

THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Clare Racecourse by the Clare Racing Club on Sunday, 10 March 2019

TRACK: Good 4 (Track with some give in it)

RAIL: True

WEATHER: Overcast

RACE 1: TAB / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

KANZO (K. Usui) - laid out throughout the event. In the vicinity of the 700 metres shifted out taking LORD VARYS wider. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LIBERTY BLUE (S. Fawke) - laid out from the 600 metres until the home straight. In the vicinity of the 300 metres laid out inconveniencing STRICTLY MAMBO.

STRICTLY MAMBO (R. Hurdle) - jumped away awkwardly. In the vicinity of the 300 metres was inconvenienced by LIBERTY BLUE, which laid out.

LORD VARYS (E. Finnegan) - reared on jumping away and as a result was slow to begin. In the vicinity of the 700 metres was taken wider by KANZO, which shifted out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: HILL LIVESTOCK / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

GRAVITY (D. Tourneur) - laid out over the concluding stages.

SHARKSKI (J. Potter) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as the gelding had not raced in two years and passed fit to race.

WALLAMAN (S. Fawke) - laid in near the 100 metres and inconvenienced PARIS ON FIRE.

LOMON TEMBY (K. Usui) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 600 metres had to be steadied when it improved onto the heels of CRAFTY LIL.

PARIS ON FIRE (K. Lau) - in the vicinity of the 100 metres was obliged to be steadied when racing in restricted room to the inside of WALLAMAN, which rolled in.

RACE 3: TAMINGA HOTEL / SABOIS DISTANCE MAIDEN PLATE - 1800 metres

HEZ A WOLF (C. Jones) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

HUSSNING (T. Pannell) - lost an off hind plate during the event.

ORANGES (K. Bishop) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider explained her instructions were to let the gelding settle where comfortable without leading. She added shortly after the start, the gelding raced keenly and for that reason, she elected to allow ORANGES to roll forward. Trainer Mr A. Beswick confirmed the instructions. Lost near for plate during the event.

RYZLINK (E. Boyd) - rider explained the mare began to give ground in the vicinity of the 600 metres and from the 200 metres, elected not to ride her mount out in its normal manner as she had been became concerned with its action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: MAGIC FM / 5CS / SABOIS FILLIES AND MARES BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

TWICE FORGOTTEN (G. Lo) - rider explained the filly travelled okay until the 600 metres when placed under pressure and did not respond to his riding as well as expected. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MISS ELEGANCE (E. Finnegan) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped SHEANNA. Laid in from the 400 metres until the 200 metres.

SWEET VARDEN (K. Lau) - in the vicinity of the 900 metres shifted in and inconvenienced SHEANNA. Rider severely reprimanded and advised to only shift ground when entitled to do so. Laid in under pressure over the concluding stages.

SHEANNA (R. Clark) - bumped on jumping away by MISS ELEGANCE. In the vicinity of the 900 metres was obliged to be steadied to avoid the heels of SWEET VARDEN, which shifted in.

RACE 5: JIM BARRY BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

FLO JO SNIP (G. Lo) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

COMMANDING DIVA (J. Potter) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground between the 500 metres and 200 metres. Approaching the 100 metres shifted out and inconvenienced WHITE JADE. Rider reminded of his obligation and to only shift ground when able to do so.

WHITE JADE (R. Clark) - approaching the 100 metres was inconvenienced and taken wider by COMMANDING DIVA, which shifted out.

CRYSTAL MOMENT (K. Lau) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and tightened SOCIAL LANE. Raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

SOCIAL LANE (D. Tourneur) - tightened on jumping away between CRYSTAL MOMENT, which shifted in and WHITE JADE and as a result lost its position.

RACE 6: TAYLORS BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

ARCHWAY TO HEAVEN (R. Hurdle) - in the vicinity of the 400 metres was inconvenienced by SOUR CREAM, which shifted out and again in the vicinity of the 300 metres when SOUR CREAM stepped out.

STRATEGIC AGENDA (K. Lau) - laid in, in the straight. Approaching the 100 metres shifted in onto the heels of AVALON DOWNS and was obliged to be steadied away from that filly's heels.

RACE 6: TAYLORS BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1100 metres (Cont'd)

SOUR CREAM (S. Fawke) - raced greenly throughout the event. In the vicinity of the 400 metres shifted out and inconvenienced ARCHWAY TO HEAVEN. Rider reprimanded and advised to straighten his mounts sooner when they commence to shift ground. In the vicinity of the 300 metres stepped out and inconvenienced ARCHWAY TO HEAVEN. Approaching the 200 metres had to be steadied when racing in restricted room between ARCHWAY TO HEAVEN and PANDEIA, which laid out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PANDEIA (K. Bishop) - raced wide throughout the event. Laid out from the 400 metres until the 200 metres.

RACE 7: AIRMASTER AUSTRALIA BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1800 metres

HALAYR ROTHESTAR (C. Jones) - approaching the 100 metres was inconvenienced by GOLD MAESTRO, which laid in.

BEL STREAK (D. Tourneur) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

JACK'S SISTER (E. Boyd) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Laid out throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GOLD MAESTRO (J. Maund) - laid in under pressure approaching the 100 metres and inconvenienced HALAYR ROTHESTAR.

BETTERTHANYOUTHINK (L. Goomany) - knuckled on jumping away.

ANOTHER MARTINI (K. Bishop) - slow to begin.

BALZAC (K. Lau) - got its head up shortly after the start whilst being restrained.
