Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Racecourse
by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 2 March 2019

RACE 1: SCHWEPPE'S HANDICAP - 1100 metres

ICE GHOST (J. Holder) - contacted at the start when **DANCER'S KIN** shifted out.

DANCER'S KIN (K. Crowther) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and contacted **ICE GHOST**.

EXALTED TRAIL (C. Douglas) - slow into stride. Lost its near hind plate during the event.

EXALTED MAXINE (R. Clark) - difficult to load. Trainer, Mr G. Young, was advised that a warning had been placed on the filly in relation to its barrier manners. Jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and inconvenienced **WRITE ENUFF**. Over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

WRITE ENUFF (J. Winks) - difficult to load. Trainer, Mr K. Keys, was advised that a warning had been placed on the filly in relation to its loading manners. Inconvenienced on jumping away when **EXALTED MAXINE** shifted in. When questioned rider could offer no explanation in relation to the filly's performance other than when he asked the filly for an effort it failed to let down. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: DOMINANT HANDICAP - 1050 metres

IDATWO (S. Price) - lost its near fore plate during the event.

BROADWAY AND FIRST (G. Cartwright) - held up for clear running for a short distance shortly after straightening.

RACE 2: DOMINANT HANDICAP - 1050 metres (cont'd)

MISS LABELLE (L. Doodt) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: AAMI HANDICAP - 2000 metres

MATAMANOA (T. Hope) - raced in restricted room for a number of strides near the 400 metres.

GETTING LEGGIE (G. Cartwright) - Stewards acceded to a request from trainer, Mr N. Smart, for permission to replace J. Lorensini, who was overweight, with apprentice G. Cartwright. Over-raced in the early stages of the event.

RED VALENTINE (NZ) (K. Crowther) - over-raced in the early stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: NUTELLA PALOOZA - APRIL 20 AT MORPHETTVILLE RACECOURSE HANDICAP - 1200 metres

AL PASSEM (E. Brown) - began awkwardly. Laid out in the straight.

GO THE JOURNEY (J. Huxtable) - slow to begin. Rider reported that as a consequence of being slow to begin he was unable to lead as intended.

MORVADA (J. Toeroek) - rider reported that the gelding appeared a little distressed post-race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visibly abnormalities.

RACE 5: TAB ADELAIDE CUP - MARCH 11 AT MORPHETTVILLE HANDICAP - 1600 metres

FLOW METER (S. Fawke) - lost its near fore plate during the event.

POLAR VORTEX (G. Cartwright) - held up for clear running rounding the home turn.

BIG CALL (C. Caserta) - laid out rounding the home turn.

YANKEE EYES (K. Crowther) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 6: TAB CINDERELLA STAKES - 1050 metres

LI'L KONTRA (C. Parish) - laid out in the straight.

ANGEL ROCK (J. Toeroek) - held up for clear running from near the entrance to the straight until in the vicinity of the 300 metres. Raced greenly in the straight.

RACE 7: 13CABS LORD REIMS STAKES - 2600 metres

OLYMPIC ACADEMY (J. Toeroek) - approaching the 1600 metres got its head up and raced ungenerously for a number of strides. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

OCTOBER DATE (K. Crowther) - laid in, in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SYLPHEED (D. Tourneur) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

RACE 8: HEINEKEN 3 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

KABINI (D. Tourneur) - contacted by BY THE POUND on jumping away.

TAMBANG BESI (A. Jordsjo) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BY THE POUND (G. Cartwright) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and contacted KABINI. Near the 900 metres shifted in and hampered RAGING QUEEN. Rider reminded of her obligations when shifting ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RAGING QUEEN (K. Crowther) - hampered by BY THE POUND near the 900 metres. Held up for clear running for a short distance after entering the straight.

GENERAL:

G. Cartwright, E. Brown and J. Eaton were all reprimanded under AR143(12)(b) for failing to produce their winning rides books.

Trainer, Mr C. Bieg, reported that on return to stable following it's run in Race 4 at Gawler on Wednesday, 27 February 2019 COMZELADY was found to have a fractured pelvis. Mr Bieg advised that the mare will now be spelled.
