Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Racecourse
by the South Australian Jockey Club on Wednesday, 23 January 2019

RAIL: Out 12 metres from 1200 metres to Winning Post, out 9 metres remainder. Sectional 616 metres.

RACE 1: JAMES BOAGS / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1539 metres

FROSTY GREY (R. Clark) - rider explained that she had been instructed to take up a forward position in the event. She added that after finding the lead the mare raced fiercely and extended its lead on the field to greater than she had anticipated despite her efforts and given the circumstances she was of the opinion that the mare had finished the event off well.

COTILLION (C. Caserta) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

MAJESTIC RIDGE (E. Boyd) - slow to begin. Rider reported that in her opinion the mare may have tied up. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MYOPIC (D. Caboche) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

RACE 2: TERRY HOWE PRINTING / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1050 metres

CAFFE ROMANO (R. Clark) - laid out under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: TERRY HOWE PRINTING / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE – 1050 metres (cont'd)

LIBERTY BLUE (J. Huxtable) – jumped away awkwardly and raced greenly throughout the event. At the entrance to the straight commenced to lay out and in being corrected shifted in slightly onto WARITON. Continued to lay out for the remainder of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

NIC'S SECRET (C. Caserta) – laid out throughout the event. Raced keenly on the heels of SOPHINA DIVA from the vicinity of the 600 metres until the entrance to the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

AQUILINE (R. Hurdle) – rolled out rounding the home turn onto WARITON.

WARITON (D. Caboche) – hampered at the entrance to the straight when tightened between AQUILINE, which rolled out at the same time as LIBERTY BLUE shifted in whilst being corrected. Raced greenly in the straight.

RACE 3: NUTELLA PALOOZA - APRIL 20 AT MORPHETTVILLE RACECOURSE BM 60 HANDICAP – 2049 metres

ALL WELL (IRE) (S. Fawke) – trainer, Mr G. Young, advised Stewards of a change of tactics prior to the event in that he would instruct his rider to attempt to settle further back than at the gelding's previous start. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 4: SCHWEPPE / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

LOPE DE WOLF (K. Crowther) – shifted in on jumping away onto RAPID RAISER. Hung out from the vicinity of the 600 metres and under pressure in the straight. Co-trainer, Mr W. Francis, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its racing manners. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LOTS OF COIN (D. Caboche) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RAPID RAISER (C. Caserta) – slow to begin and shortly afterwards was inconvenienced when contacted by LOPE DE WOLF.

RIZSKI (R. Clark) – shifted in on jumping away onto NORMAN PRINCESS.

NORMAN PRINCESS (R. Hurdle) – hampered on jumping away when contacted by RIZSKI.

SHINING BRIGHTLY (A. Chan) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: TAB ADELAIDE CUP - MARCH 11 AT MORPHETTVILLE BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

FORTIFY (S. Fawke) – stood flat-footed and was slow to begin. Trainer, Mr G. Young, was advised that the gelding would be required to jump on terms with the field in an Official Barrier Trial prior to a future race.

CHARLIE GARCON (S. Price) – awkward to begin.

FEVER (D. Tourneur) – in the vicinity of the 400 metres was inconvenienced and had to be eased when ASHADY HUSSY shifted out. Laid in under pressure in the straight. Rider reminded of his obligations in riding his mount out to the finish of the race in accordance with AR137(b). A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: TAB ADELAIDE CUP - MARCH 11 AT MORPHETTVILLE BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1200 metres (cont'd)

ASHADY HUSSY (J. Toeroek) - awkward to begin. In the vicinity of the 400 metres shifted out onto FEVER. Rider reprimanded under AR137(a) for careless riding.

EQUICHOI (J. Maund) - rider advised of his obligations in riding his mount out to the finish of the race in accordance with AR137(b).

VOD (E. Finnegan) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: HIT107 BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1600 metres

LYNCH MOB (C. Caserta) - rider accidentally dropped his whip in the vicinity of the 150 metres.

BROTHER DARKNESS (J. Holder) - shifted in under pressure approaching the 200 metres onto MCAULIFFE.

EXALTED LAURETTA (J. Toeroek) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

MCAULIFFE (K. Crowther) - in the vicinity of the 200 metres was forced to race in restricted room for a short distance between BROTHER DARKNESS, which shifted in, and GROOVE WITH ME, which rolled out slightly.

RIGHT AND READY (S. Fawke) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: AAMI CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1050 metres

EXTREME THRILL (K. Crowther) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

FLOP (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly and shortly afterwards was inconvenienced when contacted by BEIWEN.

JOLIE ROSE (R. Clark) - turned its head slightly as the start was effected and as a consequence was awkwardly to begin.

BEIWEN (S. Fawke) - shifted out on jumping away onto FLOP. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ZARACE (D. Tourneur) - was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon on arrival at the start who reported that the gelding was lame in the off foreleg. Acting on this advice Stewards withdrew ZARACE at 5.39 pm. Trainer, Mr K, Sweeney, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.
