RACE 1: AGGREKO MAIDEN PLATE - 1800 Metres

I'M APRANCER (J. Doyle) - near the 300m dipped for no apparent reason and laid out for the remainder of the event.


MAVEN MISSILE (Z. Lloyd) - contacted a gate when being loaded into its barrier. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race.

OUR SWOOSH (NZ) (W. Cave) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid in, in the straight.

ICONIC JEWEL (C. Munro) - jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

ONE DASH (T. Hutchinson) - approaching the finish became awkwardly placed on the heels of OUR SWOOSH (NZ), which laid in.

WIRRINYA (A. Lai) - jumped away awkwardly.



RACE 2: FOUND IN CLARE MENS BOUTIQUE WINES COLTS, GELDINGS & ENTIRES MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres

INNER SANCTUM (A. Lai) - approaching the 100m laid in and away from STAR VALOUR onto SHADOWIST.

SHADOWIST (W. Cave) - approaching the 100m raced in restricted room for a short distance between SPINACH and INNER SANCTUM, which laid in.

MACSPARK (P. Brewster) - rider explained that the gelding travelled well throughout; however, in the straight laid in and wandered about. She added that MACSPARK did not finish the event off as she had anticipated. Rider was reminded of her obligations under AR131(b) to ensure she rides her mounts out to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

STAR VALOUR (I. Lam) - laid in, in the straight

RACE 3: JIM BARRY FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres

MIS GUIDED CHOICE (I. Lam) - rider reported that the mare never travelled. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the near hind leg (2/5). Co-trainers, Mr J. Dunn and Ms K. Bishop were advised that a Veterinary Clearance would be required prior to a future jump-out, trial or race.

NINA DURA (C. Munro) - laid in, in the straight

DARK HELMET (NZ) (T. Hutchinson) - contacted at the start by TRUE GEM. Hung out throughout the event.

TARA RANI (S. Logan) - approaching the 150m was accidentally struck in the head by the whip of T. Hutchinson (DARK HELMET (NZ)).

TRUE GEM (W. Cave) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and contacted DARK HELMET (NZ).

WADAANA (P. Brewster) - became awkwardly placed on the heels of EMMOOKI MAGIC between the 400m and 300m. Laid in, in the straight and proved difficult to ride out to the finish.

EMMOOKI MAGIC (C. Tootell) - was unable to be ridden out to the finish when the mare became awkwardly placed on the heels on the heels of WADAANA.

RACE 4: PLATINUM AG SERVICES RATING 0 - 56 HANDICAP - 1800 Metres

CHARLESFORT (F. Atkinson) - jumped away awkwardly.

FEARLESS AL (C. Munro) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HOSTESS SUSIE (N. Seymour) - slow to begin. Rider explained that with the fast pace of the event the mare got further back than anticipated and finished the race off well.

AXECAPITAL (NZ) (C. Tootell) - jumped away awkwardly.

THE CHAPLAIN (S. Logan) - slow to begin.

RACE 5: SPORTSBET RATING 0 - 58 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

FOURTH POWER (T. Hutchinson) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped BONJOUR MON AMOUR. Shortly after the start rider lost the use of her near side iron and was unable to regain use of that iron until in the vicinity of the 800m.

MYOCEAN WARRIOR (N. Seymour) - jumped away awkwardly.

BRAZANO (C. Munro) - laid in, in the straight.



RACE 5: SPORTSBET RATING 0 - 58 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

JUSTA JILLAROO (C. Tootell) - following the declaration of acceptances Trainer, Mr J. Lukey made a gear application to remove blinkers to the mare's race gear. Stewards acceded to this request and acting under AR206(2) fined Mr Lukey \$200. Laid in, in the straight.

BONJOUR MON AMOUR (I. Lam) - bumped on jumping away by FOURTH POWER. Laid in, in the straight.

RACE 6: SAW MILL GIN RATING 0 - 52 HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

MANDRAGORIAN (S. Logan) - laid in, in the straight.

LEON'S SHOUT (I. Lam) - near the 700m improved onto the heels of MANDRAGORIAN, shifted out and inconvenienced L'ESPERANCE ROCK. Rider was reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised to only shift ground when entitled to do so, in future.

THE CASSINI (C. Munro) - laid in, in the straight. Near the 200m became awkward in its action for a short distance.

BITE YOUR TONGUE (P. Brewster) - raced in restricted room between MELMAC and L'ESPERANCE ROCK from the 100m until the finish.

L'ESPERANCE ROCK (N. Seymour) - near the 700m was obliged to be steadied to avoid the heels of LEON'S SHOUT. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the 300m until the 100m.

SEPORIA (F. Atkinson) - jumped away awkwardly.

SON OF AKEED (J. Doyle) - slow to begin. Rider reported that the gelding laid out in the straight.

RACE 7: SC HEINRICH AND CO BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

TOMMY TOMATO (W. Cave) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

JUSTICA'S BONUS (C. Tootell) - jumped away awkwardly. In the vicinity of the 900m rider had to adjust her foot in to the stirrup iron to re-gain full use.

RICHED (J. Kissick) - jumped away awkwardly. In the vicinity of the 150m improved onto the heels of JUSTICA'S BONUS and was obliged to shift in to obtain clear running to the finish.

BROMELIA (NZ) (J. Doyle) - jumped away awkwardly. Shortly after the start raced in restricted room between TOMMY TOMATO and MORE SNITZEL for a short distance. Raced keenly in the early stages of the event and got its head up on a number of occasions. Rider reported that the mare did not feel comfortable in its action over the final 100m of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FLYIN' FOR US (C. Munro) - hung in under pressure in the straight.

RODNEY (Z. Lloyd) - slow to begin. Held up from the 300m and was unable to be tested to the finish.
