# Report on Race Meeting held at Clare Racecourse by the Clare Valley Racing Club on Sunday, 11 March 2018

### RACE 1: TAMINGA HOTEL / SABOIS FILLIES AND MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

**MINTRICE** (J. Toeroek) – laid out under pressure in the straight.

**AUSTIN RAIDER** (A. Lindsay) – rider reported her mount pulled hard throughout the event.

**CALL ME MAYBE** (D. Caboche) – rider reported his mount was awkward in its actions throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FIBBERS (NZ) (A. Chan) – over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

### RACE 2: AIRMASTER AUSTRALIA / SABOIS DISTANCE MAIDEN PLATE - 1800 metres

SWEET KAISER (E. Finnegan) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

### RACE 3: HILL LIVESTOCK / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three minutes owing to a late scratching.

**ACUMAN** (J. Huxtable) – a late scratching at 2.41 pm on veterinary advice after the gelding became cast in the barriers.

**FEVER** (K. Bishop) – over-raced in the early stages of the event.

**TILLO CENTRE** (A. Lindsay) – severely hampered and was taken wider on the track in the vicinity of the 600 metres placing the gelding at a disadvantage for the remainder of the event as LITTLE PIP SQUEAK hung out severely. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**LITTLE PIP SQUEAK** (P. Gatt) – began awkwardly. In the vicinity of the 600 metres hung out severely taking the turn wide hampering TILLO CENTRE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer Mrs E Hubbard advised the filly would be required to perform to the Stewards satisfaction in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

**VABANQUE** (J. Toeroek) – rider reported his mount felt awkward in its action on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed mild tying up in the hindquarters. First aid was administered.

Following the running of Race 3 rider J. Toeroek was stood down from all his remaining engagements after being examined by the First Care Medical Personnel.

## RACE 4: MAGIC FM 5CS / SABOIS FILLIES AND MARES BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP – 1200 metres

**COMMANDING DIVA** (T. Pannell) – jumped away awkwardly.

**A LITTLE CHUNKY** (Jemma Frew) – began awkwardly, shifted in and contacted ZERO PATIENCE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**SCOTTISH THREAD** (A. Jordsjo) – in the vicinity of the 200 metres shifted out when insufficiently clear and hampered SOU SOUNI PRINCESS. Rider severely reprimanded.

**ZERO PATIENCE** (C. Lindop) – hampered on jumping away.

**SOU SOUNI PRINCESS** (J. Potter) – had to be restrained in the vicinity of the 200 metres after SCOTTISH THREAD shifted out when insufficiently clear.

**YOU REMEMBERED ME** (K. Bishop) – in the vicinity of the 900 metres had to be restrained after improving onto the heels of MINT COLLECTOR. Laid out entering the straight.

### RACE 5: JIM BARRY WINES BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1800 metres

**MULLINGER LANE** (K. Crowther) – approaching the finishing post on the first occasion had to be restrained to avoid the heels of WICKED PROMISE, which shifted in when insufficiently clear. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**CENTURIUS** (J. Huxtable) – in the vicinity of the 600 metres had to be restrained after improving onto the heels of ALDOLPHIN. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near hind leg. Trainer advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

**WICKED PROMISE** (D. Tourneur) – approaching the finishing post on the first occasion shifted in when insufficiently clear of MULLINGER LANE. Rider was found guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR137(a) in that he shifted ground when insufficiently clear and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight on Saturday, 17 March and to conclude at midnight on Saturday, 24 March 2018: a period of four meetings. Laid out rounding the home turn. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SVETLANA'S ARROW (A. Lindsay) - began awkwardly and was slow to begin.

**KIRCHNER** (K. Bishop) – laid in under pressure in the straight.

### RACE 6: ANNABELLE'S ROSE BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

PRETIOSA (A. Chan) – hampered on jumping away.

**BREAKER OF CHAINS** (T. Pannell) – severely hampered on jumping away. Hampered in the vicinity of the 200 metres after SHARK MIRAGE shifted in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed minor lacerations to the near hind leg. First aid was administered.

**VICTOR VICTOR** (P. Gatt) – laid out rounding the home turn and entering the straight.

**BAKSLAP** (S. Fawke) – began awkwardly shifted in taking PRETIOSA in onto SHARK MIRAGE, which was taken in onto BREAKER OF CHAINS, which had its hindquarters turned and was taken in onto CHUCKLES.

**SHARK MIRAGE** (K. Crowther) – hampered on jumping away. Rolled in, in the vicinity of the 200 metres hampering BREAKER OF CHAINS. Rider was reprimanded. A post-race veterinary examination revealed minor lacerations to upper eyelid.

**CHUCKLES** (J. Potter) – hampered on jumping away.

### RACE 7: XXXX GOLD BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

LET'S TANGO (C. Lindop) – began awkwardly, shifted out hampering PLAYBOY LANE.

IN THE FAST LANE (T. Pannell) - slow to begin.

MAYBE THIS TIME (D. Tourneur) – laid out rounding the home turn.

**PLAYBOY LANE** (S. Fawke) – hampered on jumping away and as a result was slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**OUTBACK TYCOON** (E. Finnegan) – rider reported that her mount felt awkward in its action after pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

**JUST MAK** (A. Jordsjo) – began awkwardly shifted in contacting PLAYBOY LANE. Laid in under pressure in the straight.
