Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Parks Racecourse

RACE 1 : WHERE'S LEWY GRANTHAM HANDICAP - 2400 metres

TUNES (J. Kah) – Stewards questioned Trainer Mr. G. Young in relation to the instructions he would provide jockey J. Kah today. Mr. Young advised his instructions would be to attempt to settle on pace as the gelding had previously when racing in South Australia. Shifted in, in the vicinity of the 2000m, when insufficiently clear of SPACE, which was forced to take hold and lost its position. J. Kah was found guilty of a charge of Careless Riding under AR137(a) in that she shifted ground when insufficiently clear and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight on Saturday, 7 May and to conclude at midnight on Friday, 13 May 2016; a period of four (4) meetings.

BONDEIGER (D. Moor) – jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin. D. Moor pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100m and was fined \$200.

STIMULATTE (J. Bowditch) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RICH RIVER (H. Coffey) – had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the vicinity of the 400m until near the 200m.

SPACE (D. Tourneur) – forced to take hold and lost its position in the vicinity of the 2000m when TUNES shifted in.

RACE 2 : UBET ADELAIDE'S FESTIVAL OF RACING HANDICAP - 1950 metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately three minutes.

HAVE PLENTY (J. Bowditch) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

STREAMING BY (GB) (P. Gatt) – slow to begin.

ZAYAK (H. Coffey) – rider reported the gelding raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

ALMAHSTIQUE (M. Neilson) – fractious and kicked out in its barrier stall after being loaded. A pre-race veterinary examination reported a laceration to the near hind stifle and ruled the gelding unfit to race. First Aid was administered. Acting on that advice, Stewards withdrew ALMAHSTIQUE at 12.58 pm. Trainer Mr. T. McEvoy was advised the gelding would be required to perform satisfactorily in either an Official Barrier Trial or Approval to Race Jump Out prior to accepting for a future trial or race.

RACE 2 : UBET ADELAIDE'S FESTIVAL OF RACING HANDICAP - 1950 metres (Cont'd)

ROOBOY (Z. Spain) – contacted a fence en route to the start. On arrival at the barriers was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon who ruled the gelding fit to race. Z. Spain pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100m and was fined \$300.

JOYFUL JOURNEY (J. Holder) – rider explained he attempted to improve into the race in the vicinity of the 600m, however, due to the positioning of STREAMING BY (GB), he was unable to do so, became held up momentarily and had difficulty obtaining clear ground for the remainder of the race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

THAT'S A SLAB (C. Lindop) – a pre-race veterinary examination of THAT'S A SLAB, which was in the adjoining stall to ALMAHSTIQUE, ruled the gelding fit to race.

FREEDOMS (D. Tourneur) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FIELDLO (T. Pannell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3 : SERAFINO WINES HANDICAP - 1000 metres

JENNYFROMTHEBLOCK (Z. Spain) – shifted in slightly in the vicinity of the 700m towards DEBEERSONUS.

STRATUMSPHERE (D. Caboche) – had to be steadied in the vicinity of the 700m to avoid the heels of AFRICAN PULSE.

DEIHEROS (J. Bowditch) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

AFRICAN PULSE (C. Jones) – forced to check off the heels of LUCKY SYMBOL, which was taken in, in the vicinity of the 700m. Held up from the vicinity of the 400m, had difficulty obtaining clear ground in the straight and was untested to the line.

LUCKY SYMBOL (D. Tourneur) – forced to check off the heels of DEBEERSONUS in the vicinity of the 700m and was taken in onto AFRICAN PULSE. Held up from the vicinity of the 400m until approaching the 200m.

DEBEERSONUS (R. Hurdle) – shifted in and away from JENNYFROMTHEBLOCK approaching the 700m into the running line of LUCKY SYMBOL. Rider reported the gelding laid in under pressure in the straight. Co-Trainer Mr. T. Dansie was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ALABAMA MISSILE (J. Holder) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BRAVE JOURNEY (A. Doyle) – jumped away awkwardly. Had to be steadied to avoid the heels of AFRICAN PULSE in the vicinity of the 700m

RACE 4 : UBET SA SIRE'S PRODUCE STAKES - 1400 metres

MOVADA (J. Toeroek) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto FLAMES OF LIFE. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the race.

FLAMES OF LIFE (J. Kah) – contacted on jumping away.

SWEET VARDEN (P. Gatt) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

OUTBACK RAIN (D. Moor) – momentarily inconvenienced at the entrance to the straight when MIDTOWN rolled in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4 : UBET SA SIRE'S PRODUCE STAKES - 1400 metres (Cont'd)

WITH A BIT OF DASH (T. Pannell) – had difficulty obtaining clear ground in the straight and in the vicinity of the 100m shifted out onto BAROQUE (NZ), which was inconvenienced when tightened onto KARMIDALA.

TOYSHOP (M. Neilson) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto WITH A BIT OF DASH. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

BAROQUE (NZ) (J. Holder) – inconvenienced near the 100m.

MIDTOWN (D. Smith) – hampered on jumping away. Rolled in at the entrance to the straight.

RACE 5 : MAC DRINK DRIVING? GROW UP HANDICAP - 1300 metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately seven minutes

COUNTER SPIN (C. Lindop) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MASTER SOMMELIER (M. Neilson) – required Farrier attention in the mounting enclosure when it lost its near fore plate. Required Farrier attention on arrival at the barriers when it lost the near fore plate en route to the start. A pre-race veterinary examination ruled the gelding fit to race. Lost its off hind plate during the event.

