Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse

TRACK: Good 4 (Track with some give in it)
Downgraded to a Soft 5 @ 5.04 pm retrospective to Race 1 (Track with a reasonable amount of give in it)

RAIL: Out 5 metres entire. Sectional 610 metres.

RACE 1: KINGSFORD HOTEL / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1719 metres

COMFORT MAN (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.

INDIAN MO (D. Tootell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ABLAAN (J. Kah) - rider reported the gelding did not respond to her riding in the straight and was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SMART ALICK (E. Boyd) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

THE GEELONG FLYER (J. Potter) - inconvenienced in the straight when taken wider by KHANION BAY.

KHANION BAY (D. Tourneur) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the vicinity of the 500 metres until inside the 400 metres. Shifted out at the entrance to the straight to obtain clear ground and in doing so, shifted out onto THE GEELONG FLYER.

RACE 2: HOLDFAST INSURANCE / SABOIS MAIDNE PLATE - 1100 metres

A THOUSAND DEGREES (J. Kah) - stepped a discoloured section of the track in the vicinity of the 1000 metres.

RACE 2: HOLDFAST INSURANCE / SABOIS MAIDNE PLATE - 1100 metres (Cont'd)

GRAVITY (J. Holder) - become held up at the entrance to the straight. Difficulty obtaining clear ground until the vicinity of the 100 metres.

HABANERO (D. Tourneur) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

SCARE CAMPAIGN (T. Pannell) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

OLIVER'S TALE (K. Lau) - inconvenienced in the vicinity of the 900 metres when **AMBIDEE** shifted in. Raced in restricted room for a number of strides at the entrance to the straight.

SIR JOHNSON (K. Bishop) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event and was wide without cover throughout.

AMBIDEE (J. Toeroek) - shifted in inside the 900 metres onto **OLIVER'S TALE**, which was inconvenienced. Rider reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

GUEST LIST (M. Henderson) - slow to begin. Improved onto the heels of **KIROSHIMA** approaching the 200 metres and became held up until able to alter course to that gelding's outside near the 100 metres.

RACE 3: BAROSSA WINES AT THE RACES - SAT JAN 2TH / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

JACK'S SISTER (E. Boyd) - laid out rounding the home turn and under pressure in the straight.

ONE O'CLOCK ROCK (W. Cave) - had to be steadied in the vicinity of the 800 metres when **TATTIES** shifted in. In being steadied got its head up, over-reacted and lost ground. Rider accidentally dropped his whip in the vicinity of the 200 metres.

TATTIES (R. Hurdle) - approaching the 800 metres shifted in onto **ONE O'CLOCK ROCK**, which had to be steadied when tightened onto **JACK'S SISTER**. Rider reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

COOL DESERT (J. Maund) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ENOUGH SWAGGER (J. Kah) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

FAR AFIELD (J. Holder) - slow to begin. Rider reported the filly did not feel comfortable in its action during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer Mr T. McEvoy was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

MISS JULIANNE (K. Bishop) - jumped away awkwardly.

STREKOZA (R. Clark) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a small laceration to the near fore cannon. First aid administered.

RACE 4: COOPER DRY CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1516 metres

OUT OF KILTER (J. Holder) - slow to begin. Laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ART MUSIC (R. Clark) - laid out under pressure in the straight. In the vicinity of the 100 metres was taken wider by **CASUE WE CAN**, which shifted out.

RACE 4: COOPER DRY CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1516 metres (Cont'd)

TROOPER'S PLOY (A. Chan) - in the vicinity of the 200 metres was forced to race in restricted room for a short distance when **OUT OF KILTER** shifted in slightly at the same time as **ART MUSIC** shifted out and then obliged to alter course to obtain clear ground,

CAUSE WE CAN (C. Caserta) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid out under pressure in the straight. Approaching the 100 metres shifted out onto **ART MUSIC** taking that gelding wider.

DOUBLESPEAK (J. Toeroek) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed a strained near fore tendon. First aid administered. Trainers were advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

RACE 5: GOLDIN FARMS - AKEED MOFEED BANCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 2121 metres

DR DEPENDABLE (R. Clark) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

LIZZIE LOUISE (A. Chan) - laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare bled from one nostril. Trainer Mr W. Bencic was advised the mare and would be required to gallop a 1000 metres in the presence of a Steward prior to accepting for a future race in accordance with AR53A.

PAT THE WEAPON (G. Lo) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event and was wide without cover throughout. Laid out under pressure in the straight.

RACE 6: AUSBIA ELECTRICAL CLASS 1 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

FEVER (J. Toeroek) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LIGHT THE WAVES (C. Caserta) - rider explained the mare was unable to maintain contact with the field in the early and middle stages despite his efforts, which in his opinion was due to the speed and distance of the race. He added that after straightening the mare picked up and finished the race off strongly. He further added that **LIGHT THE WAVES** would be better suited in a race over a longer distance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: GARNER MEMORIALS BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

CHARLIE GARCON (S. Price) - slow to begin.

CRYSTAL MOMENT (K. Lau) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid out over the concluding 600 metres of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.
