Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse
by the Gawler & Barossa Jockey Club on Wednesday, 20 January 2016

RACE 1 : SCHWEPPE PEPSI MAX / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE – 1500 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

LADY CHORA (T. O' Donnell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the near foreleg. First aid administered. Veterinary Certificate of Fitness required prior to trial or race.

PINK LUCY (K. Bishop) – lost its near hind plate en route to the barrier and required Farrier attention. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to race. Jumped away awkwardly and was slow into stride.

RED JIAN – Late scratching on veterinary advice at 9.30 am.

ALSHIMA (S. Cahill) – trainer advised the rider would attempt to ride the filly more forward if possible. Taken wider in the vicinity of the 400 metres when SANIMA STAR shifted out and away from DIVINE WEAVER, which had improved to its inside.

GRAND MARTINI (Z. Spain) – hung out throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be lame in the near hind leg. Veterinary Certificate of Fitness required prior to trial or race.

SANIMA STAR (J. Toeroek) – rider reported the filly raced greenly throughout the event.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow S. Cahill (ALSHIMA) placed third to view the official vision in the straight.

RACE 2 : LIFE MEMBERS / SABOIS DISTANCE MAIDEN PLATE - 1700 metres

DYFIELD (D. Tourneur) – had difficulty obtaining clear ground from inside the 600 metres until near the 400 metres when it became awkwardly placed on the heels of SCENTED ROSE for a short distance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GANGSTA HOUR (K. Bishop) – raced wide without cover throughout the event.

MOOSEM (J. Cartwright) – laid in under pressure in the straight.

WHYCLASS (J. Maund) – slow to begin.

GETTING LEGGIE (S. Cahill) – rider reported the gelding was inclined to lay out throughout the event.

CHIAZZA – Late scratching on veterinary advice at 7.44 am.

JEST IN VAIN (J. Toeroek) - jumped away awkwardly. Rider reported he became concerned with the mare's action in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2 : LIFE MEMBERS / SABOIS DISTANCE MAIDEN PLATE - 1700 metres (Cont'd)

SCENTED ROSE (C. Lindop) – forced to race in restricted room approaching the finish when STALKER shifted in away from MOOSEM, which was inclined to lay in.

STALKER (P. Gatt) - jumped away awkwardly. Lost its off hind plate during the event.

RACE 3 : ADELAIDE GALVANISING INDUSTRIES / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE – 1100 metres

BEL SORBET (C. Lindop) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow into stride.

TRUST THE FAITH (D. Caboche) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be showing signs of heat stress. First aid administered.

WINGARD'S MARK (J. Cartwright) – saddle shifted back on jumping away placing the rider at a disadvantage for the remainder of the event. As a consequence was not free in its action in the early stages of the event while the rider was repositioning the saddle. Held up from the vicinity of the 400 metres until near the 200 metres.

CORONA SHAW (Z. Spain) – rider became concerned with the mare's action in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4 : GOLDIN FARMS – AKEED MOFEED CLASS 2 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately fourteen minutes.

BRIMARVI CUGAT (E. Finnegan) - was slow to begin.

VALARCH (K. Bishop) – dislodged rider en route to the barriers. Rider examined by the First Care Medical Personnel and ruled unfit to fulfil her remaining engagements. K. Bishop sustained an injury to her lower left leg and was taken to hospital for further examination. VALARCH was withdrawn by Stewards at 2.41 pm.

FAN THE BREEZE (J. Maund) – lost its near hind plate during the event.

SERBIAN CROWN (C. Lindop) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination at the barriers which revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. SERBIAN CROWN was a late scratching on veterinary advice at 2.53 pm.

LOUISIANA (G. Willoughby) – lost its near fore plate en route to the barrier and required Farrier attention. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$200.

RACE 5 : HAPPY 70TH BIRTHDAY BARRY LAMP RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1700 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately seven minutes due to the delay of the previous event.

GUILTY AS CHARGED (J. Toeroek) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ORBITAL MOTION (J. Frew) – held up from the 600 metres until approaching the 400 metres when awkwardly placed between the heels of MAGGIE'S CALL and GUILTY AS CHARGED.

JACK OF CLUBS (M. Poon) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto MOON BRICKS.

BENEFIT (E. Finnegan) – lost its position on jumping away when contacted by MAGGIE'S CALL, which had been taken in by JACK OF CLUBS. Rider concerned with the gelding's action in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer reported the gelding would now be spelled.

RACE 5 : HAPPY 70TH BIRTHDAY BARRY LAMP RATING 0-58 HANDICAP - 1700 metres
(Cont'd)

ONWARD (J. Bowditch) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

SOLID BULLET (P. Gatt) – slow to begin.

RACE 6 : SPORTSBET – CASH CARD BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

WAR THUNDER (P. Gatt) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

ROCK OUT (D. Tourneur) – raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RUG RAT (D. Caboche) – raced keenly in the early stages. Rider reported, in his opinion, the gelding got its tongue over the bit. A post-race veterinary examination revealed low grade tying up in the hind quarters.

SOCIAL LANE (J. Cartwright) – held up from the vicinity of the 400 metres until the entrance to the straight when the gelding became disappointed attempting a run between RUG RAT, which shifted out at the same time as GWYDIR laid in, resulting in SOCIAL LANE having to ease to the outside of SHELBY APPLES to obtain clear ground.

RACE 7 : COOPERS PALE ALE BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 2100 metres

NEW EMPIRE (W. Kerford) – hampered on jumping away.

JARRVIS (J. Potter) – poor performance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MOTACADE (T. O' Donnell) – shifted out on jumping away contacting NEW EMPIRE.

FREECLOUD (Z. Spain) – held up in the vicinity of the 500 metres when awkwardly placed inside the heels of NEW EMPIRE.

RACE 8 : CRABB SHELLGRIT BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP – 1500 metres

UMALUKA (J. Frew) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DUBAI (NZ) (E. Boyd) - rider reported the gelding did not stretch out in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed DUBAI (NZ) to be lame in the off foreleg. Veterinary Certificate of Fitness required prior to trial or race.

SEMAPHORE (J. Bowditch) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

IMPRESSIVE YIELD (J. Kah) – laid in throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SPIRITED MATCH (Z. Spain) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.
