Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse by the Gawler & Barossa Jockey Club on Wednesday, 23 May 2018

TRACK: Soft 5 WEATHER: Fine.

RAIL: Out 5 metres 800 metres to 400 metres, out 2 metres remainder.

RACE 1: Z-WINE / SABOIS TWO-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1122 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

CATERHAM (T. Pannell) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted in contacting CHEZBLACK. Taken wider in the vicinity of the 400 metres by AVORA SUN.

EQUIMOORE (J. Holder) – contacted on jumping away. Laid out rounding the home turn and raced greenly in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SMART ALICK (A. Chan) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto EQUIMOORE.

THE GEELONG FLYER (J. Huxtable) – struck the outside running rail on exiting the mounting yard dislodging J. Huxtable. Galloped riderless for some distance prior to being recaptured. Late scratching on veterinary advice at 12.05 pm. Trainer, Mr C. Bieg, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its pre-race behaviour.

AVORA SUN (R. Clark) – became awkwardly placed on the heels of EQUIMOORE in the vicinity of the 400 metres and shifted out abruptly inconveniencing CATERHAM.

CHEZBLACK (J. Bowditch) – contacted on jumping away.

COOGEE DANCER (J. Maund) – slow into stride. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KISSABLE EIGHT (C. Lindop) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MAGNETIC ROSE (K. Bishop) – shifted out abruptly in the vicinity of the 800 metres and became awkwardly placed on the heels of CHEZBLACK for a short distance.

RACE 2: COOPERS SESSION ALE TWO OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1122 metres

LORD VARYS (J. Toeroek) – laid out rounding the home turn. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: COOPERS SESSION ALE TWO OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1122 metres (Cont'd)

LOMACHENKO (J. Bowditch) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TEXAS LIL (K. Crowther) – raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 3: BAROSSA.COM / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1224 metres

NOTARBARTOLO (A. Chan) – contacted on jumping away and shortly after lost its position when tightened between EXALTED CRACKER and TECTONIC MOVES, which shifted out slightly.

OH MO (J. Toeroek) – shifted in on jumping away. Shifted in approaching the 1100 metres onto EXALTED CRACKER, which was forced to be taken hold of. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR137(a) and was suspended from riding in raced to commence midnight Saturday, 26 May 2018 and to conclude midnight Saturday, 2 June 2018, a period of 3 meetings. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

TECTONIC MOVES (J. Bowditch) – inconvenienced in the vicinity of the 1100 metres when EXALTED CRACKER was taken in. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider reported he became concerned with the gelding's action over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off hind leg. Trainer, Mr L. Kennewell, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

FROSTY GREY (J. Huxtable) – trainer, Mr C. Bieg, was fined \$100 under AR59A for failing to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card. The horse was permitted to start as it was able to be identified from records held by the Stewards.

EXALTED CRACKER (K. Bishop) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto NOTARBARTOLO. Approaching the 1100 metres was taken in and lost its position when OH MO shifted in.

RACE 4: PAISLEY WINES BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1524 metres

ROTHMOORE (A. Chan) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

ANYPORTINASTORM (J. Toeroek) – in the vicinity of the 1400 metres shifted in abruptly and became unbalanced when RONG DOOR REGGIE improved quickly to its outside. In the vicinity of the 300 metres lost its position when tightened between WALKABOUTCREEK, which was taken in, and LUVULONGTIME, which rolled out.

LUVULONGTIME (J. Holder) – rolled out in the vicinity of the 300 metres onto ANYPORTINASTORM as it commenced to weaken. Rider explained that the gelding had travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event; however, when asked for an effort at the entrance to the straight had failed to respond to his riding and commenced to weaken from the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ALWAYS THE KING (D. Caboche) – laid in throughout the event and in the vicinity of the 300 metres shifted in onto WALKABOUTCREEK. Rider reminded of his obligations and advised to make a greater effort to keep his mounts straight when they commence to shift ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WALKABOUTCREEK (J. Potter) – jumped away awkwardly. In the vicinity of the 300 metres taken in by ALWAYS THE KING onto ANYPORTINASTORM.

BROOKTON ICE (K. Bishop) – jumped away awkwardly and was slow into stride.

RACE 5: BAROSSA VOLKSWAGEN BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1730 metres

BALTIC PRINCE (G. Lo) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

GRAND ARMADA (K. Lau) - slow to begin. Raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 5: BAROSSA VOLKSWAGEN BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1730 metres (Cont'd)

CALL ME PENNY (J. Maund) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FANDANGO (J. Potter) – slow to begin. Improved onto the heels of BALTIC PRINCE in the vicinity of the 1200 metres and had to be steadied for a number of strides. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

BIT OF A FLIRT (K. Crowther) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the off foreleg. Co-trainers, Mr N. O'Shea and Miss A. Downing, were advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

JIMMYTOWN JEWEL (J. Kah) – slow to begin.

TRICKY AFFAIR (K. Bishop) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KIRCHNER (A. Lindsay) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: SCHILD ESTATE WINES BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1122 metres

JUST A BIGGER DASH (K. Lau) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ANAMNESIS (A. Chan) – became awkwardly placed on the heels of SNOWBROOK in the vicinity of the 800 metres and had to be steadied. In being steadied rolled out onto CASH IS COMING.

SNOWBROOK (J. Kah) – held up from the vicinity of the 400 metres until entrance to the straight.

MASTER BLACK (K. Crowther) – inconvenienced and taken wider on the track in the vicinity of the 800 metres by CASH IS COMING.

OUR PROSPECT (C. Lindop) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CASH IS COMING (A. Lindsay) – inconvenienced and taken wider onto MASTER BLACK in the vicinity of the 800 metres by ANAMNESIS and became awkwardly placed for a number of strides on the heels of QUIVERS.

RACE 7: GOLDIN FARMS / SABOIS+ BAROSSA CUP - 2132 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

PASS THE GLASS (T. Pannell) – laid in under pressure in the straight.

KAZOOM (NZ) (D. Caboche) - slow to begin.

CHAPAL (J. Kah) – lost its near fore plate en route to the barrier and required farrier attention.

STAR WARS (NZ) (J. Maund) – jumped away awkwardly.

SANIMA STAR (K. Crowther) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 800 metres raced in restricted room to the inside of SPANISH HALO (NZ) and had to be steadied, losing its position.

RACE 8: KELLERMEISTER WINES CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1224 metres

ANCIENT HISTORY (IRE) (K. Crowther) - slow to begin.

SWISS DESIGN (T. Pannell) – contacted on jumping away.

DEXELATION (D. Caboche) – jumped away awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PEWTER (A. Chan) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8: KELLERMEISTER WINES CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1224 metres (Cont'd)

AUSTRALIAN DESIGN (J. Kah) – jumped away awkwardly.

MAYBE THIS TIME (C. Lindop) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RUSTYDUSTYSUNSHINE (G. Lo) – jumped away awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PARTY SET (K. Bishop) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto SWISS DESIGN.
