RACE 1: K & K COOLING BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1390 metres

I AM DEXTER (R. Hurdle) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KID ME (A. Chan) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BAKER'S DOZEN (R. Clark) – on jumping away knuckled severely and became unbalanced.

RACE 2: MAGIC MILLIONS / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1210 metres

HARDAZ (K. Crowther) – in the vicinity of the 100 metres rolled out and inconvenienced WHITWAY.

WHITWAY (J. Potter) – inconvenienced shortly after the start when tightened between HARDAZ and FLOP, which both rolled. Raced wide without cover throughout the event. In the vicinity of the 100 metres was inconvenienced when HARDAZ rolled out.

HERE DE TRAIN (S. Cahill) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(i) in that he used his whip in consecutive strides and was reprimanded. Rider also pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was fined \$100. In assessing penalty Stewards took into account S. Cahill's circumstances in the event.

KOODA RHYTHM (K. Bishop) – re-saddled on arrival at the barriers. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Held up for clear running from approaching the 400 metres until the entrance to the straight.

SYNERGY (V. Wong) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FLOP (A. Jordsjo) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LI'L EAG (C. Davies) – jumped away very awkwardly and was slow to begin.

RACE 3: FESTIVAL HIRE BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

HEAVENS FLIGHT (B. Paterson) – inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 3: FESTIVAL HIRE BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1000 metres (cont'd)

THE SHOW GOES ON (S. Fawke) – on jumping away was inconvenienced and lost its position when tightened onto STRAGUN as NIPPY LIPPY jumped away awkwardly and shifted out. Inclined to shift about in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer, Mr S. Drewitt, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

KINGSON (A. Lindsay) – hung in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HELMARA (J. Toeroek) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

NIPPY LIPPY (A. Jordsjo) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and inconvenienced THE SHOW GOES ON, which lost its position when tightened on to STRAGUN.

OUTBACK TYCOON (E. Boyd) – rider reported that the gelding made the turn in the vicinity of the 400 metres awkwardly and shifted out. She added that from thereafter OUTBACK TYCOON didn't feel comfortable in its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: RONALD MCDONALD HOUSE ADELAIDE BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1390 metres

ALL KRUPT (A. Lindsay) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near hind leg. Trainer, Mr B. Cozamanis (Jnr) was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

STAGHORN (R. Clark) – on jumping away dipped and shifted out bumping HEZA HUSSLER.

BRAMFIELD (J. Potter) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HEZA HUSSLER (R. Hurdle) – bumped at the start as STAGHORN dipped and shifted out.

RACE 5: WILLIAM BUCK BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP – 1750 metres

ARTFUL MONTY (A. Chan) – required to be re-saddled on arrival at the barriers. Shortly after the start shifted out onto ANOTHER MARTINI, which was obliged to be eased and lost its position. Rider severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care in future. Raced in restricted room for some distance in the vicinity of the 1400 metres when racing between BETTERTHANYOUGHTHINK and LADY CONQUISTADOR. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

LOCKS WELL (T. Pannell) – weakened from approaching the 400 metres. Rider explained the mare travelled well during the event and when asked for an effort in the vicinity of the 500 metres failed to respond to his riding and for this reason he did not ride the mare out in his normal manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BURNRO (R. Clark) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DOWNUNDER PRINCE (D. Tourneur) – near the 800 metres shifted in onto ANOTHER MARTINI, which was obliged to be eased. Rider reprimanded and advised to take greater care in future. In the vicinity of the 700 metres made the turn awkwardly and had to be restrained and shifted out.

ANOTHER MARTINI (K. Crowther) – shortly after the start was obliged to be eased and lost its position as ARTFUL MONTY shifted out. Near the 800 metres was obliged to be eased as DOWNUNDER PRINCE shifted in. In the vicinity of the 300 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of LOCKS WELL and was inconvenienced as that mare weakened.

RACE 6: THOMAS FOODS INTERNATIONAL FLYING HANDICAP - 1210 metres

DEBEERSONUS (A. Lindsay) – hung in throughout the event placing its rider at a disadvantage, particularly when riding her mount out in the straight. Inconvenienced approaching the finish as IRISH MINT rolled out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KILLAWARRA (T. Pannell) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

IRISH MINT (J. Toeroek) – rolled out approaching the finish.

RACE 7: MGA INSURANCE BROKERS PORT LINCOLN CUP - 1960 metres

COPPER COAST RAIDA (J. Potter) – approaching the 600 metres dipped for no apparent reason.

FANTASTIC MAGIC (D. Tourneur) – hung out rounding the home turn. Inside the 400 metres rolled out onto HARD AT IT which was inconvenienced. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LAKE JACKSON (J. Maund) – in the vicinity of the 600 metres had difficulty obtaining clear ground for a short distance.

NEVA DOUBT US (K. Crowther) – laid in under pressure approaching the finish.

HARD AT IT (J. Toeroek) – inconvenienced inside the 400 metres when FANTASTIC MAGIC, which was inclined to hang out, rolled out.

RED MENACE (R. Clark) – weakened from inside the 600 metres. Rider reported the gelding was disappointing in today's event, did not back up from its last start and may have come to the end of its preparation. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8: VICE SECURITY BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1210 metres

GALAXY FALLS (T. Pannell) – brushed with PRINCESS ASTRO shortly after the start.

DE JORVIK (R. Clark) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GOLD BUSKER (A. Jordsjo) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination in the parade ring after being kicked by another runner and was passed fit to start. Bumped with STAY SASSY which jumped away awkwardly and shifted in. Inside the 1000 metres was obliged to be eased when racing keenly as EQUIDANT shifted in. Shortly thereafter was inclined to hang out and shifted out when making the turn. Hung out rounding the home turn.

EQUIDANT (D. Tourneur) – inside the 1000 metres shifted in onto GOLD BUSKER, which was racing keenly and obliged to be eased. As a consequence, OBLIQUE LINE, which was following, was inconvenienced. Rider severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care in future.

MACKIE (J. Toeroek) – hung in from approaching the 400 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ASH ROAD (J. Potter) – held up for clear running from the entrance to the straight until inside the 200 metres when racing between GALAXY FALLS and MR JAZZ MAN.

STAY SASSY (S. Fawke) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped GOLD BUSKER.

PRINCESS ASTRO (K. Bishop) – rolled in shortly after the start and brushed GALAXY FALLS. In the vicinity of the 1100 metres attempted to savage DE JORVIK. Hung in throughout the event.

OBLIQUE LINE (V. Wong) – reared on jumping away and as a result was awkward to begin. Inside the 1000 metres was inconvenienced when GOLD BUSKER eased as EQUIDANT shifted in.

OLD FARM ROAD (NZ) (J. Maund) – obliged to be re-saddled on arrival at the barriers.
