RACE 1: SPORTSBET MAIDEN PLATE - 1350 Metres

DEE MAC (R. Milnes) - jumped away awkwardly. Laid in, in the straight.

GOING OFF (C. Murray) - hung out throughout the event. Rider explained that the gelding began well, and due to the formation of the field he elected to go forward rather than be caught wide, and as a result it led in today's event.

RACE 1: SPORTSBET MAIDEN PLATE - 1350 Metres (cont'd)

LORD AVINGTON (D. Caboche) - beaten 46 lengths. Trainer, Mr B. J. Cozamanis, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to being uncompetitive. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Mr Cozamanis advised Stewards that he would recommend to owners that the gelding be retired.

UNISPHERE (T. Johnstone) - on jumping away was hampered when contacted by ISUSPECTIEU (NZ), which shifted out, and as a result lost its position. Held up from the 250m until the 150m. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

WYES TRIER (J. Doyle) - slow to begin. Raced greenly throughout the event.

ISUSPECTJEU (NZ) (S. Metcalfe) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto UNISPHERE.

LUNE DE BLAZE (F. Atkinson) - rider reported that the mare raced greenly in the event.

RACE 2: PORT LINCOLN HOTEL MAIDEN PLATE - 1210 Metres

BAR TIME BOUY (D. Caboche) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GAME OVER (T. Johnstone) - hung out throughout the event.

RUSCHEYNE (K. Crowther) - laid in, in the straight.

SACRED CHORD (C. Murray) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid in, in the straight. On pulling up dislodged its rider. Rider was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and required further assessment prior to being permitted to fulfil his remaining engagements.

AMILACY (NZ) (B. Price) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and was deemed suitable to start. Rider reported that the mare raced greenly in the straight.

EL EXPLOSIVO (R. Milnes) - approaching the 200m dipped and momentarily unbalanced its rider, and shortly after dipped again.

ROLLING DUCK (J. Doyle) - dipped at the entrance to the straight momentarily unbalancing its rider.

RACE 3: PURCHASE YOUR PLRC SEASON MEMBERSHIP CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

UTILITARIAN (R. Milnes) - held up for clear running from near the 300m until near the 200m.

JAMAICAN GOLD (T. Johnstone) - near the 150m shifted in onto SWIFT TERCEL when insufficiently clear, tightening that horse onto DIAMENTE TAGLIATO forcing A. Livesey to stop riding and take hold of her mount. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR131(a) and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence directly following the expiry of her current suspension on midnight Thursday, 7 November 2024 and conclude midnight Saturday, 16 September 2024, a period of four meetings.

GILDED LADY (S. Fawke) - had difficulty obtaining clear running from near the 200m until near the 100m.

GALLANTRY GIRL (D. Caboche) - slow to begin.

SWIFT TERCEL (A. Livesey) - near the 150m rider had to stop riding and take hold of her mount when tightened onto DIAMENTE TAGLIATO by JAMAICAN GOLD, which shifted in.

TANE TOA (NZ) (F. Atkinson) - approaching the 100m was held up for a short distance.

Following the running of this event C. Murray underwent further assessment by the First Care Medical personnel and passed fit to fulfil his remaining engagements.

RACE 4: CARLTON UNITED BREWERIES RATING 0 - 56 HANDICAP - 1210 Metres

TRYGVE (T. Johnstone) - approaching the 100m was taken in onto MISS THATCHER. Raced in restricted room from inside the 150m until the 50m.

FOSSHIO (C. Murray) - shortly after the start commenced to buck and shifted in abruptly dislodging its rider. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a small wound to the neck and minor abrasions. Trainer, Mr B. Hull, was advised that the gelding would now be required to perform to the satisfaction of Stewards in an Official Barrier Trial prior to a future race start. C. Murray was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and transported to hospital for further assessment and observations.

MISS THATCHER (S. Fawke) - approaching the 100m was eased and altered course to avoid the heels of TRYGVE.

MANDRAGORIAN (D. Caboche) - reared on jumping away, was reluctant to proceed further despite the efforts of its rider and took no further part in the event. Trainer, Mr T. Allen, was advised that the gelding would now be required to complete either an Official Barrier Trial or Approval to Race Jump-out to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to a future race start. Rider was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and passed fit to fulfil his remaining riding engagements.

NADANA (B. Price) - laid in, in the straight. Approaching the 100m, when laying in, shifted in onto TRYGVE taking that gelding in onto MISS THATCHER.

