Report on Race Meeting held at Naracoorte Racecourse

RACE 1: DON IRLAM MEMORIAL / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1430 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

BOOGIE WOOGIE (R. Hurdle) - rider dislodged en route to the barriers. R. Hurdle was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and passed fit to fulfil his engagements. Trainer, Mr P. Ryan, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding regarding its pre-race manners.

CADWIL KID (P. Marks) - when questioned regarding the performance of the gelding P. Marks stated that his mount failed to respond to his riding throughout the event, and from the vicinity of the 600 metres he became concerned with the action of the gelding and as a result elected not to place CADWIL KID under pressure over the concluding stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SHABO GOLD (E. Finnegan) - slow to begin. When questioned regarding the performance of the mare E. Finnegan stated that her mount was under pressure from the vicinity of the 600 metres and she was disappointed in its finished efforts. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CROWN HARMONIUM (S. Fawke) - difficult to load. Trainer, Mr J. Hickmott, was advised that the filly would be required to load without delay in either an Approval to Race Jump-out or an Official Barrier Trial prior to a future race start.

RACE 2: FAMILY DAY SUNDAY 30TH DECEMBER / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

AHIGA (S. Fawke) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not raced in the past twelve months and was passed fit to start. Fractious in the barriers. Trainer, Mr S. Burford, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding.

RACE 2: FAMILY DAY SUNDAY 30TH DECEMBER / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres
(cont'd)

AQUIFER MIST (S. Cahill) - fractious in the barriers. Late scratching at 2.33 pm. Co-trainer, Mr T. O'Sullivan, was advised that the gelding would be required to complete an Official Barrier Trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to a future race start.

CAPTAINZWAYZE (E. Finnegan) - slow to begin. When questioned regarding the performance of the gelding E. Finnegan stated that after being slow to begin CAPTAINZWAYZE raced fiercely in the early stages. She added she elected to shift her mount to the outside of runners in an attempt to settle her mount. She further added that the gelding began to weaken from the vicinity of the 400 metres and ran to the line in a disappointing manner.

SANDHILL GALAXY (J. Lorensini) - in the vicinity of the 400 metres was momentarily inconvenienced when ROHLON DRUNK shifted in.

ROHLON DRUNK (D. Tourneur) - began awkwardly. Laid in under pressure throughout the event. In the vicinity of the 400 metres shifted in despite the efforts of its rider hampering SANDHILL GALAXY.

ZETMORE (G. Lo) - rider reported that the gelding made breathing noises throughout the event, and as a result he elected not to place the gelding under pressure over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KING HAMISH (P. Marks) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not raced in the past twelve months and was passed fit to start.

RACE 3: GRAROCK PLUMBING BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

RHYTHMATIC (D. Tourneur) - momentarily held up for clear running on entering the straight.

STRATEGIC GLASS (J. Lorensini) - when questioned regarding the performance of the gelding J. Lorensini reported that his mount began well but when he placed the gelding under pressure in the vicinity of the 600 metres it failed to respond to his riding and finished the event in a disappointing manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ACTION IN RIO (NZ) (E. Finnegan) - began awkwardly.

RACE 4: HAYNES ENGINEERING BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

PELLINA (D. Tourneur) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

SHE'S DELICIOUS (P. Marks) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not raced in the past twelve months and was passed fit to start. Hampered on jumping on away. In the vicinity of the 700 metres shifted in despite the efforts of its rider severely hampering RADIOLOGIST. Laid in under pressure throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HASTA LA BOUNTY (E. Finnegan) - began awkwardly. Raced wide without cover throughout the event. When questioned regarding the performance of the gelding E. Finnegan reported that in her opinion HASTA LA BOUNTY would be better suited over further ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RADIOLOGIST (S. Fawke) - knuckled on jumping away. In the vicinity of the 700 metres was severely hampered by SHE'S DELICIOUS, which shifted in. Raced in restricted room from the vicinity of the 500 metres to the 200 metres.

RACE 4: HAYNES ENGINEERING BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1000 metres (cont'd)

TRUE LIBERTY (S. Logan) – began awkwardly, shifted out and contacted SHE'S DELICIOUS. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 5: DONNA'S ELECTRICAL BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 2000 metres

BRONSKI (J. Lorensini) – began awkwardly, shifted in and contacted CENTENARY SHOT. Over-raced in the early stages of the event. Laid in throughout the event. In the vicinity of the 300 metres shifted in abruptly despite the efforts of its rider severely hampering ELITE LADY. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

QUEEN'S PALACE (R. Hurdle) – trainer, Mr R. Gilcrist, advised Stewards prior to the event of a change of tactics in that he would instruct his rider to attempt to settle further back than at the mare's most recent start. Settled back.

CENTENARY SHOT (E. Finnegan) – fractious in the barriers. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start. Hampered on jumping away by BRONSKI, which shifted in, and ELITE LADY, which shifted out.

ELITE LADY (J. Maund) – began awkwardly, shifted out and contacted CENTENARY SHOT. In the vicinity of the 300 metres was severely hampered by BRONSKI, which shifted in abruptly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FORCE OF THREE (E. Boyd) – over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid out throughout the event.

RACE 6: KERKHOF CONCRETE CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1200 metres

NASEEB (S. Cahill) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

BWUVA (K. Lau) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it competed at Gawler on Wednesday, 21 November 2018, and was passed fit to start. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CHIC SALE (E. Boyd) – reared on jumping away and as a result was slow to begin. When questioned regarding the performance of CHIC SALE rider reported that after rearing on jumping away she had to place her mount under pressure in the early stages in an attempt to tack on to the field. She further stated that CHIC SALE failed to respond to her riding at any stages of the event and ran to the line in a disappointing manner. Trainer, Mr J. Dodgson, was advised that the gelding was now required to perform to the satisfaction of Stewards in an Official Barrier Trial prior to a future trial or race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MONTRE (J. Potter) – began awkwardly.

RACE 7: LIVING TURF BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1430 metres

PEWTER (S. Cahill) – held up for clear running on entering the straight.

CRYSTAL GLASS (J. Lorensini) – in the vicinity of the 400 metres shifted in when insufficiently clear of ZERO PATIENCE. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR137(a) and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence midnight Tuesday, 27 November 2018 to conclude midnight Sunday, 2 December 2018, a period of four meetings.

TIZA (E. Finnegan) – laid in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 7: LIVING TURF BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP – 1430 metres (cont'd)

BEL MOSHE (S. Fawke) - over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

ZERO PATIENCE (A. Jordsjo) - in the vicinity of the 400 metres was severely hampered when **CRYSTAL GLASS** shifted in when insufficiently clear.
