STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Parks Racecourse
by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 2 February 2019

TRACK: Good 4 (Track with some give in it)
Upgraded to a Good 3 at 3.57 pm retrospective to Race 5.
(Track with good grass coverage and cushion)

RACE 1: 36° SOUTH HANDICAP - 1000 metres

DALASAN (R. Clark) - jumped away awkwardly.

INZAGHI (D. Tourneur) - Stewards questioned D. Tourneur into his riding in the straight, in particular in relation to his vigour over the concluding 200 metres and the amount of times he had looked to his outside at the eventual winner DALASAN. D. Tourneur explained that he had been instructed that the horse would likely lead, however, it had a relatively short sprint, so if possible to try and maintain a hold until the vicinity of the 200 metres to allow the horse the best chance to finish off the event. He stated that the horse had raced a touch fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event, and was of the opinion rounding the home turn that the filly would not have much of a kick, and for this reason had elected to comply with the instructions he had received and not ask it for an effort until the vicinity of the 200 metres. He added that after drawing the whip inside the 100 metres INZAGHI had not responded and continued to race at its top. Stewards confirmed the instructions supplied with the travelling foreman, Mr David Crofts. After considering his evidence and viewing the vision Stewards took no further action but advised D. Tourneur in future to ride in a manner that did not invite question and in their opinion he would have been better suited on this occasion to concentrate on his mount and ride it to the finish rather than continually look to his outside. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: ADELAIDE GALVANISING HANDICAP - 1000 metres

FIRST DIAMOND (C. Caserta) - lost its off fore plate during the event.

METRO TRAMP (D. Caboche) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be lame in both forelegs. Trainer, Mr D. Clarken, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

RACE 3: TAB ADELAIDE CUP - MARCH 11 AT MORPHETTVILLE HANDICAP - 1250 metres

LUCKY FLIPPER (A. Jordsjo) - inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

FLOP (J. Holder) - laid out at the entrance to the straight contacting VIETTI.

VIETTI (C. Caserta) - shortly after the start was inconvenienced when tightened between EVERYDAY LADY, which shifted in slightly at the same time as LUCKY FLIPPER shifted out. At the entrance to the straight was inconvenienced when tightened onto EVERYDAY LADY by FLOP. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(i) and AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and in consecutive strides and was reprimanded for each breach. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: SCHWEPPE THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1250 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately four minutes.

DEXSTRA (R. Hurdle) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DREAMED (D. Tourneur) - slow to begin.

LA VITA (O. Ridge) - refused to load. Late scratching by order of Stewards at 3.14 pm. Trainer, Mr S. Gower, was advised that the filly would be required to load without delay in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race.

MISS BRIXTON (J. Holder) - became fractious in its barrier after being loaded. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and ruled unfit to start. Acting on this advice Stewards withdrew MISS BRIXTON at 3.13 pm. Mr C. McEvoy, representing trainer Mr T. McEvoy, was advised that a warning had been placed on the filly in relation to its barrier manners.

TROJOHNSTAR (R. Clark) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 5: MEDALLION HOMES HANDICAP - 1000 metres

MIHANY (C. Caserta) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

BAROOD (E. Finnegan) - held up from the vicinity of the 400 metres until near the 200 metres. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that she used her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

STRAGUN (D. Tourneur) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until the vicinity of the 200 metres.

RACE 6: TABLE & CHAIR CO HANDICAP - 1950 metres

SUPERVELOCE (NZ) (K. Bishop) – hung out in the early stages of the event. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until inside the 200 metres.

MAJESTIC RIDGE (E. Finnegan) – had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the entrance to the straight until near the 300 metres.

FANDANGO (E. Boyd) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

RACE 7: JOHN SENIOR FRANKHUISEN 83RD BIRTHDAY HANDICAP - 1550 metres

CANNOT BE SERIOS (NZ) (C. Caserta) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

PIANISSIMO (R. Clark) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed an elevated heart rate.

JUST LIVE ON (E. Finnegan) – raced fiercely in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider reported that due to the gelding racing keenly in the early stages of the event it had extended its lead on the field of its own accord, despite her efforts, by a larger margin than she had hoped.

BAKER'S DOZEN (C. Lions) – slow to begin.

RACE 8: TAB HANDICAP - 1250 metres

WINNING PARTNER (C. Caserta) – jumped away awkwardly and was slow into stride.

HALAYR ROTHESTAR (E. Boyd) – jumped away awkwardly.

VALLIANO (J. Toeroek) – acting on confirmed advice from trainer, Mr B. Papazaharoudakis, that the gelding was showing signs of an abscess on its off fore hoof and would be unfit to race Stewards withdrew VALLIANO at 2.22 pm. Mr B. Papazaharoudakis was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

IN THE FAST LANE (R. Hurdle) – laid in under pressure in the straight.

Race 8 – WINNING PARTNER, KNOTTED, ZAGATO STAR, IN THE FAST LANE.