Due to the delay following the incident in this event the remaining races were delayed by one race time and Race 8 was rescheduled to start at 5.49pm.

RACE 5: SPORTSBET RATING 0 - 56 HANDICAP - 1210 Metres

The start of this event was rescheduled to begin at 4.10pm.

TOORAK BLAZE (D. Caboche) - jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin.

BONJOUR (NZ) (S. Fawke) - on jumping away was inconvenienced when tightened between THE LAST DANCE and WHISKY SOUR, and as a result lost its position.

PRESCIENT (A. Jordsjo) - laid in, in the straight.

WHISKY SOUR (M. Wolanin) – near the 150m improved onto the heels of SPIRITUAL GAL, which was weakening, and thereafter raced ungenerously for a short distance when being restrained.

CHILKO LAKE (R. Milnes) - momentarily held up near the 250m.

CHEF DE MISSION (F. Atkinson) - on jumping away was contacted by ORIEDOS, which shifted out.

ORIEDOS (A. Livesey) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and contacted CHEF DE MISSION.

CATALINA BLUE (T. Johnstone) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and was deemed suitable to start.

SPIRITUAL GAL (M. Collett) - knuckled on jumping away.

RACE 6: MCDONALD'S BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1350 Metres

The start of this event was rescheduled to begin at 4.50pm.

HEY MICHAEL (A. Lai) - held up for clear running from near the 400m until approaching the 200m. Inside the 200m raced in restricted room for a short distance between HARD LEAF, which rolled in, and SUPER SHARP, which rolled out marginally.

PALE FACE (NZ) (J. Doyle) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.



DIAMONDS ARE (S. Fawke) - slow to begin.

NOYERS (NZ) (A. Jordsjo) - laid in, in the straight.

SUPER SHARP (T. Johnstone) - near the 1250m brushed with ONEMORE MARSHALL. Rider explained that the gelding raced well in the early and middle stages of the event; however, when asked for an effort did not respond to her riding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ONEMORE MARSHALL (K. Crowther) - near the 1250m brushed with the hindquarters of SUPER SHARP resulting in the rider becoming unbalanced. Hung in, in the straight.

HARD LEAF (M. Wolanin) - jumped away awkwardly. Rider reported that the gelding raced greenly throughout the event.

RACE 7: YUMBAH MUSSEL HOLDINGS BENCHMARK 66 HANDICAP - 1750 Metres

The start of this event was rescheduled to begin at 5.20pm.

I NEED A DRINK (A. Lai) - on jumping away was tightened onto JAMROCK by AL RANCHERO, which shifted out. Held up for clear running from near the 400m until near the 200m.

SEEKING GLORY (J. Potter) - slow to begin.

DJANGO EXPRESS (S. Fawke) - shortly after jumping away was inconvenienced when racing in restricted room between THE ART OF FLYING and SUPER VALENTINE. Near the 300m shifted out when insufficiently clear onto JAMROCK, which had to be checked when tightened onto THE ART OF FLYING. Rider was found guilty of a charge of careless riding under AR131(a) and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commenced directly following his current suspension on Saturday, 16 November 2024 and to conclude midnight Wednesday, 27 November 2024, a period of five meetings.

JAMROCK (K. Crowther) - near the 300m rider had to check her mount when tightened onto THE ART OF FLYING by DJANGO EXPRESS, which shifted out when insufficiently clear. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SHINSEKI (A. Livesey) - laid in, in the straight.

HOUSE SPOUSE (NZ) (D. Caboche) - slow to begin.

AL RANCHERO (S. Metcalfe) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto I NEED A DRINK.

OLI ALPINE (M. Wolanin) - dipped near the 900m. Rider reported that the gelding raced greenly throughout the event.

RACE 8: EYRE CAR CENTRE BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres

The start of this event was rescheduled to begin at 5.49pm.

EVENING BRIDE (T. Johnstone) - laid out in the straight.

IRISH MIST (S. Fawke) - near the 200m bumped with HARLEEN.

TYDEUS (F. Atkinson) - jumped away awkwardly. Laid in, in the straight.

HARLEEN (A. Lai) - near the 200m bumped with IRISH MIST.

KINGSON (A. Livesey) - laid out rounding the home turn. Inside the 400m was steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of IRISH MIST, which rolled in marginally.
