

Racing SA Ltd Stipendiary Stewards' Report



Report on Race Meeting held at Penola Racecourse
by the Penola Racing Club on Sunday, 2 June 2024

RACINGSA

TRACK: Soft 6 (Moist but not a badly affected track)

RAIL: True

WEATHER: Overcast

RACE 1: E.E MUIR & SONS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres

LUDO (NZ) (A. Livesey) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

MANALORE (S. Fawke) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CONSTANT REIGN (M. Collett) - on jumping away had its hind quarters turned out as it bumped with AM I THE DRAMA, which shifted out. Uncompetitive during the event and was beaten 35.8 lengths. Trainer, Mr. M. Sharp was advised the mare is required to prove competitive in an Official Barrier Trial prior accepting for a future race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Mr. Sharp advised Stewards it was his intention to retire CONSTANT REIGN.

MOLEY BELLE (J. Doyle) - slow to begin.

AM I THE DRAMA (T. Voorham) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped CONSTANT REIGN and as a result was slow to begin.

RACE 2: SPORTSBET MAIDEN PLATE - 1600 Metres

FRONTAL ATTACK (A. Livesey) - hung out rounding the home turn and under pressure in the straight and proved difficult for its rider to ride out in her normal manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

I LOVE THIS SONG (C. Murray) - slow to begin.

FRAZIONI (NZ) (J. Eaton) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin. Raced very ungenerous in the early and middle stages and got its head up on a number of occasions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

I'VE GOT THAT (K. Crowther) - slow to begin.

MERCHANT MISS (K. Walters) - raced very ungenerous in the early and middle stages of the event. Near the 1200m was awkwardly placed between the heels of MONOCHROMATIC and FRONTAL ATTACK.



RACE 2: SPORTSBET MAIDEN PLATE - 1600 Metres (cont'd)

SAVSONIC (NZ) (T. Voorham) - laid in under pressure in the straight. Rider explained in relation to the mare's performance that she raced in a wide position throughout the event and this was a detriment to SAVSONIC (NZ)'s performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WAVE FUNCTION (D. Tourneur) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

MISS FIREWATER (J. Opperman) - slow to begin.

RACE 3: COOPERS BREWERY BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

ENLIST (A. Jordsjo) - on jumping away bumped with SO YOU CAN, which shifted out and as a result was slow to begin (approximately one to two lengths).

SO YOU CAN (K. Crowther) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped ENLIST. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

BONJOUR MON AMOUR (B. King) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin (approximately two to three lengths).

RACE 4: SPORTSBET RATING 0 - 54 HANDICAP - 1300 Metres

ZEPHYR WINGS (C. Jones) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto OUR ELLIE ROSE (NZ). A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MESCAMINTO (S. Fawke) - jumped away awkwardly. At the entrance to the straight rolled in and bumped CARRY ON CAMPING.

OUR ELLIE ROSE (NZ) (K. Walters) - on jumping away lost its position when tightened onto TITAN I AM as ZEPHYR WINGS shifted in. Difficulty obtaining clear running from the entrance to the straight until inside the 200m.

CHANTISS (K. Crowther) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course which revealed a skin abrasion to the near side hip and was deemed unsuitable to race. Acting on this advice CHANTISS was declared a late scratching at 12.05pm.

CARRY ON CAMPING (M. Collett) - at the entrance to the straight rolled out and bumped MESCAMINTO.

TITAN I AM (D. Tourneur) - approaching the 1100m dipped. Laid out under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LADY ANNABEL (NZ) (J. Weatherley) - stewards permitted the rider to claim 0.5kg of her 2kg allowance in this event. Rider was reminded of her obligations with relation to being unable to claim down to her minimum riding weight and advised, in future circumstances, to advise the Stewards prior to race day. Slow to begin.

RACE 5: ADRIAN THOMAS INDUSTRIAL BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

DUKE OF ANJOU (J. Opperman) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BURNT BY BERNIE (J. Eaton) - jumped away awkwardly.

IT'S DAN THE MAN (C. Murray) - slow to begin. Laid in under pressure in the straight.



RACE 6: DIGIORGIO FAMILY WINES RATING 0 - 56 HANDICAP - 1700 Metres

SEA OF SECRETS (S. Metcalfe) - raced wide and without cover in the early stages and near the 1200m was eased to obtain cover. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 6: DIGIORGIO FAMILY WINES RATING 0 - 56 HANDICAP - 1700 Metres (cont'd)

FANTASTIC BABY (C. Murray) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LUNA DIVA (K. Crowther) - raced keenly throughout the event. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

CAMBERWOOD (A. Jordsjo) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

DISTURBING (J. Eaton) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and was inconvenienced. Raced keenly throughout the event and near the 1100m got its head up when being restrained. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

PRIZE LAD (D. Caboche) - raced wide and without cover throughout the event.

FIGHTING FUND (D. Tourneur) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

INNOCENT PEGG (K. Walters) - held up for clear running for a short distance inside the 400m. Difficulty obtaining clear running from the entrance to the straight until approaching the 100m.

RACE 7: THE MIDFIELD GROUP BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 2100 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes owing to a clash with an international event (Tokyo).

WALK IN THE WOODS (NZ) (J. Weatherley) - over raced in the early and middle stages despite the efforts of its rider. Weakened from the 500m. When questioned in relation to the gelding's performance, rider explained that the gelding was quite agitated pre-race and after being loaded in the barriers and may have worked itself up. She stated that her instructions were to lead in the event as the gelding is one paced. She said after stepping slightly slow she was obliged to encourage WALK IN THE WOODS to comply with her instructions and on exiting the straight the gelding raced keenly for the majority of the event despite her efforts and this was a detriment to its chances. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FIORANTE SPRITZ (J. Eaton) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

PULVERISER (S. Payne) - held up for clear running from the 500m until near the 400m.

WRITTEN RULZ (Z. Lloyd) - 12-year-old gelding. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was deemed suitable to race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.
