RACE 1 : PORT LINCOLN REAL ESTATE / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1210 metres

CARBON STORM (T. Pannell) – slow to begin.

GANGSTA HOUR (K. Bishop) – slow to begin.

PATRIOT CODE (A. Doyle) – raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RIPABOY (G. Willoughby) – slow to begin.

THAT COOL TIGER (D. Caboche) – laid out rounding the home turn and shifted in when placed under pressure over the concluding stages.

SUMITEE (C. Jones) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed abrasions to the off hind pastern.

COMPLIMENT (Z. Spain) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after making contact with the mounting yard gates en route to the barrier and was passed fit to race.

RACE 2 : LIBERTY RURAL & LOGICOIL PORT LINCOLN BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP
- 1750 metres

HARD AT IT (L. Stojakovic) – in the vicinity of the 400 metres L. Stojakovic's saddle slipped backwards, which resulted in her becoming unbalanced and losing the use of her left iron and when approaching the 100 metres, the rider's right foot slipped from her iron placing her at a disadvantage over the concluding stages. On pulling up L. Stojakovic was dislodged from her mount. Rider was examined by the First Care Medical Personnel and was stood down from her remaining engagements. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3 : TOWN & RURAL FENCING / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP
- 1000 metres

MR ROADSTAR (T. Pannell) - in the vicinity of the 800 metres was crowded in onto ON DUTY when PUNTER'S LASS shifted in when insufficiently clear. Rider reminded of her obligation to be sufficiently clear when shifting ground in future.

RACE 3 : TOWN & RURAL FENCING / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP
- 1000 metres (Cont'd)

NIPPY LIPPY (G. Willoughby) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ON DUTY (K. Bishop) – crowded in the vicinity of the 800 metres.

GRAND MARTINI (Z. Spain) - jumped away awkwardly making contact with the inside partition of its barrier and as a result was slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4 : PORT LINCOLN CARPETS & FLOORING DIRECT BENCHMARK 64 - 1390 metres

ROOBOY (C. Jones) – in the vicinity of the 400 metres had to be steadied when momentarily crowded by VALIK, which shifted in marginally. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SANDHILL JET (W. Kerford) – stood flat-footed as the start was affected and was slow to begin.

WILLY THE RABBIT (M. Poon) – slow to begin. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR137A(4)(c) in relation to using his whip out of contention.

RACE 5 : SPORTSCENE PORT LINCOLN BENCHMARK 64 - 1390 metres

PRIMITIVE MAN (A. Doyle) – hung in when placed under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Rider was severely reprimanded to a charge of Careless Riding under AR137(a) for shifting ground when insufficiently clear.

JESTWIN (Z. Spain) – in the vicinity of the 150 metres had to steady his mount to avoid the heels of PRIMITIVE MAN, which shifted in when insufficiently clear.

MORCHOWINE MISS (T. O' Donnell) – slow to begin. Over-raced in the middle stages of the event.

ARJAE (K. Bishop) – laid out rounding the home turn.

RACE 6 : KEMP REAL ESTATE BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1210 metres

MOON DEVIL (A. Doyle) – raced wide without cover throughout the event.

DIRE WARNING (E. Boyd) – slow to begin.

MAGICAL TYCOON (K. Bishop) – held up for clear running from the entrance to the straight until the vicinity of the 100 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7 : AVIS PORT LINCOLN RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

HEZAFRAAR (G. Willoughby) – began awkwardly and shifted out abruptly crowding RIPASON. Riders left foot slipped out of her iron, placing her at a disadvantage in the early stages and was unable to gain the use of her iron until in the vicinity of the 900 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MAGICAL MUSICIAN (T. Pannell) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SNIP IN TIME (S. Cahill) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination at the barriers which revealed the mare to be lame in near foreleg. Late scratching on veterinary advice at 7.03 pm. Veterinary Certificate of Fitness required prior to trial or race.

SUTANOC (Z. Spain) – slow to begin.

BAZILLION (A. Doyle) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer advised the mare would be spelled.

RIPASON (M. Poon) – crowded at the start.

RACE 8 : IAN BROWN'S BUCKS SHOW BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1210 metres

NIPEX (K. Kah) – in the vicinity of the 300 meters bumped HEZA HUSSLER becoming unbalanced and shifted in abruptly.

HEZA HUSSLER (T. Pannell) – bumped in the vicinity of the 300 metres.

ARTFUL MONTY (M. Poon) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PANIOLO (E. Boyd) – in the vicinity of the 1000 metres raced in restricted room to the inside of LOS RIOS.

BRAWNY HUNTER (G. Willoughby) – rider was reprimanded under AR137(a) for dropping her whip in the vicinity of the 150 metres.

FACE LEICA STAR (D. Caboche) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as the mare sustained minor abrasions to the near foreleg en route to the course and was ruled fit to race.
