Report on Race Meeting held at Kingscote Racecourse
by Kangaroo Island Racing Club on Thursday, 15 February 2018

RACE 1: BUDGET KANGAROO ISLAND / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE -1008 metres

RALPH (D. Caboche) – shortly after the start rolled out and bumped VABANQUE. Rider reported that the gelding failed to respond to his riding in the early stages of the event and also when asked for an effort from in the vicinity of the 500 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MASKED SECRET (Jemma Frew) – hung in throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MISS WAZZA (J. Maund) – shortly after the start rolled in onto VABANQUE. Raced greenly in the straight.

OUR LILYJAZ (A. Lindsay) – became awkward in its action in the vicinity of the 500 metres for no apparent reason.

VABANQUE (J. Toeroek) – inconvenienced shortly after the start when tightened between RALPH, which rolled out, and MISS WAZZA, which rolled in.

RACE 2: DUDLEY WINES BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1880 metres

O'FENNESSY (S. Price) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and was passed fit to start.

SVETLANA'S ARROW (A. Lindsay) – held up for clear running from in the vicinity of the 500 metres until the entrance to the straight. In the vicinity of the 100 metres rider accidentally dropped her off side rein for a number of strides before regathering it.

CRYSTAL ICON (J. Maund) – made the turn out of the straight on the first occasion awkwardly and from thereafter raced wide and was inclined to race keenly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed xx

TOMMY GUN (K. Crowther) – shortly after the finish clipped the heels of PARENTIVE, which rolled in marginally.

RACE 3: A G WILLSON EARTHMOVERS BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1750 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute.

RACE 3: A G WILLSON EARTHMOVERS BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1750 metres (Cont'd)

JESTWIN (J. Potter) – held up for clear running from inside the 600 metres until inside the 400 metres when racing between KAZOOM (NZ) and RED MENACE. Rider explained that he was comfortable with the position he had obtained and that the gelding travelled well during the event although it was inclined to lay in for the majority of the race. He further stated that when asked to improve in the vicinity of the 600 metres JESTWIN did not respond to his riding as he had expected and as a consequence, became held up until the 400 metres. He further stated when he presented the gelding at the entrance to the straight JESTWIN did not respond to his riding in the manner he had anticipated and was dour in the finish. Stewards noted J. Potter's explanation. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MOORE ALPHA (S. Fawke) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RED MENACE (R. Clark) – tongue-tie was replaced on arrival at the barriers. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(i) in that she used her whip in consecutive strides prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. Rider also pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$300.

RACE 4: ATKINS FREIGHT SERVICE BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1008 metres

OOSTERMAN (K. Crowther) – in the vicinity of the 900 metres was obliged to take hold and lost its position when tightened onto ALPHABETIC as SOU SOUNI PRINCESS, which was inclined to lay in, was inconvenienced when taken in by ANAMNESIS.

ANAMNESIS (A. Lindsay) – in the vicinity of the 900 metres shifted in onto SOU SOUNI PRINCESS, which was laying in and was inconvenienced when tightened onto OOSTERMAN, which was obliged to take hold and lost its position when tightened onto ALPHABETIC, which also was obliged to take hold and lost its position. Rider severely reprimanded and advised that she is required to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

ALPHABETIC (K. Bishop) – in the vicinity of the 900 metres was obliged to take hold and lost its position when awkwardly placed on the heels of MAPPINGA QUEEN as OOSTERMAN was also obliged to take hold and lost its position when SOU SOUNI PRINCESS, which was inclined to lay in, was inconvenienced as ANAMNESIS shifted in.

LITTLE JAY JAY (J. Potter) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SOU SOUNI PRINCESS (J. Toeroek) – in the vicinity of the 900 metres was inclined to lay in and was inconvenienced when taken in by ANAMNESIS and tightened onto OOSTERMAN, which was obliged to take hold and lost its position when tightened onto ALPHABETIC, which was also obliged to take hold and lost its position.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow K. Crowther (OOSTERMAN) placed second, and trainer, Mr J. Dodgson, to view the Official Vision in the vicinity of the 900 metres. After doing so K. Crowther lodged an objection against ANAMNESIS (A. Lindsay) being declared the winner, alleging interference in the vicinity of the 900 metres. After considering the evidence, on viewing the official footage and acting on their own observations, Stewards *dismissed* the objection.

RACE 5: MERCURE LODGE BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP – 1215 metres

ONEWOOD (M. Henderson) – slow to begin.

CHIC SALE (S. Fawke) – bucked shortly after the start losing considerable ground. Trainer, Mr J. Dodgson, was advised that the gelding was required to complete an Official Barrier Trial in a race day saddle prior to accepting for a future race.

FLIP DE GLOIRE (J. Toeroek) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LADY BARRON (J. Potter) – slow to begin.

RACE 6: KANGAROO ISLAND PLANTATION TIMBERS BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1360 metres

JUDELLY (J. Toeroek) – trainer, Mr W. Clarken, was fined \$100 under AR59A for failing to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card. JUDELLY was permitted to start as it was able to be identified from records held by the Stewards. Trainer was also advised the gelding is unable to start until the TIC is presented prior to racing. Rider reported that in his opinion the gelding was disappointing in today's event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding was lame in the near hind leg. Trainer Mr W. Clarken was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

MANHATTAN PRINCE (R. Clark) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ROD'S OPINION (Jemma Frew) – trainer, Mr J. Frew, was reprimanded under AR59A for failing to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card. ROD'S OPINION was permitted to start as it was able to be identified from records held by the Stewards. Jumped away very awkwardly and as a result Jemma Frew became unbalanced for a number of strides. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

AMBER ALERT (J. Maund) – laid in under pressure in the straight.
