

Racing SA Ltd Stipendiary Stewards' Report

Report on Race Meeting held at Ceduna
Racecourse by the Ceduna Racing Club on
Saturday, 3 February 2024

TRACK: Dirt / Good (More loosened surface than fast, some kickback may be evident)

RAIL: True.

WEATHER: Fine

RACE 1: TERRY WHITE CHEMMART CEDUNA/WCT RURAL/WIKINSON
PLUMBING/DEMPSEY'S FEED & SADDLERY MAIDEN PLATE - 1000 Metres

SEVEN RAYS (I. Lam) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course and was deemed suitable to start.

HUMEA (C. Munro) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course and was found to be lame in the off hind leg (2/5) and therefore deemed unsuitable to start. Acting on this advice Stewards declared HUMEA a late scratching at 12.16pm.

TONIGHTS THE NIGHT (D. Gillett) - laid in, in the straight.

TYPAR (M. Henderson) - stood flat-footed and was slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow Stewards to review the vision of the start in relation to TYPAR.

RACE 2: TOYOTA AUSTRALIA FEATURE SPRINT BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

RICHED (S. Fawke) - hung in, in the straight. Rider explained that his mount was off the bridle from the 500m and was disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CHAMPAGNE AFFAIR (M. Henderson) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course and was deemed suitable to start.

RACE 3: LETCHER MORONEY / MIDSEC FINANCIAL ADVISORS BENCHMARK 52 TROPHY
RACE - 1200 Metres

STAKE A CLAIM (Z. Lloyd) - jumped away awkwardly.

MANDRAGORIAN (M. Henderson) - slow to begin.

MIZZ BEEBEEFF (A. Lai) - held up from the 400m to the 300m when racing to the inside of SANBUCK, and was obliged to alter course to obtain clear ground.

RACE 3: LETCHER MORONEY / MIDSEC FINANCIAL ADVISORS BENCHMARK 52 TROPHY
RACE - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

SANBUCK (D. Gillett) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100m and was suspended for a period to commence midnight Monday, 5 February 2024 to conclude midnight Saturday, 10 February 2024, a period of three meetings, and also fined \$200. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for the totality of the use of the whip by D. Gillett and noted that she used it on five occasions over the final 100m of the event.

KURIMUZON (J. Doyle) – rider reported that in her opinion her mount did not handle the track conditions and didn't appreciate the kickback. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow D. Gillett (SANBUCK), placed third, to view the official photo.

RACE 4: MCEVOY TRANSPORT / EYRE PREMIX CONCRETE BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP -
1300 Metres

ICE HUNT (I. Lam) – rider reported that in her opinion her mount did not handle the track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SUNNY GREEN (S. Fawke) – rider reported that in his opinion his mount did not handle the track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: CEDUNA FORESHORE HOTEL CEDUNA CUP - 1600 Metres

GRINZINGER ALLEE (NZ) (A. Lai) – rider explained that when asked for an effort the gelding did not respond to his riding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed an abnormal respiratory noise. Co-trainers, Ms K McKerlie and Mr W. Hornhardt, were advised that the results of an endoscopic examination and a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to presenting the gelding for a future jump-out, trial or race.

PERSIAN EMPIRE (NZ) (S. Fawke) – rider explained that the gelding was not suited by the pattern of the race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DIAMONDS ARE (I. Lam) – rider was questioned in relation to the tactics adopted in today's event. She explained that she was instructed to find a position at the back of the field as the gelding is usually slow to begin; however, as the gelding jumped away better than expected she took the initiative to find a forward position. Trainer, Ms M. Gillespie, confirmed the instructions.

RACE 6: VITERRA AUSTRALIA BUSHY TRENOWDEN MEMORIAL BENCHMARK 52 TROPHY
RACE - 1600 Metres

JAMCRA (NZ) (S. Fawke) – laid out in the straight. Rider reported that he lost the use of his off side iron for a few strides in the early stages of the event.

BARON OF BEDFORD (NZ) (C. Munro) – rider reported that her mount did not feel comfortable in its action in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

THIS ONE DAD (A. Lai) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. Hung in, in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.