WHAT'S IN A NAME (R. Hurdle) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, contacting VENTIC.

VENTIC (Z. Spain) – contacted on jumping away. Rider reported he was concerned with the gelding's action in front. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer Mr. B. Cozamanis was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

AMPLE ON OFFA (E. Finnegan) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FASTCAR (J. Holder) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

RACE 6 : H C NITSCHKE STAKES - 1400 metres

CATCH A FIRE (M. Neilson) – inconvenienced on jumping away. Inconvenienced near the 900m when tightened onto RAGEESE.

LITTLE BITA SPUNK (J. Payne) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto LUCHADOR.

DANE THUNDER (H. Coffey) – shifted out on jumping away onto CATCH A FIRE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer Mr. S. Bottomley was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting for a future trial or race.

ECLAIR ATTACK (D. Tourneur) – shifted in near the 1100m onto COBBER, which had to be steadied. D. Tourneur was issued with a severe reprimand.

BATTLE BREWING (C. Lindop) – taken out on jumping away onto BEAUTIFUL FLYER.

LUCHADOR (D. Moor) – inconvenienced on jumping away when tightened by BATTLE BREWING. Shifted out slightly at the entrance to the straight onto COBBER. D. Moor was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground in future. Obligated to alter course to the inside of DANE THUNDER, which shifted out, approaching the 200m.

COBBER (T. Pannell) – had to be steadied in the vicinity of the 1100m when ECLAIR ATTACK shifted in. Made the turn in the vicinity of the 900m awkwardly and shifted out onto CATCH A FIRE. At the entrance to the straight, improved of its own accord into a run between CATCH A FIRE and LUCHADOR and had to be steadied. Shortly after LUCHADOR shifted out slightly, resulting in COBBER becoming awkwardly placed between these two runners' heels for a number of strides.

RACE 6 : H C NITSCHKE STAKES - 1400 metres (Cont'd)

BEAUTIFUL FLYER (J. Bowditch) – hampered on jumping away. Held up from the vicinity of the 500m until near the 200m.

RACE 7 : HOLDFAST INSURANCE CITY OF ADELAIDE HANDICAP - 1400 metres

RIZIZ (P. Gatt) – acting on confirmed telephone advice from Trainer Mr. K. Sweeney that the gelding had a respiratory infection and was unfit to race, Stewards withdrew RIZIZ at 8.56 am.

ALCOHOL (J. Toeroek) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed lower than expected heart rate.

SYSMO (FR) (M. Neilson) – slow to begin.

MR BACKCHAT (C. Lindop) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Held up from the 500m for the remainder of the race and was untested to the line.

CASINO WIZARD (J. Holder) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

OCTOBER DATE (J. Bowditch) – slow to begin.

QADIR (D. Moor) – slow to begin.

KISS ME KETUT (NZ) (J. Payne) – raced wide without cover throughout the event.

SPIRITOF ENDEAVOUR (USA) (T. Pannell) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 8 : CHAIRMAN'S STAKES - 2020 metres (Run on Morphettville Track)

ROYAL RUMBLE (C. Lindop) – contacted on jumping away. In the vicinity of the 1900m was forced to take hold and lost its position when tightened between MANHATTAN BOSS and HOWARD BE THY NAME, which had been taken in by WAR LEGEND (NZ). Contacted in the vicinity of the 500m.

HOWARD BE THY NAME (B. Rawiller) – became awkward in the vicinity of the 1900m for a number of strides when racing to the inside of WAR LEGEND (NZ), which had been taken in, and COLONEL CUSTER (NZ), which made the turn awkwardly and shifted out.

MAIL IT IN (J. Holder) – jumped away awkwardly. Shortly after the start taken out by DUXEVA onto CONCUBINE, losing its position. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 500m improved of its own accord into restricted room between the heels of DROPPED and ROYAL RUMBLE, making heavy contact with ROYAL RUMBLE and became awkwardly placed between these runners' heels for a number of strides. Laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PATCH ADAMS (P. Gatt) – rider advised Stewards he has been given the option to push forward from the wide barrier if circumstances permit today.

WAR LEGEND (NZ) (J. Childs) – in the vicinity of the 1900m was bumped by READY RIGHT NOW and taken in onto HOWARD BE THY NAME.

COLONEL CUSTER (NZ) (D. Tourneur) – made the turn near the 1900m awkwardly and shifted out onto HOWARD BE THY NAME.

READY RIGHT NOW (T. Pannell) – rolled in near the 1900 metres making heavy contact with WAR LEGEND (NZ). A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DROPPED (C. Jones) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out, contacting ROYAL RUMBLE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CHENERS (J. Kah) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

CONCUBINE (J. Toeroek) – lost its position shortly after the start when contacted by MAIL IT IN.

RACE 8 : CHAIRMAN'S STAKES - 2020 metres (Run on Morphettville Track) (Cont'd)

Correct Weight for this event was delayed to allow C. Lindop (ROYAL RUMBLE) placed second, together with Co-Trainer Mr. L. Macdonald and part-owners Mr. D. Rasheed and Mr. H. Perks, to view the official footage in the vicinity of the 1900m.
