Report on Race Meeting held at the Naracoorte Racecourse by the Naracoorte Racing Club on Wednesday, 31 October 2018

RACE 1: BOB ATKINSON / SABOIS PLUS MAIDEN/CLASS 1 PLATE - 1800 meters

GO WALLY (A. Chan) – in the vicinity of the 1600 metres shifted in inconveniencing HE'S A VALLEYBOY. Rider severely reprimanded under AR137(a) for careless riding. In the vicinity of the 1200 metres was inconvenienced by SECRET BAR, which shifted out. In the vicinity of the 600 metres rolled in and inconvenienced ROCK STAR LAD. On entering the straight shifted out taking EUDORA wider. Rider reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

HE'S A VALLEYBOY (D. Caboche) – slow to begin. In the vicinity of the 1600 metres was obliged to be eased to avoid the heels of GO WALLY, which shifted in. In the vicinity of the 800 metres rolled in and inconvenienced GO WALLY.

LORD GREYSON (S. Cahill) – slow to begin. Raced keenly throughout the event. In the vicinity of the 1200 metres was obliged to be steadied after improving onto the heels of GO WALLY. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Rider explained that LORD GREYSON travelled well until 1000 metres when the gelding became awkwardly placed on the heels of GO WALLY, and from that point, weakened and was disappointing to the finish. Mr G. Lynch, representing Trainer, Mr G. Young, could offer no explanation for the gelding's poor performance but undertook to report to the Stewards of the gelding's future racing plans.

QUICKCRAFT (P. Marks) – slow to begin. Raced in restricted room in the vicinity of the 1600 metres between EUDORA and HE'S A VALLEYBOY. in the vicinity of the 1400 metres was inconvenienced by EUDORA, which rolled out. Taken wider at the entrance to the straight by GO WALLY, which shifted out

EUDORA (K. Crowther) – in the vicinity of the 1400 metres made contact with the running rail and became unbalanced, shifted out and inconvenienced QUICKCRAFT. On entering the straight was taken wider by GO WALLY, which shifted out.

INSTINCTUAL (C. Caserta) – laid out from the 800 metres.

ROCK STAR LAD (E. Boyd) – slow to begin. In the vicinity of the 600 metres was obliged to be steadied away from the heels of GO WALLY, which rolled in.

ELITE LADY (R. Clark) - jumped away awkwardly.

SECRET BAR (S. Fawke) –Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 1200 metres shifted out inconveniencing GO WALLY. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR137(a) for careless riding and was advised to only shift ground when entitled to do so.

RACE 2: BOB MCKAY / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1430 meters

AMERICAN BLUE (A. Chan) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: BOB MCKAY / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1430 meters (Cont'd)

DARILJON (S. Fawke) – laid in, in the straight.

TARDAVAUX (P. Marks) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: PETER & ROBYN WALTERS CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1430 metres

BEL MOSHE (S. Fawke) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid out from the 1200 metres to the 1000 metres.

DANGEROUS REBEL (R. Hurdle) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid out throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LILAC WINE (E. Finnegan) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: RACELANDS RACING STABLES BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

BONNE SENSATION (J. Potter) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out contacting GAMBLER'S GIRL. Approaching the 200 metres was disappointed for a run between GAMBLER'S GIRL and JIMASSI, and was obliged to alter course to the inside of JIMASSI to obtain clear running.

JIMASSI (J. Maund) – laid in from the 400 metres.

GAMBLER'S GIRL (R. Clark) – hampered on jumping away.

SACRED SISTER (S. Thornton) – inconvenienced on jumping away. Approaching the 100 metres rolled out and tightened PANDEIA.

JUST LIKE HEAVEN (D. Tourneur) - hampered on jumping away.

PELLINA (K. Crowther) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

PANDEIA (S. Logan) – approaching the 100 metres was obliged to be steadied when tightened onto AKERBOY by SACRED SISTER, which rolled out.

RACE 5: UBET / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

PUFTALOON (S. Fawke) – inconvenienced on jumping away by CADWIL KID, which was taken wider. Laid in, in the straight placing its rider at a disadvantage. Rider reported after placing the gelding under pressure from the 600 metres, the gelding commenced **to** lay in, and for that reason, in the straight, he could not ride the mount out in his usual manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WEDGEBROOK (G. Lo) – shifted out and away from SUNMATE taking CADWIL KID wider.

MISSED ME (R. Hurdle) – awkward to begin and as a result was slow into stride.

SHABO GOLD (R. Clark) – rider reported the mare laid out throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SUNMATE (K. Bishop) - jumped away awkwardly.

ZEMLYA (J. Maund) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PURELY ON SPEC (C. Caserta) – awkward to begin.

RACE 6: JIM & MAUREEN BIGGINS BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

PHAR LINK (A. Jordsjo) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding had bled from both nostrils. Trainer, Mr J. Searle was advised that as this was the gelding's first bi-lateral bleed PHAR LINK would now be suspended from racing for a period of three months in accordance with AR53A and would be required to gallop 1000 metres in the presence of a Steward prior to accepting for a future race.

CASINO MAGIC (E. Finnegan) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and tightened HASTA LA BOUNTY. Laid in, in the straight.

LITTLE HEATH (R. Hurdle) – in the vicinity of the 100 metres shifted in when insufficiently clear of HASTA LA BOUNTY. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR137(a) in that he shifted ground when insufficiently clear and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight on Saturday, 10 November and to conclude at midnight on Saturday, 17 November 2018: a period of four meetings.

HASTA LA BOUNTY (S. Fawke) – on jumping away tightened onto LITTLE HEATH by CASINO MAGIC, which shifted in and lost its positon. In the vicinity of the 100 metres had to be restrained to avoid the heels of LITTLE HEATH, which shifted in.

SQUADRON LEADER (R. Clark) – raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

VISUAL IMAGE (K. Bishop) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

Correct weight was delayed to allow S. Fawke (HASTA LA BOUNTY) placed third, to view the vision in the straight.

RACE 7: CADGEE PARK RACING BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 2000 metres

ROCK ON IVY (NZ) (S. Logan) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 8: LOCAL TRAINERS BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP - 1430 metres

DANGLE LAD (A. Jordsjo) – in the vicinity of the 1300 metres was obliged to be steadied to avoid the heels of SIR CHARLESTON (NZ), which shifted in.

CANNOT BE SERIOS (NZ) (K. Crowther) – disappointed for clear running at the entrance to the straight. Inclined to lay in, in the straight.

CRYSTAL GLASS (R. Clark) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider explained from in the vicinity of the 400 metres, when placed under pressure, the mare failed to respond to her riding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SIR CHARLESTON (NZ) (S. Logan) – raced wide throughout the event. In the vicinity of the 1300 metres shifted in and inconvenienced DANGLE LAD. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR137(a) for careless riding and advised to only shift ground when entitled to do so.
