STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Kingscote Racecourse
by Kangaroo Island Racing Club on Saturday, 28 January 2017

TRACK: Good 4 (*Upgraded to a Good 3 at 2.25 pm*)

WEATHER: Fine

Rail: True

RACE 1: INGRAM'S HOME HARDWARE / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE -1008 metres

VANDALAY (J. Huxtable) – which had not raced in twelve months, underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start.

BONSTAR EXPRESS (L. Stojakovic) – raced wide throughout the event. Rider reported that the mare was inclined to lay in throughout the event.

ZAZIPZOOM (Jemma Frew) – which was reluctant to proceed to the start and contacted the outside perimeter fence on a number of occasions underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and passed fit to start. Trainer, Mr J. Frew, was advised that a warning had been placed on the mare in regards to its pre-race manners.

LACE THE LADY (J. Mamat) – inclined to lay in over the concluding stages of the event.

VERY ROUGH SEAS (W. Kerford) – began awkwardly and as a result was slow into stride.

RACE 2: KILDEA PHARMACY BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1008 metres

LITTLE JAY JAY (J. Mamat) – began awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin. In the vicinity of the 900 metres was obliged to be steadied when racing in restricted room between WHITE LINE FEVER to its inside and DUST 'N' DIAMONDS to its outside. Approaching the 800 metres raced in restricted room between FLYNN'S FLYER, which was obliged to be steadied, and DUST 'N' DIAMONDS to its outside. Inclined to lay out in the straight.

KANGAROO JACK (J. Maund) – inclined to lay in, in the straight.

PAZZIMY (J. Huxtable) – rider reported the gelding was inclined to lay in throughout the event.

FLYNN'S FLYER (T. Zanker) – was obliged to be steadied in the vicinity of the 800 metres after improving onto the heels of NORTH BEACH.

RACE 3: PARNDANA HOTEL BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1360 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately eight minutes.

COMMANDING DIVA (W. Kerford) – at the entrance to the straight rolled out and contacted WARRASIDE EDDY.

WARRASIDE EDDY (D. Tootell) – slow to begin. Contacted at the entrance to the straight and taken wider.

CALIBRIUM (V. Wong) – laid out in the straight.

TOUGH POACHER (J. Huxtable) – rider reported the gelding was inclined to lay out in the early stages of the event.

ALPHA CASH (K. Cross) – which had not raced in twelve months, underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start.

RACE 4: DUDLEY WINES BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP - 1360 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately four minutes.

FINNISS MOMENT (J. Huxtable) – inconvenienced and taken wider in the vicinity of the 1000 metres as EMMOKI'S STAR shifted out.

JESTWIN (K. Cross) – which raced on Wednesday, 25 January 2017, underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start. Over-raced in the early stages of the event.

CALYPSO CHOICE (V. Wong) – shifted out in the vicinity of the 400 metres across the running of CHAMBRAY. Rider severely reprimanded and advised only to shift ground when entitled to do so.

EMMOOKI'S STAR (D. Tootell) – lost its near fore plate and required farrier attention. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start. Slow to begin. In the vicinity of the 1000 metres was obliged to be steadied after improving onto the heels of JESTWIN and shortly thereafter shifted out inconveniencing FINNISS MOMENT.

CHAMBRAY (T. Zanker) – in the vicinity of the 400 metres and was obliged to be steadied to avoid the heels of CALYPSO CHOICE, which shifted out.

RACE 5: SEALINK BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1750 metres

CRYSTAL ICON (J. Huxtable) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$200. In determining penalty Stewards had regard for J. Huxtable's record and his use of the whip over the final 100 metres of the event. Rider also pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(4)(b) in that he used his whip in an action which raised his arm above shoulder height and was fined \$100.

FINAL TABLE (K. Cross) – which had not raced in five months, underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start.

SEPTEMBER STORM (Jemma Frew) – performed below expectations. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: CENTURY 21 BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1215 metres

SHADE OF GREEN (J. Huxtable) – rider reported the mare raced keenly throughout.

MISS INSOMNIA (J. Maund) – rider reported the mare did not feel comfortable in its action during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HURRICANE SONNY (Jemma Frew) – laid out in the straight.
