RACE 1: FREELING FOOTBALL CLUB HANDICAP - 1200 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

HE WILL BOOM (P. Gatt) – proved difficult to load. Trainer, Mr G. Searle, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding.

TONGSAI BOSS (R. Clark) – jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

TOOLBAR (J. Bowditch) – jumped away awkwardly.

BEHEMOTH (K. Crowther) – proved difficult to load. Trainer, Mr D. Jolly, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding. Slow to begin. Raced fiercely and hung out in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

BURN OFF (A. Chan) – reared on jumping away. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be lame in both hind legs. First aid administered. Trainer, Mr S. Cahill, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

RACE 2: COOPERS SESSION ALE HANDICAP – 1200 metres

SO YOU TOO (R. Clark) – held up from the vicinity of the 500 metres until approaching the 200 metres and then laid in under pressure.

RACE 2: COOPERS SESSION ALE HANDICAP – 1200 metres (cont'd)

FALCOOL (T. Pannell) – rider explained that the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event; however, when placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 500 metres was reluctant to stretch out and he had become concerned with its action over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

STRAGUN (A. Chan) – slow to begin.

RACE 3: GOLDIN FARMS - AKEED MOFEED HANDICAP - 1500 metres

NIGHT FALLS (B. Rawiller) – inside the 500 metres shifted out onto SKID LID. Rider reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

CHUBBY RAIN (O. Ridge) – rider reported that the gelding did not stretch out throughout the event despite his efforts. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off hind leg. Trainer, Mr S. Gower, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

OH MO (J. Bowditch) – slow to begin. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

TRIPLE DEEZ (K. Crowther) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SKID LID (J. Kah) – had to be steadied inside the 500 metres when NIGHT FALLS shifted out.

LOSTARC (R. Sakai) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: GAWLER CARAVAN PARK HANDICAP - 2100 metres

ANNAMAN (R. Hurdle) – inconvenienced in the vicinity of the 300 metres when DIAMOND DUKE was taken in.

MORE THAN FABULOUS (J. Bowditch) – rider reported that the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event; however, when placed under pressure in the vicinity of the 500 metres failed to respond to his riding and in his opinion felt lethargic. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in both forelegs. Trainer, Mr G. Searle, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

TABLE OF WISDOM (J. Kah) – in the vicinity of the 300 metres rolled in and contacted DIAMOND DUKE.

CASINO CLUB (P. Gatt) – had to be checked in the vicinity of the 200 metres when DANOULI shifted in.

DIAMOND DUKE (T. Pannell) – taken in onto ANNAMAN in the vicinity of the 300 metres by TABLE OF WISDOM.

KAZOOM (NZ) (J. Potter) – slow to begin.

DANOULI (R. Clark) – inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight. In the vicinity of the 200 metres shifted in under riding when insufficiently clear of CASINO CLUB, which had to be checked. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR137(a) and was suspended from riding in races to commence at midnight Sunday, 8 July 2018 to conclude midnight Sunday, 15 July 2018, a period of 3 meetings. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ECLAIR FIESTA (FR) (K. Crowther) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off hind leg. Trainer, Mr P. Stokes, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

JIMMYTOWN JEWEL (J. Holder) – slow to begin.

RACE 5: CHATEAU YALDARA HANDICAP - 1100 metres

NODOUBTABOUTIT (K. Crowther) – jumped away awkwardly. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight and in the vicinity of the 50 metres shifted in onto MYSTICANO.

MYSTICANO (T. Pannell) – raced in restricted room for a number of strides in the vicinity of the 50 metres when NODOUBTABOUTIT shifted in.

GOLD DENARI (A. Chan) – jumped away awkwardly. Approaching the 100 metres shifted in to attempt a run at the same time as TRUENO shifted out to attempt the same run, resulting in these runners brushing.

TRUENO (R. Sakai) – approaching the 100 metres shifted in to attempt a run at the same time as GOLD DENARI shifted in to attempt the same run, resulting in these runners brushing and TRUENO having to be steadied for a number of strides and losing its position when it became awkwardly placed on the heels of ASHERO, and inside GOLD DENARI.

ALASKAN JADE (E. Finnegan) – contacted on jumping away. Rider reported that she was disappointed with the mare's performance in today's event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

L'AMARYBELLE (D. Tourneur) – rider reported that the mare had only travelled fairly throughout the event and had not responded when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ASHERO (A. Jordsjo) – shifted out on jumping away and contacted ALASKAN JADE.

OUR PROSPECT (R. Clark) – contacted on jumping away.

BOLDACIOUS GIRL (K. Bishop) – held up from the entrance to the straight until the vicinity of the 200 metres.

MINT COLLECTOR (J. Holder) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out contacting OUR PROPECT.

RACE 6: GAWLER CENTRAL FOOTBALL CLUB HANDICAP - 1700 metres

BALF'S CHOICE (A. Chan) – rider reported that the gelding dipped on a number of occasions throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BROWN BEN (K. Crowther) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

ROYAL RUMBLE (R. Clark) – slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

AZURO (FR) (J. Bowditch) – slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid out rounding the home turn and under pressure in the straight.

LADY SILHOUETTE (E. Finnegan) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

ORAKEI OVERLORD (NZ) (P. Gatt) – raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 7: 1847 WINES HANDICAP - 1550 metres

BIANMAGIC (T. Pannell) – slow to begin.

MERRIMEN (J. Bowditch) – had difficulty obtaining clear ground in the straight and then became held up inside the final 100 metres.

SUPERVELOCE (NZ) (R. Clark) – rider reported that in her opinion the gelding had not handled the track conditions.

AMPLE ON OFFA (D. Tourneur) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: 1847 WINES HANDICAP - 1550 metres (cont'd)

PALE ALE (E. Finnegan) – rider reported that the gelding did not feel comfortable in its action. A postrace veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DANCES ON STARS (NZ) (A. Jordsjo) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off hind leg. Trainer, Mr G. Young, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

RACE 8: EXCHANGE HOTEL AFTER THE LAST HANDICAP - 1200 metres

POSEIDON'S POOL (B. Rawiller) – had difficulty obtaining clear ground in the straight.

MONDO MAGIC (E. Boyd) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MOUNT HOREB (A. Chan) – slow to begin and shortly after was hampered when GALCURM shifted out. In the vicinity of the 700 metres shifted in for no apparent reason and made heavy contact with the running rail. Laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near hind leg. Trainer, Mr G. Osborne, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

GALCRUM (J. Maund) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto MOUNT HOREB.

TENNESSEE RAIDER (R. Clark) – rider questioned in relation to returning to scale in excess of half a kilogram over the weight imposed. After considering her explanation rider was reprimanded under AR145. In arriving at this penalty Stewards noted that R. Clark's minimum riding weight will be increased to 53 kilograms following today's meeting.
