

A PROUD HISTORY

CELEBRATING OVER 140 YEARS OF RACING

A PROUD CLUB WITH A LONG HISTORY ON THE ISLAND

Racing on KI began shortly after the Island was settled, with initial gatherings on beaches in an informal picnic style. The first official meeting with the SA Jockey Club took place at the Cygnet River race course in March 1883, where 'Lolo' won the 1883 Kangaroo Island Cup, owned by Mr. Richard Chapman and ridden by J. Melville.

Challenges such as world wars and economic downturns occasionally hindered racing on KI, but dedicated volunteers have ensured the club's prosperity. Despite its growth, the club maintains a casual atmosphere, offering a unique country racing experience.

In recent years, the club faced bushfires and Covid regulations, yet still managed to raise substantial funds for the Royal Flying Doctor Service and the KI Mayoral

Bushfire Fund. During the fires, the club's on-course stables sheltered affected horses and provided a base for the Australian Army's firefighting efforts.

The club received accolades, including "The Greatest Achievement by a South Australian Racing Club" in 2019/2020 and "Event of the Year" by the Kangaroo Island Council in 2020/2021. Committee member Kerry Brinkley was awarded Volunteer of the year at Racing SA Awards in 2021 for his work in building 40 new overnight stables

With the Daw family's support, the club established the **Arthur Daw Memorial Trainers Challenge** worth \$10,000, and with the support of the Turner family the Ralph Turner \$3,000 Memorial Jockeys Challenge the **Ralph Turner Memorial Jockeys Challenge**, valued at \$3,000, increasing total prize money to over \$354,000.

Today, the club hosts three meetings annually, including the January Non-Tab meeting, a prelude to the two-day TAB Cup Carnival broadcast nationwide.



LOCAL FAMILIES SUPPORTING OUR CLUB

ARTHUR DAW MEMORIAL TRAINERS CHALLENGE

Born and raised on Kangaroo Island, Arthur moved to Adelaide at twelve for schooling and later served five years in the Navy before earning a master's degree in Accountancy. Despite city life, he often returned home, where his parents lived on Dauncey Street.

A loyal supporter of the Kangaroo Island races for over forty years, Arthur never owned a horse but loved the carnival atmosphere and catching up with friends. He rarely missed an event, attending owners' nights, calcuttas and street parties — absent only once, in 2017 due to illness, before his passing in 2018.

His warmth, humour and enduring enthusiasm made him a much-loved presence at every race meet.



RALPH TURNER MEMORIAL JOCKEYS CHALLENGE

Ralph's passion for racing began early, training his first horse under his father's license before going on to own and train more than fifty winners, including his favourite, Mollyander.

A long-time committee member and former chairman, Ralph helped modernise the club — overseeing mobile starting gates, reinstating the lead-up meeting, and building racecourse facilities himself. His hands-on work and family's fundraising rodeos at Emu Ridge reflected his commitment to the sport and community that he loved.

Ralph's legacy continues through the many improvements he inspired and the friendships he forged along the way.

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RACING SA'S THOROUGH CARE PROGRAM

SETTING A NEW BENCHMARK IN EQUINE WELFARE



In modern racing, welfare isn't a side program — it's the licence to operate. And in South Australia, Racing SA's dedicated welfare division, Thorough Care SA, is proving that genuine care, innovation and investment can transform lives across the industry. With 1% of prize money committed directly to welfare initiatives, Thorough Care SA supports thoroughbreds before, during and after their racing careers.

"To attract new participants and maintain the faith of the public, we need welfare systems that are world-class — and we're proud to say that's what we've built," says Racing SA's Industry Operations and Welfare Manager, John Cornell. Having worked with David Hayes at Lindsay Park and later as stable foreman for McEvoy Mitchell Racing, John brought a wealth of experience when he helped establish the welfare department in 2020.

Since then, Thorough Care SA's impact has been significant: over 1,300 Thorough Care Packs delivered to new off-the-track owners, three horse ambulances purchased, drought-relief funding for 526 horses, and partnerships with organisations such as the RSPCA, Windamere Horse Haven and Riding for the Disabled. One standout initiative is the Thorough Care Pack Program, which equips new owners with feed, care products and training guidance.

Alongside John, Equine Welfare Coordinator Keely Rayson plays a key role. Keely believes racing is "on the front foot when it comes to welfare compliance and integrity," setting high standards across all equestrian disciplines. Thorough Care SA also proudly sponsors thoroughbred events statewide, from Pony Club to the Adelaide Equestrian Festival — all with one goal: making the off-the-track thoroughbred the rider's first choice.

"Horses give us so much," says Keely. "We owe it to them to give back — every step of the way."

Each year, the Kangaroo Island Racing Carnival is uplifted by the remarkable commitment of volunteer groups whose support reaches well beyond race day - including the Lions Clubs of Kangaroo Island, the Kangaroo Island Cancer Support Group, Supporting Cambodia, The Kangaroo Island Hunt Club, Parndana Sports Club and Wisanger Sports Club.

Lions Clubs of Kangaroo Island

With two active clubs - Kangaroo Island Lions Inc. and Parndana Lions Club - Lions members return again in 2026 to help bring the Carnival to life. Funds raised through events like this support essential community projects including the Royal Flying Doctor Service, Lions Skin Cancer Trailer visits, and the Lions Eye Health Project. Their Op Shops, Lions Mart and regular working bees continue to make a lasting difference across the Island. New volunteers are always welcome: "Where there is a need, there is a Lion."

Kangaroo Island Cancer Support Group

For 20 years, the KICSG has supported Islanders facing cancer, offering understanding, connection and practical help. The group provides \$1,000 in financial support for individuals undergoing treatment, along with information, journals and peer contacts. Fundraising through their shop - filled with home-made jams, sauces, chutneys, baking and crafts - allows them to contribute annually to Cancer Council SA, Angel Flight, Red Kite, RFDS and the KI Health Service. The Racing Club is proud to help their vital work continue.

Supporting Cambodia

Supporting Cambodia, founded on Kangaroo Island in 2009, delivers life-changing aid to families in Phnom Penh and remote provinces. Their two primary schools educate and feed more than 1,000 children daily, and in 2021 they opened a new \$500,000 school funded entirely by supporters. Clean water projects, home construction, medical assistance and emergency food programs form the backbone of their work. Their annual clean-up at the KI Races remains one of their most important fundraisers.

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
