

THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Port Lincoln Racecourse by the Port Lincoln Racing Club on Sunday, 13 January 2019

RAIL: Out 2 metres from 800 metres to Winning Post, out 1 metre remainder.

RACE 1: LINCOLN SAND SUPPLIES - NT & DA DICKSON / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1210 metres

BALWARRA SPIRIT (L. Goomany) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted in tightening AMERICAIN SAPHIRE. Held up for clear running from the 300 metres to the 200 metres.

GOURMELIN (K. Bishop) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

MANDALA (S. Logan) - shifted out on jumping away tightening AMERICAIN SAPHIRE. Raced greenly throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WARY GLANCE (S. Fawke) – rider accidentally dropped his whip in the vicinity of the 300 metres. Rolled around in the straight.

AMERICAIN SAPHIRE (J. Maund) – slow to begin and shortly afterwards was tightened by MANDALA, which shifted out, and BALWARRA SPIRIT, which shifted in, and lost its position. Held up for clear running at the entrance to the straight. Rider reported that inside the 200 metres the mare was reluctant to improve into a tight run to the inside of WARY GLANCE, which rolled in.

RACE 2: RAMSEY BROS BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1750 metres

NEVA DOUBT US (R. Clark) – in the vicinity of the 500 metres taken wider by UMALUKA, which laid out, tightening COOL RUNNINGS (NZ).

HARD AT IT (J. Kah) - in the vicinity of the 1200 metres rolled in and tightened UMALUKA.



RACE 2: RAMSEY BROS BENCHMARK 80 HANDICAP - 1750 metres (cont'd)

UMALUKA (J. Toeroek) – in the vicinity of the 1200 metres was tightened by HARD AT IT, which rolled in. In the vicinity of the 500 metres laid out taking NEVA DOUBT US wider. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer, Ms J. Stoetzer, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

COOL RUNNINGS (NZ) (A. Chan) – approaching the 500 metres raced in restricted room for a number of strides between NEVA DOUBT US and DESERT MINTY shortly after lost its position when both those runners shifted ground slightly.

DESERT MINTY (S. Fawke) – in the vicinity of the 500 metres rolled in tightening COOL RUNNINGS (NZ).

RACE 3: TUNARAMA COACHLINES CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1210 metres

MR TRUMAN (J. Toeroek) – in the vicinity of the 1000 metres bumped by KOODA STAR, which shifted in. Approaching the finish was inconvenienced by HOW JAMMY'S THAT, which shifted in.

BARE WITNESS (G. Lo) – jumped away awkwardly. Laid out from the 600 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed minor lacerations to the off hind pastern.

STORM VOYAGER (J. Kah) – rider explained that she had no firm instructions, but after jumping well from a wide barrier she elected to press forward.

OBLIQUE LINE (K. Bishop) - awkward to begin.

KOODA STAR (S. Logan) - raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 1000 metres shifted in and bumped MR TRUMAN. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HOW JAMMY'S THAT (J. Maund) – approaching the finish attempted a tight run between MR TRUMAN and CHOUX BACQUAT (NZ), shifted in and inconvenienced MR TRUMAN.

RACE 4: DK QUARRIES BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

SOCIAL MEDIA (S. Logan) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GOLD RUNNER (J. Maund) – fractious in the barriers and became cast. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and ruled unfit to race. Acting on this advice Stewards declared GOLD RUNNER a late scratching at 3.02 pm. Trainer, Ms A. Cornell, was advised that the gelding was now required to prove tractable in an Approval to Race Jump-out prior to a future race start.

APOLLO HOPE (S. Fawke) - from the 400 metres to the entrance to the straight became held up on the heels of COOLIDGE.

TORNADO BLUE (L. Goomany) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: XTREME KITES & PADDLE BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1390 metres

BURNRO (J. Kah) – held up for clear running from the 400 metres until inside the 200 metres. In the vicinity of the 300 metres was obliged to steady to avoid the heels of TURFONIC, which shifted out.



RACE 5: XTREME KITES & PADDLE BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1390 metres (cont'd)

TURFONIC (J. Maund) – shifted out in the vicinity of the 300 metres and inconvenienced BURNRO. Rider reminded of his obligations when his horses commence to shift ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed an abrasion to the off hind leg. First aid administered.

CALL ME CRACKERS (K. Lau) – jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin. Dislodged rider on pulling up. K. Lau was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and was passed fit to fulfil his remaining engagements. A post-race veterinary examination revealed minor lacerations to the near hind paster. First aid applied. Trainer, Ms C. Rose, was advised that a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to being uncompetitive.

RACE 6: SCALLYWAGS TOYS & NURSERY BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1210 metres

VINTAGE GROVE (K. Lau) - jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin.

MIRTHDALE (A. Chan) - laid in, in the straight. In the vicinity of the 100 metres shifted in onto the heels of SLIDE OF HAND and was obliged to be steadied.

LICORICE BULLET (K. Bishop) - laid in, in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: EP FUNCTION HIRE BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1750 metres

ARTFUL MONTY (J. Maund) – raced keenly in the middle stages of the event and got its head up whilst being restrained after improving onto the heels of TASSIE in the vicinity of the 1000 metres.

CRAZY CULPRIT (B. Sweeney) – approaching the 1300 metres shifted in and tightened KAAPOW. Rider severely reprimanded and advised to only shift ground when entitled to do so.

KAAPOW (A. Chan) – approaching the 1300 metres was tightened by CRAZY CULPRIT, which shifted in, and was obliged to be steadied.

HARDASHIAN (J. Toeroek) – began to weaken in the vicinity of the 600 metres. Rider reported that he elected not to ride his mount out in his normal manner as he had become concerned with its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer, Ms A. Harder, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to being uncompetitive.

HEZA HUSSLER (S. Logan) – inside the 800 metres when racing in restricted room to the outside of CRAZY CULPRIT and to the inside of BURGUNDEE MISS was obliged to be steadied when both runners shifted ground slightly.

WHITWAY (G. Lo) - began awkwardly.

BURGUNDEE MISS (L. Goomany) – laid out throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ANOTHER MARTINI (K. Bishop) - raced fiercely in the early stages of the event.
