 1350 Metres

RABTAT (B. Price) - hampered at the start when bumped by TERAMBI. Held up for clear running from near the 550m until passing the 300m.

EVENTUALLY (R. Milnes) - rider reported that the mare was disappointing and did not respond to her riding as she had anticipated when placed under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: PETER MOODY'S 80TH BIRTHDAY CLASS ONE HCP - 1350 Metres (cont'd)

KEEP SWINGING (H. Yuen) - raced wide without cover throughout. Near the 400m rider was obliged to take hold to avoid the heels of MEDAL QUEST, which shifted out after being bumped by RULING GODDESS.

PILLOW GUY (M. Collett) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Rider reported the gelding raced greenly in the straight.

SASSY ANGEL (A. Livesey) - began awkwardly and as a result lost ground.

OFF THE CUFF (C. Reynolds) – near the 400m was severely hampered and taken out off its course when being checked to avoid the heels of KEEP SWINGING, which had steadied to avoid the heels of MEDAL QUEST, which had shifted out after being bumped by RULING GODDESS.

TERAMBI (H. Edgley) - began awkwardly, shifted in and bumped RABTAT. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a poor post-race recovery. Stable advised that the Stewards will be informed if any issues arise with the gelding in the coming days.

MISS ELLAROSE (C. Tootell) - approaching the winning post had to be steadied to avoid the heels of DARE TO BE FREE when awkwardly placed on the heels of that mare.

RULING GODDESS (S. Tomlinson) – near the 400m when improving shifted out and bumped MEDAL QUEST. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR131(a) in that near the 400m he permitted his mount to shift out when improving, which resulted in his mount bumping MEDAL QUEST, which shifted out after being bumped and resulted in KEEP SWINGING, which was following MEDAL QUEST being obliged to take hold and shift out to avoid that mare's heels. OFF THE CUFF, which was racing to the outside KEEP SWINGING was then checked to avoid the heels of KEEP SWINGING severely hampered and taken out off its course. Rider was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence midnight Wednesday, 8 November 2023 and to conclude midnight Sunday, 12 November 2023, a period of three meetings. In determining penalty, Stewards took into account S. Tomlinson's record and his guilty plea.

MEDAL QUEST (J. Doyle) - near the 400m was bumped heavily by RULING GODDESS, which shifted out when not clear.

SUVARNAH – as there was no rider available, Stewards declared SUVARNAH a late scratching at 7:55am.

RACE 5: NORTH EAST AUTO WHOLESALE BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

DEEVINE (A. Livesey) - rider reported that the gelding laid in under pressure in the straight.

BRAZANO (J. Potter) - rider reported that the gelding changed stride and became unbalanced near the 1100m.

LORD MORTON (J. Toeroek) - near the 1100m shifted in when not fully clear of TUPOLEU, which had to be steadied to avoid the gelding's heels. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised to ensure that he is clear of other runners when shifting ground in future.

TUPOLEU (J. Holder) - began awkwardly. Over raced in the early stages. Near the 1100m was steadied to avoid the heels of LORD MORTON, which shifted in when not fully clear.

NO ENTITLEMENT (R. Milnes) - held up for clear running from near the 400m until passing the 200m.

RACE 6: GOOLWA MEATS FILLIES & MARES RATING 0-56 HANDICAP - 1350 Metres

WHENTHEDEELINGSDUN (H. Edgley) - bumped on jumping away by COME AGAIN, which shifted out. Rider reported that the mare did not respond to her riding when placed under pressure and was, in her opinion, disappointing and may be feeling the effects of recent racing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LYNDA'S LEGACY (J. Doyle) - on jumping away was tightened for room between SEE YOU LATER NOW, which shifted out and SNAPTOF, which shifted in.

RACE 6: GOOLWA MEATS FILLIES & MARES RATING 0-56 HANDICAP - 1350 Metres (cont'd)

SWAMP VIXEN (J. Toeroek) - rider reported that despite his efforts the mare showed little early speed and as a result settled further back than intended. He added that when placed under pressure in the straight, the mare responded to his riding only fairly and was somewhat disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KACIGA (K. Crowther) - raced wide without cover throughout. Rider reported that the mare laid out under pressure rounding the home turn and in the early part of the straight.

COME AGAIN (J. Potter) - began awkwardly, shifted out and made heavy contact with WHENTHEDEELINGSDUN. As a result J Potter became unbalanced for a short distance.

EMINENCIA (J. Holder) – lost its near hind plate during the event. At the entrance to the straight near the 350m was steadied when there was insufficient room to improve between KACIGA, which shifted out slightly and LYNDA'S LEGACY. Shortly after the mare shifted to the outside of LYNDA'S LEGACY to obtain clear running.

SEE YOU LATER NOW (S. Fawke) - began awkwardly, shifted out and brushed with LYNDA'S LEGACY.

RACE 7: COMMERCIAL HOTEL COLTS, GELDINGS & ENTIRES RATING 0-56 HANDICAP - 1350 Metres

ARCHDEACON (A. Jordsjo) - began awkwardly. Near the 1000m when racing keenly was steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels PETERZANO.

COMMANDER MEROO (B. Price) – over raced in the early stages. Held up for clear running from near the 400m until near the 200m. Held up over the concluding stages and was not fully tested to the line.

FIORENTE STAR (R. Milnes) - near the 900m when racing tight to the inside of GENERAL MINT laid out across that gelding's heels. As a result lost ground and got its head up when being restrained by its rider for several strides. Raced erratically for a short distance after.

GENERAL MINT (S. Tomlinson) - gave ground quickly in the straight. Rider could offer no explanation for the gelding's performance other than it was very disappointing and did not respond to his riding when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CHONCAPE (H. Yuen) - raced wide without cover throughout. Near the 900m was hampered and obliged to shift out abruptly to avoid the heels of FIORENTE STAR, which had shifted out abruptly after laying out across the heels of GENERAL MINT.
